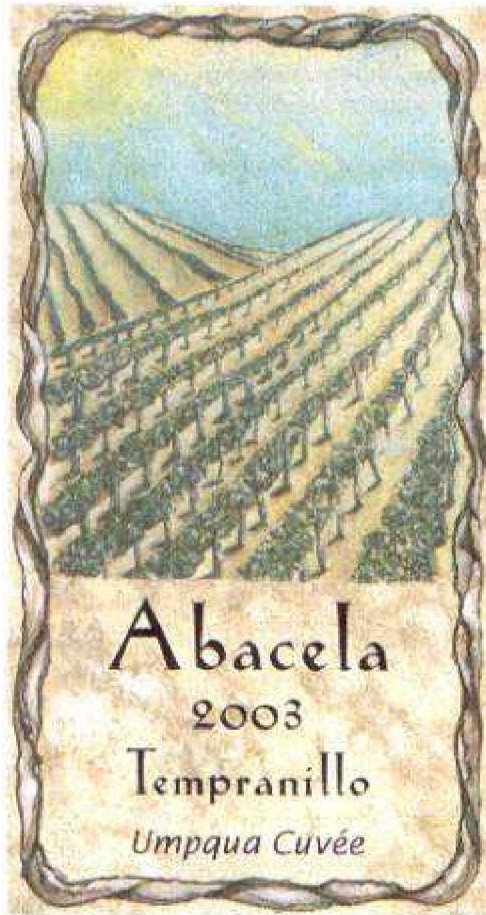

For the second consecutive vintage we have produced the Umpqua Cuvée, a bright, fruit-driven, somewhat softer style Tempranillo that offers lovely black cherry, cassis, leather, and spice tones on a medium weight frame. The bounty lies in the fact it's delicious and drinkable now without the need for cellaring. Enjoy over the next three years with pancetta, chile, and goat cheese-stuffed blue corn tamales.

In 1995, proprietors Earl & Hilda Jones planted the first Tempranillo in the Pacific Northwest and named their vineyard Abacela, from an ancient and now obsolete Spanish word meaning to plant a grapevine. Successful production of these wines is made possible by our estate's Southern Oregon terroir.
