IN 1980, one hundred years after our family began farming in Eastern Washington, we planted the old blocks of Seven Hills Vineyard. Along with my father, Vicky and I founded Seven Hills Winery in 1988. From that first vintage, my goal has been to craft intensely structured, balanced wines that express their vineyard origin.

In the tradition of the classic French Rosés, ours is delicate and refreshing, pale in color, and bone-dry. Primarily Cabernet Franc, with small amounts of Petit Verdot for structure and Malbec for expressive fruitfulness. Complex, with flavors of peach, grapefruit, and papaya along with fresh herbs, white flowers, and a hint of spice.
