EOLA-AMITY HILLS AVA

The Eola-Amity Hills American Viticultural Area was established in 2006. The federal petition to create the area was authored by Ted Casteel and Russ Raney. It was one of six sub-AVA's created simultaneously in the northern Willamette Valley.

This AVA is dominated by volcanic basalt parent material (mother rock). This thin 15 million year old veneer of cooled lava produces Pinot noir that emphasizes focused red and blue fruits. The compelling structure of the wine is supported by lively acidity and soft tannins.
