INSTRUCTIONS

- (A) One copy of this application properly executed, must be filed with the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, Austin, Texas; covering each set of labels for which a Certificate of Label Approval is desired. Applications must be accompanied by a copy of the Federal Label Approval (BATF) issued by Washington, D.C. One Application showing different size containers may be used for one particular brand of Vinous Liquor.
- (B) Attach to this side of the application form one (1) set of original labels for each size of container identical with those for which approval is desired. By set of labels is meant all brand, strip, neck and back labels appearing on any individual container. If original label cannot be obtained then only color reproductions will be accepted. Since a separate Certificate will be issued for each size, we must have a set of each size. Note: analytical samples of wines are required if alcoholic content is below 7% by volume and no BATF Certificate is available. A fee of \$25.00 (twenty-five dollars) must be attached for each size of each brand if a Certificate of Approval is desired. A fee of \$25.00 (twenty-five dollars) also must be attached for each size of each brand when there is any type of "LABEL REVISION". MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO THE "TEXAS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION".
- (C) Label applications cannot be processed until applicant has an active Non-Resident Seller's Permit.

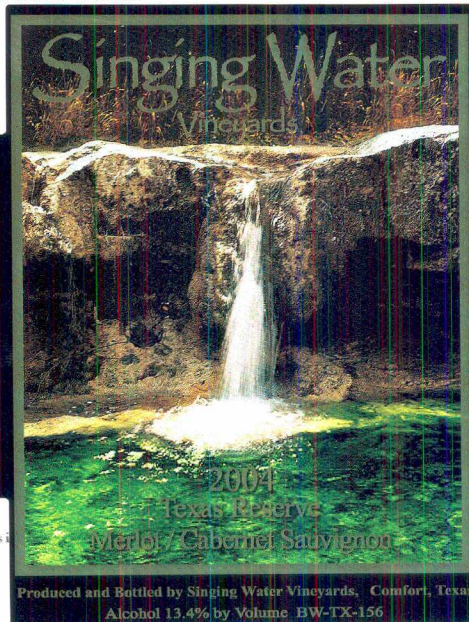
NOTE

Section 37.10(b) of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code provides: "It shall be unlawful for any holder of a Non-Resident Seller's Permit to solicit, accept or fill any order of any distilled spirits or wine unless the spirit holder is the Primary American Source of Supply for the brand of distilled spirits or wine sold or sought to be sold". In order to comply with the above mentioned LAW, please follow the instructions set out below:

VINOUS LIQUOR (WINE):

1. Label application & affidavit (4-MP-17).
2. Copy of Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms (BATF) Certificate of Approval.
3. Sample of product (in container with labels affixed as it is to be shipped/marketed in this state). If product is 7% or more alcohol by volume, sample is not necessary.
4. Proper fee. (\$25.00 for each size, brand and class). Make company check, money order, or cashiers check payable to Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission.
5. One brand and class per application.
6. In this order staple application, BATF Certificate of Approval, affidavit, along with all other corresponding documents in the upper left hand corner.

Singing Water Vineyards was established in 1997 in the Texas Hill Country near Comfort. Over 150 years earlier, Comanche Indians enjoyed the fruits of this land and its singing waters. Today, the grapes are carefully grown, hand harvested, crushed and fermented, followed by gentle aging of the wine in oak barrels. This Bordeaux-Style red wine with Texas roots is dark, rich, fruity and smooth. It is a blend of 55% Merlot and 45% Cabernet Sauvignon.
