Château Lalande is a small family owned estate in the village of Saint-Julien, owned by the dynamic Meffre brothers. Adjoining Château Gruaud Larose, Château Talbot and Château Lagrange, and facing Château Ducru-Beaucaillou, it is one of the rare, small, non-classified estates in the St. Julien appellation that has not yet been snatched up by one of its renowned neighbors. This estate comprises 15.5 hectares of vineyards planted on gravel soils at a density of 8,000 vines/hectare. Average age of vines 30 years. Sustainable agricultural farming. After manual harvest and sorting, grapes undergo a cold soak for 48 hours to extract color and aromas, and are fermented at 25°C in traditional cement and stainless steel vats. Aged 12 months in French oak barrels, 35% new. Only 6,000 cases produced annually. Bright ruby color. *Elegant nose of crushed red and black berry fruit, spices and a hint of vanilla. Rich and round in the mouth with a touch of freshness. Soft well-integrated tannins and a long finish. Enjoy with steaks, pork roasts, lamb chops, barbecue and cheese.*
