In 1999, Howard & Amy Davies, along with family and friends, planted their vineyard in Montague County, laying the foundation of what is now known as Arché. Their son, Ryan, was the creative visionary, designing the round "OAK" symbol identifying the family's vineyard, Oak Creek, and which is now promoted as the brand for Arché. In 2005, Ryan Davies, beloved son and brother, passed away. Two years later, Arché winery was created, and the first red wine produced was Ryan's Red, as Ryan single-handedly planted most of the original vines that went into the blend. Today, under winemaker and son, Grayson Davies, Arché still produces Ryan's Red, a blend of Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon, as a tribute to Ryan.
