At 625 feet above sea level, the bowl-shaped Kalita Vineyard is among the higher elevation, and thus cooler, sites in the Yamhill-Carlton viticultural district. The Willakenzie series soils are well known for complexity and structure.

The varied soil structure, along with the cool nature of the site planted to rich Pommard grapes, results in a wine of considerable structure and intense black fruits.
