This wine is made from fruit dry-farmed in the deep south of Chile in the Malleco Valley where several smaller wineries began growing fruit only a generation ago. Quino is a native word meaning "between two rivers". The reddish soils of volcanic origin are well peppered with the large stones of an ancient riverbed. Rainfall in Quino is more than 1,100 mm a year. Whilst a lot of water for Chile, it is modest next to rainfall where Sauvignon Blanc is produced in the old world. The challenge of growing in Quino is frost.
