Ca' Storica Amarone della Valpolicella is made in the "appassimento" method (drying of the grapes). Traditionally it is aged in wood then bottle aged for at least 6 months prior to release. As early as the 4th century A.D. it was known as "Acinatico". Enjoyed for centuries by royalty and noblemen, when Venice was a Republic, it was affectionately known as "Vino dei Dogi" (the Doge's wine). Today, it is simply called "Amarone", one of Italy's most prestigious wines.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS: Risotto, pasta, red meat, game, cheese or on its own. For best results, open wine 30 minutes before drinking so as to allow it to breathe. Serve at room temperature or 68 F.
