

Light Aroma Ball-Rolled Oolong Tea

The tea broth has a rich and mellow mouthfeel, with a moderate thickness and a lingering aftertaste. It carries a sweet and slightly astringent taste, primarily exuding the aroma of orchid and magnolia flowers, along with hints of sugarcane, pear, green plum, and guava. The tea leaves exhibit a bright greenish-yellow color with many stems, and the infusion presents a clear and bright honey-green hue after brewing.
