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BLANC DU BOIS IS AN AMERICAN HYBRID GRAPE VARIETY CREATED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA IN 1968 BY JOHN A. MORTENSEN. IT WAS CREATED FOR THE HOT HUMID CLIMATES OF THE SOUTHEASTERN UNITED STATES AND ITS TOLERANCE TO PIERCE'S DISEASE, A BACTERIAL INFECTION THAT DESTROYS NEARLY ALL VINIFERA VINE STOCKS. THE VARIETY IS NAMED IN HONOR OF EMILE DUBOIS, AN ACCOMPLISHED GRAPE GROWER AND WINEMAKER, WHO CAME TO FLORIDA FROM FRANCE IN 1982.

IT IS AN EARLY RIPENING VARIETY, WITH HARVEST BEGINNING THE FIRST WEEK IN JULY IN THE TEXAS GULF COAST REGION. THE PREDOMINANT WINE STYLE FOR BLANC DU BOIS IS AN OFF-DRY TO SEMI-SWEET WINE.

THIS DELIGHTFUL WINE IS 100% TEXAS — ESTATE GROWN AT OUR VINEYARD IN CANTON, TEXAS. WE HARVEST AT MATURITY, THEN FERMENT SLOW AND COOL TO BRING OUT THE PREDOMINANT TROPICAL FRUIT AROMAS WITH A CRISP CITRUS FINISH.
