Le vignoble est voisin des terroirs de Saint-Julien et de Pauillac. Il est planté de 50% de cabernet sauvignon et franc, 48% de merlot et de 2% de petit-verdot. Les vins sont élevés 12 mois en barriques de chêne français comportant 25 à 30% de bois neuf. À carter dans leur jeunesse, ils accompagnent parfaitement les viandes et volailles, les charcuteries et certains fromages.

The vineyard is a neighbour of the land at Saint-Julien and that at Pauillac. It is planted with 50% cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc, 48% merlot and 2% petit verdot. The wines are matured for 12 months in French oak barrels, including 25-30% new wood. To be decanted young, they are perfect accompaniment for meat and poultry, charcuterie and certain cheeses.
