Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa, was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three centuries. For our Grand Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its myriad sub-regions. It is this tapestry of 'terroirs' which enables us to create our classic and refined house style. By combining both traditional and modern winemaking techniques we are able to make handcrafted wines of complexity, depth and intensity. Lifted aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry and vanilla are accompanied by vibrant, dark berry fruits on the palate. The finish is long with fine-grained tannins from eighteen months' maturation in a combination of new and seasoned French oak barrels. Although drinking well now this wine may be cellared for up to ten years.
