When we discovered this small parcel of Petite Sirah in Lake County, we knew it would hold its own against the toast and char of our bourbon barrels. For our inaugural Half Batch release, just over 100 barrels were selected to develop this small-lot Petite Sirah.

This is a complex wine with a striking balance of succulent fruit, savory notes and hints of grilled herbs. I love that subtle hint of liquid smoke that only a bourbon barrel can deliver.
