San Diego State finished the season ranked in the *USA Today* Coaches Top 25 Poll, ranking **No. 2**.

2

The MW and Big 12 are the only **two** conferences in which every program has a NET ranking of 200 or better.

5

The Mountain West is the one of **five** conferences that has five or more teams with at least 22 wins on the season.

5

The MW owns a 116-55 (.678) nonconference record in 2022-23, which is the **fifth**-best nonconference record among the 32 conferences in the nation.

5

Among the 32 conferences, the Mountain West ranks **fifth** in NET rankings with an average NET of 88.4. The MW's average is the best in the west.

6

The Mountain West is one of **six** conferences (Big 12, 7; SEC, 6; Big East, 4; Big Ten, 4; MW, 3; ACC, 3) that have three or more teams ranked among the top 30 of the NET rankings.

7

The Mountain West has **seven** NCAA Sweet 16 appearances in league history. This year, San Diego State made its third Sweet 16 appearance and first since 2014.

Seven Mountain West teams own an overall record of .500 or better in 2022-23.

With New Mexico's bid to the 2023 NIT, the Mountain West has made **33** NIT appearances in Conference history.

59

With four teams in the NCAA tournament, the Mountain West has **59** NCAA appearances in league history.

MOUNTAIN WEST NOTEBOOK

- San Diego State made its first (and the Mountain West's first) appearance in the NCAA Men's Basketball National Championship game.
- The Mountain West is 5-4 in the NCAA tournament in 2023, marking the most NCAA tournament wins in the postseason in league history.
- Heading into the Final Four, the Mountain West has earned a Conference-record eight units during March Madness, which ranks sixth among the 32 leagues in 2023. The projected payout over the next six years is \$16 million for the MW.
- SDSU is the only team west of the Mississippi River to make the 2023 final four.
- A total of six Mountain West squads appeared in the 2023 postseason. Four teams (Boise State, Nevada, San Diego State and Utah State) earned bids to the NCAA tournament. New Mexico received a bid to play in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT), while San José State accepted an invitation to play in College Basketball Invitational (CBI).
- Four teams in the NCAA tournament marks the second time in league history with back-to-back seasons of four or more NCAA tournament bids. The MW had four in 2012 and five in 2013.
- The Mountain West is one of six conferences (ACC, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, SEC) to have back-to-back seasons with four or more NCAA tournament bids in 2022 and 2023.
- The MW is one of seven conferences in 2023 (ACC, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12, SEC) to have four or more teams earn NCAA tournament bids.
- 2023 marks the fifth-straight NCAA tournament that the MW has had multiple bids and the 20th time in Conference history to have two or more teams earn bids.
- For the second year in a row, and the eighth time since 2000, the Mountain West has six or more teams in the postseason.
- With four teams in the NCAA tournament in 2023, the Mountain West has 59 NCAA appearances in league history.
- Seven of the 11 MW teams have played in the NCAA tournament over the last eight seasons.
- Boise State returned to the NCAA postseason for the second year in a row, marking the third time that the Broncos have made back-to-back March Madness appearances in program history. This was Boise State's ninth NCAA tournament appearance in program history and fourth since joining the Mountain West in 2011.
- Utah State made its 23rd overall NCAA tournament appearance and third since joining the Mountain West in 2013. The Aggies made their first NCAA appearance since earning back-to-back bids in 2019 and 2021.
- Nevada appeared in the NCAA tournament for the first time since 2019. This marked the 10th NCAA appearance in program history and the fourth bid since joining the Mountain West in 2012.
- New Mexico is made its 20th NIT appearance and first since 2011. The Lobos were the NIT runner-up in 1964, reached the semifinals in 1990 and advanced to the quarterfinals six other times, most recently in 2001.
- San José State made its first postseason appearance since 2011 and second in the College Basketball Invitational. The Spartans made their sixth postseason appearance in program history.
