L'Ecuyer [lay kwee yair] is a tiny estate of 3 hectares located in the small, but prestigious, appellation of Pomerol. The estate is owned by Emeric Petit, one of the top winemakers from the right bank of Bordeaux. The vines are planted on the famous Pomerol plateau, adjacent to Clos l'Eglise and Château Clinet, and benefit from an exceptional terroir of limestone and gravel soil over an iron pad. 40 year old vines. High planted density of 5500 vines/hectare. Manual harvest. Whole cluster fermentation in 400 liter oak barrels. Malolactic fermentation in 100 % new French oak barrels, followed by 15 months of ageing. No fining and filtering. *Intense purple-black color. Fine, delicate, nose of violets, black berry fruits, vanilla, and toasty oak flavors. Elegant attack that evolves linearly and progressively in the mouth with soft, silky tannins. Only 1300 cases produced.*

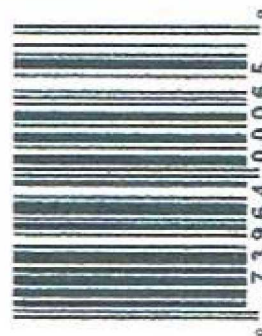

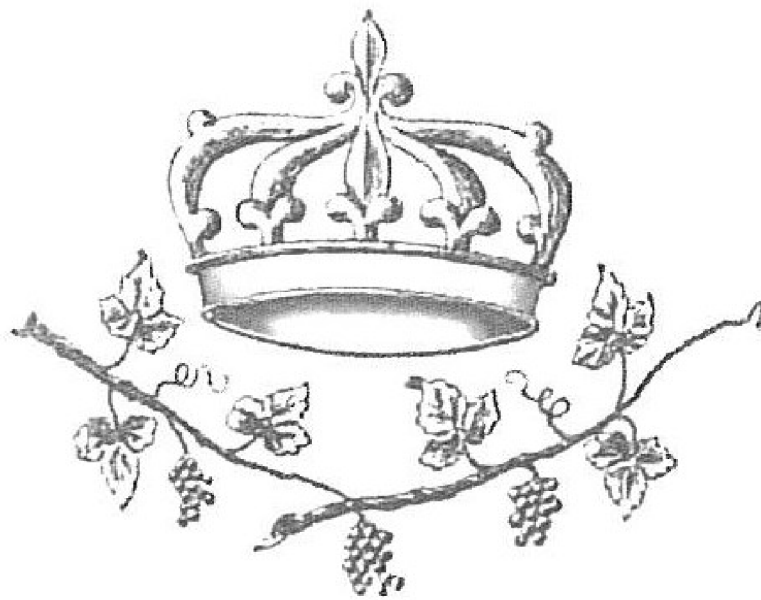
