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In 2014, we sought to evolve and expand our creative process by testing a dual aged method beginning with second-use barrels. By slowing down the maturation process, we mellowed the whiskey and developed its unique personality. Followed by resting the whiskey with French Oak staves before transferring it to New American Oak barrels where it spent time building layers of complexity. The result is a full bodied, flavorful double barrel whiskey, indicative of the many exciting things to come from Rebecca Creek Distillery.
