Barlow Vineyards is an estate on the Silverado Trail between Calistoga and St. Helena at the upper end of the Napa Valley. Merlot was originally grown in the Napa Valley as a blending grape and it was not until the 1980's that it was found that the grape did exceptionally well in this area as a major varietal. Barlow Merlot is many layered and intense. It is grown on lyre trellises to take advantage of the well-drained, down sloped vineyards which enjoy a microclimate of cool nights and warm wind protected days. The Merlot fruit was picked at its prime and aged in French oak barrels for 20 months. As growers/producers we hope you will enjoy this rich Merlot wine as much as we do.
