The vines of Château Macard planted on a plateau rising to more than 80 meters above the level of the Dordogne, enjoy a perfect exposure and a panoramic position over the valley. Some plots are centuries old planted on a single rock base which bestows this red Bordeaux Supérieur, Château Macard, with an exceptional character.

The well-known Aubert family has been living in Saint-Émilion since 1750 and has a long and successful history as producers of some of Bordeaux's finest wines. Alain and Bernadette Aubert own over 600 acres of vineyard property, making them one of the largest family producers on the Right Bank. Their daughter, Amélie Aubert, is the 7th generation to take over the reins of the family's winemaking and vineyard responsibilities. The 30 hectare Estate is planted to 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc & 10% Cabernet Sauvignon with an average vine age of 35 years. Soils are composed of clay-limestone and gravel which enhance the minerality found in this wine.

Blackberry, blackcurrant and blueberry dominate the nose accented with toasty notes. Complex and sophisticated wine, well-balanced throughout the tasting. It has an intense color, generous volume and elegant final taste.

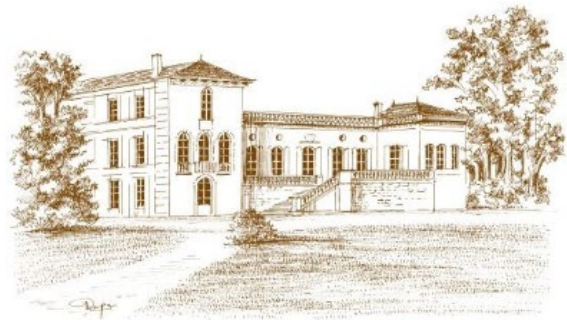
