The Allamand H 2010 is a blend of 50% Malbec from Fico Villafañe's vineyard in Altamira, La Consulta and 50% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Calandria vineyard in El Peral, Tupungato. The wine was aged in new French oak for 12 months and spent 15 months in this bottle before being released to the market. Only 2,800 bottles produced.

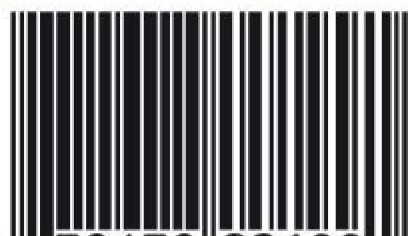
