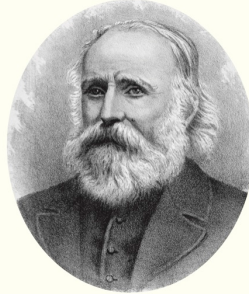

Located nearly 110 miles apart on two distinct benches above the Columbia River, Champoux and Sagemoor Vineyards are among the oldest and most highly acclaimed vineyards in Washington State.

We dedicate our Old Vines to Mr. A.P. Woodward who circa 1860 settled on 400 acres of what was formally Washington Territory. Nestled within this land near the present-day agricultural community of Lowden lies Woodward Canyon. Now, more than 150 years later the canyon that bears his name supports a hillside vineyard and a winery that proudly carries his name.
