Patent infringement suit: Intel wins patent trial involving VLSI Technology!

Recently, the US District Court for the Western District of Texas ruled in favor of Intel Inc. in a patent infringement suit filed against it by VLSI Technology, which was seeking \$3.1bn in damages. The dispute arose in April 2019 when VLSI sued Intel, accusing the latter of infringing three patents covering data processing system VLSI technology. has vet another opportunity after this setback as a third trial before US District Judge which seems to begin soon in June.

Patent dispute: Nokia and Lenovo settle over video compression technology!

Nokia and Lenovo recently have announced that they have decided to settle a longstanding patent dispute relating to video compression technology. The dispute which began in 2019 with Nokia suing Lenovo across multiple jurisdictions around the world, has come to an end after Lenovo agreed to pay an undisclosed sum to Nokia. Also, the parties have reportedly arrived at a cross-licensing agreement as part of the settlement deal.

The Tribunals Reforms (Rationalisation and Conditions of Service) Ordinance, 2021 got notified!

On April 4, 2021, the Government of India, notified 'The Tribunals Reforms (Rationalisation and Conditions of Service) Ordinance. 2021'. The Ordinance has effectively dissolved several appellate bodies, including the Intellectual Property Appellate Board, Airport Appellate Tribunal, etc. and transferred their functions to District and High Courts. The Ordinance also provides for selection, appointment, and tenure of chairpersons and members of existing tribunals.



COPYRIGHT HIGHLIGHTS

Copyright claim: Copa sues Craig Wright over Bitcoin!

The Cryptocurrency Open Patent Alliance (COPA) is suing nChain Chief Scientist Craig Wright before a UK High Court to allege that Craig Wright does not have any copyright ownership over the Bitcoin white paper. Whereas, Wright has been claiming ownership over the Bitcoin White Paper and had sent a cease and desist notice to Square to takedown the same from their website, in response to which, COPA sought some clarifications.

The opposition from COPA, claims to bring this action on behalf of the entire crypto community to protect the open source spirit of the same, by ensuring that all resources, such as the white paper, remain in the open source realm and not become protected works.

Copyright infringement: Google wins against Oracle's Code theft claim

The US Supreme Court decided in favor of Google in a case filed by Oracle accusing Google of copying their software code that is used to make Apps. The code was written in Java, a software programming language owned by Oracle and used by Google to create the Android Operating System. Google contested that such copying was a standard practice in the industry while Oracle accused Google of theft. The Supreme Court held that Google's copying fell under 'the Fair Use' exception, which allows copying another's work without authorization if some conditions are met.

Ministry of Commerce and Industry: Copyright (Amendment) Rules, 2021 got notified!

The Ministry of Commerce and Industry has notified Copyright (Amendment) Rules, 2021 under section 78 of the Copyright Act, 1957 that is effective from March 30, 2021. One of the significant changes that the Amendment Rules has made is that it has substituted the 'Copyright Board' with the 'Appellate Board'

Copyright infringement: Xinuos Inc. sues IBM and Red Hat.

In March, 2021, Xinuos, Inc., has filed a copyright infringement and antitrust lawsuit against IBM and Red Hat, Inc. alleging unauthorized use of their software code and subsequent engagement in anti-competitive behaviour, claiming punitive damages as well as injunctive relief.

Further, with the illegally obtained software code, IBM and Red Hat decided to split the relevant market unfairly and use their growing market leverage against customers, rivals, and other stakeholders.

As alleged by Xinuos, this collaboration between IBM and Red Hat resulted in Xinuos' product OpenServer 10 being unfairly eliminated from the market.

GI Tag: Madhya Pradesh's tribal dolls applied for it!

Recently, the tribal dolls, or the 'Adivasi Gudiya Hastshilp', which have been produced in Madhya Pradesh's Jhabua district for decades. has applied for geographical indication tagging by the Tribal Co-Operative Development Federation Marketing (TRIFED). The dolls, which are made using cloth, cotton, and iron wires, feature a combination of Rajasthani puppet-making and Gujarati ethnic art, which uses beads and jewellery. The granting of this GI would be a major step towards the recognition of tribal art forms in the country

This specific strain of maize is high in protein content and resistant to a wide variety of diseases.
