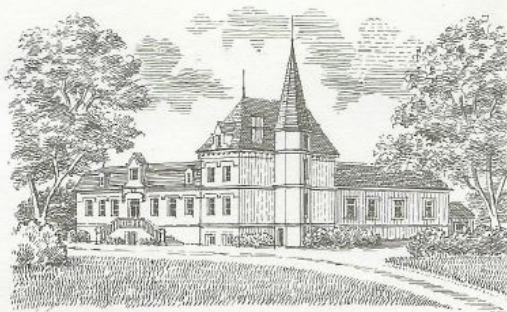

Château Bellegrave is a small family owned estate close to the village of Pauillac managed by the dynamic brothers Ludovic and Julien Meffre (who also own Château Lalande in Saint-Julien). The property is in the middle of the promised land of top Cabernet Sauvignon based wines; its close neighbors are the famous Château Latour, Château Pichon Lalande, Château Pichon Baron and Château Lynch Bages. Despite adjoining prestigious estates, Bellegrave is one of the few Pauillac that is not classified and therefore an exception in the appellation. The vineyard size is 9 hectares (22.2 acres). Bellegrave refers to the 100% pure 'garonnaise' gravel soil in the vineyard. This allows maximum filtration and heat retention during the day. Average age of the vines is 25 years old. Sustainable farming is used. After manual harvest and sorting, the grapes undergo 3 days of cold soak to extract aromas and are then fermented in stainless steel vats. The wine is aged in French oak barrels for 12 months. Only 2,500 cases produced. *Dark purple red color. Fleshy cassis fruit with backbone, velvety tannins and long finish. Enjoy with steaks, lamb chops, barbecue, and seasoned cheese.*
