We set out to make the ultimate Syrah. We co-ferment grapes from all of the top Santa Barbara County Syrah vineyards we work with. We then blend in designated barrels from our single vineyard selections. The result is a wine with tremendous structure, length, and complexity.

ÜBER is a synonym for super; e.g. ubercool. We began calling the wine ÜBER because of the intense multifaceted flavors it produced and for just how cool the whole idea is/was. The wine is aged 20 months in a new Ermitage French oak 2,000 liter foudre.
