Château Haut-Colombier is an award winning wine from the Blaye region of Bordeaux. This 37 acre estate is owned by two young, dynamic, up and coming brothers, Emmanuel and Olivier Chety, who have extensive winemaking experience in France and Australia. The vines have an average age of 30 years and are planted on the highest hill of Blaye, overlooking the Gironde river. Clay and limestone soils. Rigorous pruning, deleafing and green harvest to maintain low yields. The estate follows sustainable agricultural practices: no pesticides, herbicides or chemical fertilizers. Grapes harvested at night to preserve freshness and fruit. Pre-fermentation cold maceration to extract fruit and aromas. Modern vinification techniques. Aged 12 months in French oak barrels, of which 1/3 are new. *Purple robe. Elegant, fruity nose with vanilla and toasty oak aromas. Medium-bodied, rich, harmonious palate of red fruits from ultra ripe Merlot. Good balance, lovely tannins and a long finish.*

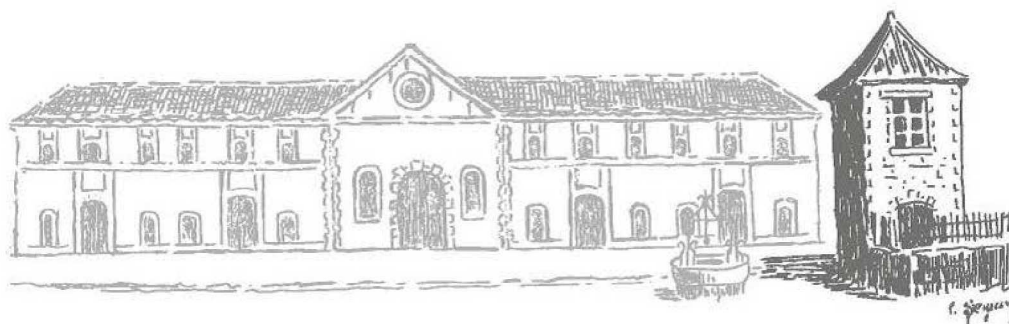
