En 1788, il fut acquis par M. Gabriel Barthélémy Romain de Filhot, Président du Parlement de Bordeaux et restera plus d'un siècle propriété de sa famille. Son petit-fils, le Marquis Romain Bertrand de Lur Saluces, deviendra le plus grand producteur de vin blanc liquoreux du monde. Classé 1^{er} Cru en 1855, ses propriétaires successifs l'ont toujours maintenu à un très haut niveau de qualité. Le vin de Château Coutet est méticuleusement élaboré dans la pure tradition, combinant à la fois style et élégance avec subtilité. Il perpétue la richesse d'un grand Sauternes.
