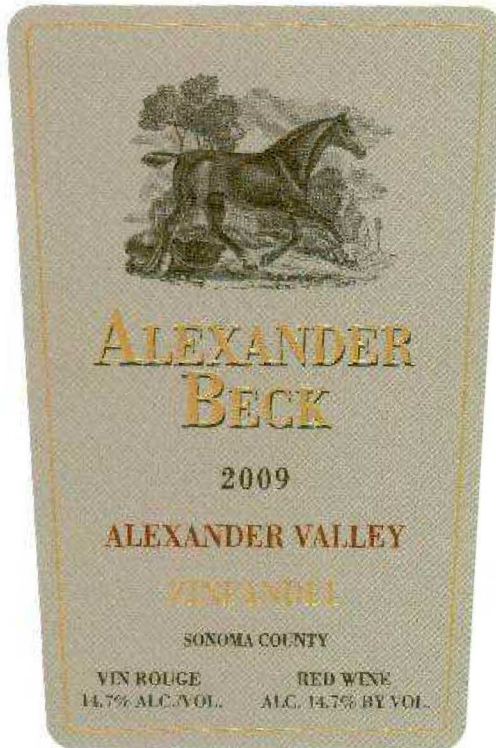

The premium vineyards of the Alexander Valley first took root with its discovery by Cyrus Alexander in 1890. The land grants that followed in 1841 and 1844 deeded 95,800 acres to H.D. Fitch and Cyrus began the years of work needed to earn his share of the discovery.

During these first years in the Alexander Valley, the cattle ranches depended heavily on the Spanish Andalusian horse. The transition from cattle and orchards to the beautiful vineyards of today took place over the next 130 years. The rolling hills and well-drained soils of the Alexander Valley proved the perfect growing environment for premium Zinfandel. The multiple layers of texture in the valley are reflected in the wine. The 2009 Zinfandel exhibits bramble berry and rich raspberry overtones. Cream cherry, mocha and vanilla notes frame the finish of this wine. This wine is ideal with grilled lamb, Italian sauces and roasted red meats, try with berry flans and chocolate desserts.
