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AK ZANJ

Zanj is the Creole word for Angel. Ak Zanj means "With Angels," a reference to the Angel's Share, the spirit stolen by thirsty angels each year, as the rum matures in barrels. Under the tropical weather of Haiti, the Angels are especially thirsty, and their share can be as high as 10 percent annually. The more they drink, the more mature and complex the rum.

Produced and blended by Berling S.A. a brand owned and operated by the Linge family in Haiti, the "Zanj" collection comes from a rich heritage of rum distilling that traces back to the early 1800's. Resting in French oak barrels, their rums distilled in copper stills are an homage to their forbearers.
