

What is The Emmanuel House? A Better Understanding of a Women's Transition Home - Storyboard

Introduction: This video was designed for learners to get a better understanding as to what is the Emmanuel House? The video will explain what a transition home is and how home is run with a specific program designed to prepare the women in the home for successful reentry into society.

Learning Objectives:

After watching this video, viewers (learners) will be able to:

1. Explaining the primary purpose of Emmanuel House as a transition home and its role in supporting individuals in transition.
2. List at list three supportive services and life skills training opportunities offered by the Emmanuel House to its residents.
3. Inspire viewers to take action or support The Emmanuel House. (Viewers should feel motivated to get involved, volunteer, or contribute to the mission of The Emmanuel House. (This is our community.)

Outline:

 - Having a better understanding of The Emmanuel House and having a desire to support its efforts to better the community.
- Each table in this storyboard represents one scene.
- The character speaking will be indicated in the audio/script column as [character].
- Audio will be lip synched with character speaking.

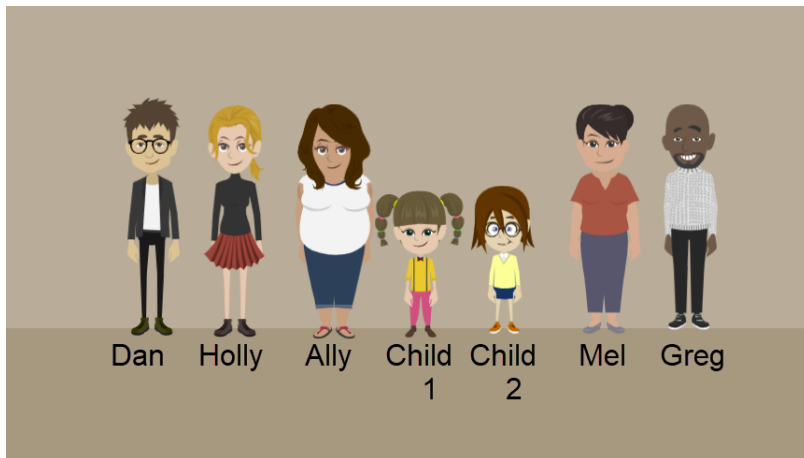





I owe you. Hey, we just passed The Emmanuel House. Do you know anything about it?”</p> <p>[Holly]: “Actually I do Dan. The Emmanuel House is a transition home for women and children. Great things are happening there.”</p> <p>[Dan]: “Great things? That’s great, but I don’t really know what a transition home really is or does. Tell me more.”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Scene transitions in with the two opening a conversation ● Lip sync of each character is timed with audio ● Pedestrian walks across screen as car drives past the home.

	<p>[Holly]: "A transition home is housing that offers a supportive type of accommodation that is meant to bridge the gap from homelessness or recent incarceration to permanent housing. Once the women become residents at The Emmanuel House, they complete a step program to prepare them for reentry into society through mentoring, classes, education, and other supportive services. Let's meet the wonderful staff at the Emmanuel House to see what it's like."</p>

She and her case manager will give a tour. 	<p>[Mel]: Our transition home provides a safe haven for those in need. The residents share the main room in the home. They also use the common rooms for support sessions and socializing, which is an important skill to improve upon while at The Emmanuel House.”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The screen fades in and Mel is standing off left among the women of The Emmanuel House. ● Mel is lip syncing to the audio. ● Scene slowly fades out at end. 	



<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The viewer comes to the living room. Mel explains what the living room is used for in a transition home. 	<p>[Mel]: “The women are required to complete a phase program while here. The program is 12 months, sometimes longer if they’re not ready. While at the Emmanuel House, the women create a personal plan, growth plan, and a house plan. Each of these plans guide the women into personal growth for their future.”</p>

	<p>[Mel]: In our transition home the women and children have their own private bedrooms, fostering independence and comfort. The women work outside the home and pay rent for the bedroom so the women can gain responsibility skills. 	<p>[Mel]: “Our dedicated staff members are here to offer guidance and support. This is Greg, our case manager.”</p> <p>[Greg]: “I’m working with Allie today. Sometimes, the women come from situations where their actions have resulted in limited time with their children. This involves legal action. Allie is working on paperwork to ensure her children will be able to stay with her full-time.”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Mel continues to appear in this scene as a talking head in a circle. ● Greg narrates the 2nd half of the scene. ● The resident, Allie, is present in all scenes of the video, but does not narrate. She is actively filling out paperwork.
