OLD VINE GRENACHE VINTAGE 2013

The concept: Grenache is one of the founding varieties planted in the Barossa in the mid 1800's. It has been used in multiple wine styles and blends and interpreted diversely as a single variety. The St Hallett take on Grenache is to treat it quite differently to other varieties, in an effort to produce a medium bodied wine full of complexity and charisma.

The method: Vinification of these Grenache blocks occurs in open fermenters that are hand plunged with some bunches left whole to promote lifted and vibrant fruit characters. One and three year old French oak barrels are used for maturation to maintain the elegant aromas and flavours.

The result: The aroma reveals the beautiful complexity of Grenache as a variety, with traces of dark berries, earth and a variety of spices. The palate opens with vibrant red berries before layers of savoury dried herbs and coating tannins emerge.
