## BULLDOG BONES

- As the No. 9 seed, Fresno State will play in the opening round of the tournament against No. 8 Air Force
- Bulldogs received the No. 9 seed after a loss to New Mexico earlier this week, 72-58
- In the last two tournament appearances, Fresno State has a seen knock out in the first round (2022, Utah State) (2023, Nevada)
- This will be the first neutral meeting between the two programs in series history
- For the second consecutive time Fresno State will enter the tournament as the No. 9 seed
- Four Bulldogs have recorded ten or more 10+ point games this season, Mia Jacobs leads the team with the team with 20; Deajanae Harvey (11), Keely Brown (11) and Kylee Fox (10)
- Fresno State is 9-0 when shooting better than opponents
- Four Bulldogs have had at least one 20+ point games, Mia Jacobs also leads the team with five this season; Deajanae Harvey (2), Sydney Dethman (1), Tajja Sta. Maria (1)
- In the last two meetings, Fresno State has not seen a winning margin lower than six points
- Fresno State enters the tournament on a three game losing streak streak, dropping contest against Boise State, Wyoming and New Mexico
- Bulldogs are 10-3 when leading at the half and 6-2 when leading for over 20 minutes
- Fresno State has seen strong success with a starting lineup that features Sta. Maria, Jacobs, Dethman, Brown and Fox recording nine wins
- Fresno State comes into Sunday's game with a -1.00 scoring margin and a -1.72 rebounding margin while shooting 39% from the field, 33% from the three and 71% from the charity line
- Mia Jacobs is the 5th best rebounder in the conference with 131 rebounds (40 Off / 91 Def.) and averages 7.28 rebounds per game
- Jacobs also ranks as the 7th best shooter in conference with 252 points averaging 14 ppg through 18 conference games
- With a win at Utah State head coach Jaime White surpasses 100 conference wins, becoming the third active women's basketball head coach in the Mountain West, trailing Boise State's Gordy Presnell and Colorado State's Ryun Williams
- With the win a second against Utah State, Fresno State has already passed its win total and conference win total from a season ago. 2022-23 (10-22, 3-15 MW)
- Three Bulldogs have been tabbed with Mountain West honors so far this season, Tajja Sta. Maria (3x, Freshman of the Week, Nov. 13, Dec. 11 & Feb. 12), Kylee Fox (Freshman of the Week, Nov. 11) and Mia Jacobs (Player of the Week, Dec. 26)

## FRESNO STATE NOTES

### WHAT'S TO COME THIS WEEK

Fresno State women's basketball is set to open the first round of the Mountain West Tournament this Sunday against the No. 8 seed Air Force. Tip-off is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. PT at the Thomas & Mack Center and streaming live on the Mountain West Network.

### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

Fresno State and Air Force will meet for the 26th time in series history and for the third time this season. The two teams will see each other for the first time in a neutral setting and at the tournament since Fresno State joined the Mountain West in 2013. Fresno State leads the all-time meetings 21-4.

This season the Bulldogs own wins in both meetings with the Falcons and are looking for the potential third to move onto the next round of the tournament. Last time out, Fresno State was able to hold over on the Falcons to take the six-point lead all the way to the finish.

### TIME TO MAKE (MW) HISTORY

Head coach Jaime White has held a strong standing in the Mountain West in her tenure leading the Bulldogs. Just this season Coach White has surpassed 100 conference wins (70-50 at Utah State, Feb. 3), making her the first active female women's basketball head coach in the Mountain West and the third active women's basketball MW head coach to reach this milestone.

Coach White's mark doesn't end there, in her ten years she has seen six championship games with two championship wins (2013, 2014) as the No. 2 seed. Prior to 2022 coach White had not entered the tournament lower than No. 7 (2017), in these last two seasons the Bulldogs have only seen a first round appearance. Fresno State stands just a bit taller entering the tournament this season, earning four more conference wins than last season.

### UP & DOWN PERIODS

Whether it's opening the game with a high scoring period and seeing ten or less points in the final period or vice versa. Fresno State has seen their struggles opening and closing games this season, but the Bulldogs have yet to see a win, either way.

- 0-4 when scoring more than ten points in the opening period and less than 10 points in the fourth period
- 0-3 when opening the period with less than ten points and scoring more than ten points in the final period.

Fresno State played with consistency midway through the season logging seven games scoring ten or more points every period, including in four wins.

Even in tight matchups that ended in a loss

- Aztecs (15, 21, 11, 23)
- Boise State (10, 15, 13, 27)
- New Mexico (13, 23, 18, 23)

### TAKING IT TO THE ARC FOR THREE

Throughout the season Fresno State has seen its strength taking shots from the three-point line. With two Bulldogs holding a top ten rank in conference standing, Mia Jacobs and Kylee Fox. The duo are tied for 7th in the conference with 35 FGM (1.94 avg) through 18 conference games.

Individually, Jacobs shoots 37% from the three (58-of-156) with a conference high of 6 at Nevada. Fox shoots 38% from the three (56-of-144) with a conference high of 5-of-5 versus San Jose State.

As a team Fresno State held the No.1 position in 3PFGM throughout the season. Still at No. 1, Bulldogs hold a 7.39 average and have only seen four conference games shooting less than six 3PFG. Bulldogs have a season high of 14 3FGM versus San Jose State.

### SENIOR NIGHT

Fresno State will be recognizing two seniors in the final home game of the season, Keely Brown and Deajanae Harvey.

Deajanae transferred to Fresno State from Palomar College and has spent one year in a Bulldog uniform. In that time, Deajanae has played in 26 games with two career starts and has recorded 224 points, 54 rebounds and 50 steals. Deajanae has a career high of 23 points at Boise State (2/24/24), 6 steals at CSU Bakersfield (11/18/23) and 7 rebounds vs Air Force (12/30/23). Deajanae will earn a bachelor's degree in sociology in the spring.

Keely Brown has spent three years in a Bulldog uniform, after redshirting in the 2021-22 campaign. In that time, Keely has played in 77 games with 35 career starts and has recorded over 400 points and 180 rebounds. Keely has a career high of 19 points at UNLV (2/9/23), 5 blocks vs Rice (03/20/21). Keely will earn her bachelor's degree in Biology in the spring

### LEADING THE PACK

Going into the final conference game two Bulldogs continue to lead the way, Mia Jacobs and Deajanae Harvey.

Jacobs goes into the week with 689 career-points (409 points as a Bulldog), 371 rebounds and 77 three-point field goals made, under her belt. Jacobs also stands tall within the conference as the seventh best shooter with 244 points in conference play (14.35 avg), and is tied for fourth best rebounder with 127 (7.47).

Harvey has worked her way to the top. With two career-starts, both in conference games and 26 games

played this season. Harvey brings the defensive pressure for the Bulldogs as the top player in steals during conference play with 33 steals (1.94 avg). Harvey comes into the final week with 224 points, 54 rebounds and 50 steals as a Bulldog.

### TOURNAMENT BOUND

The four-day Mountain West tournament begins on Sunday, March 9th with the first round tipping off at 2:30 p.m. PT. The Mountain West will release the official brackets on Tuesday, March 5, at the conclusion of regular-season play.

Fresno State is on the outside looking in, currently sitting in eighth place after a tough loss to Wyoming last Saturday afternoon in Laramie, 61-51. A win against New Mexico can clinch the Bulldogs the No. 8 seed for the opening round of the tournament.

### NEW JUMPS FOR HARVEY

Senior Deajanae Harvey scored another career-high game at Boise State with 23 points. Harvey's second career-high game comes just a week later after logging 21 points at home versus San Jose State.

Harvey's last four games have finished in double-figures with two 20+ point games both ending as career-high games. Harvey has been Fresno State's top scorer off the bench, helping produce more than 30 points in three of the last four games.

### FINAL ROAD GAME

Fresno State has seen their struggles on the road this season. Their first true road win coming in January against the Spartans. Fresno State has only seen a total of three conference wins this season, San Jose State, Utah State and Air Force.

Bulldogs have one more chance to close out the last of the road games with a win against the Cowgirls in Laramie.

### DOUBLE IT UP

Sophomore Mia Jacobs has earned her fifth double-double this season. Jacobs scored 19 points with 12 rebounds.

Jacobs looks to close out the season on a high note, continuing her streak of scoring in double figures. Jacobs has seen eight straight games scoring in double-figures.

### TOURNEY BOUND

Mountain West tournament is right around the corner. Bulldogs will make the trip to Las Vegas to the Thomas & Mack Center.

Last seasons trip was short-lived as the Bulldogs were eliminated in the first round by Nevada. This has been a strong season for the team already beating last years overall and conference wins.

### LEADING STRONG AT THE HALF

In the last three games Fresno State has managed to hold the lead going into the half.

In the last three matchups Bulldogs did not see their lead drop below ten points for the entire second half.

In the last two games Fresno State has seen a win with only two players scoring in double figure. In recent matchups this season, Bulldogs were consistently earning wins when three to four players scored in double-figures.

### CAREER MARKS FOR HARVEY

Against San Jose State, Deajanae Harvey scored a career-high 21 points, twelve of which came from beyond the arc.

Harvey has been a strong scorer for the Bulldogs off the bench in the last three games. Harvey has been the backbone of the bench allowing them to score no less than 20 points in the last four games.

Scoring double-figures in back-to-back games, Harvey has accounted for almost half (48%) of the bench points produced in Fresno's last two meetings.

### BACK-TO-BACK WINS

Fresno State enters the final two weeks of conference play on a two game win streak. Bulldogs found themselves in a mid-season rut on a four game losing streak before a big road win at Utah State. The last time Fresno State saw themselves on a win streak in conference play was the opening two match ups. Bulldogs remain strong on their court with a 9-6 home record this season.

### KEEP YOUR EYES ON THE BALL

Fresno State has seen the top spot in the conference for turnovers and steals. During conference play Fresno State has seen five games with ten or less turnovers. Fresno State holds a +3.71 turnover margin (No. 2 MW). In the last three games Fresno State has forced their opponents to a combined 46 turnovers. Deajanae Harvey leads the team in steals with 27 (No. 2 MW) and averages 1.93 steals per game.

### HOT OFF THE BENCH

Fresno State's bench was a big support in the road match between the Falcons on Wednesday night. Two of the top three scorers from Bulldogs came off the bench, Deajanae Harvey (11) and Sydney Dethman (14). In five of the last six games the bench has been able to produce no less than 21 points per game.

Recording a season high 32 points from the bench against Air Force. Fresno State has out shot their opponent from the bench in eight of the 13 conference games this season.

### REDEMPTION MATCHUPS

With the end of the season near, Fresno State has four more games remaining in the season. Fresno State's final four opponents will be tough rematch-

es. Bulldogs dropped the first meeting with the remaining four opponents and will be facing tough rematches, two of which will be on the road.

Of the next four matches, Fresno State's closest chance for a potential win was at Nevada, as they fell by one in mid-January, 63-62.

### BULLDOG HIGHLIGHTS

- Bulldogs saw their first win at Air Force since Feb. 20, 2019 (77-70) and snap a three game losing streak at the Academy
- Fresno State shot their highest percentage from the field 60% (24-of-40), the three 62% (5-of-8) and the foul line 95% (21-of-22) this season
- Fresno State is backing scoring in the 70 points or more since Feb. 3 at Utah State
- Bulldogs are now 9-1 when three or more players score in double-figures
- Last time the Bulldogs put up 40 point in a half was against Utah State on Jan. 13
- Three Bulldogs saw double-digits Mia Jacobs (15), Sydney Dethman (14), and Deajanae Harvey (11)
- Taija Sta. Maria locks in on a 100 assist as a Bulldog this season
- Team highs: Points (Mia Jacobs, 15) Rebounds ( Mia Jacobs, 8) Assists (Tamia Stricklin & Taija Sta. Maria, 3)
- Fresno State saw their most turnovers (21) since their first meeting with the Falcons in Dec. 30 (22 TO)

### 3X FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

True freshman Taija Sta. Maria earns her third MW Weekly honor this season. Logged 18 points, four assists and two rebounds on the week.

At Colorado State, posted seven points, shooting 40 percent from the field and 75 percent from beyond the arc. Against then-No.25 UNLV, registered 11 points, shooting 50 percent from the field and 75 percent from three-point range. Taija Sta. Maria has earned her third Freshman of the Week honor this season. Sta. Maria ties with two other freshmen for three weekly honors (Lovett, San Jose State) (Sullivan, Nevada)

Against UNLV Sta. Maria was the team's leading scorer with 11 points and saw her first time back in double-figures since mid-January at New Mexico (10 points). Sta. Maria is the only Freshman in program history to have more than one MW Freshman Weekly Honor. As of Jan. 11 Sta. Maria ranks 6th in assists with 42 (3.5 avg), 2nd in assist/turnover ratio 42-to-17, 2.47 ratio in the Mountain West.

### ROAD WORK

Bulldogs are back on the road after a tough loss to Colorado State earlier this past week. Fresno State have seen their struggles on the road this season winning a total of three games on the road, two true road wins. Both true road wins have been during conference play. 'Dogs saw their largest loss on the

road against Colorado by thirteen points, 69-56.

Fresno State shoots between 30-40% in all road loss conference matchups, in their two wins Bulldogs successfully shot over 40%. Fresno State is 2-0 on the road when shooting over 40% from the field. (41% at San Jose) (42% at Utah State.) Bulldogs highest shooting percentage from the field on the road during conference came in New Mexico shooting 46% 30-of-65.

### FINAL STRETCH

Bulldogs are setting their sights on the near end of conference play. With only 30 days until the opening round of the Mountain West Championships in Las Vegas, Nevada. Fresno State currently sits at No. 9 in conference standings.

Fresno State has six games remaining this season. After UNLV, Bulldogs are back on the road to face the Air Force Falcons. A set of home matches against San Jose State and Nevada, before closing out the month at Boise State. 'Dogs will open up March at Wyoming before settling back at home for senior night against New Mexico.

### IT'S A BATTLE ON THE ROAD

Bulldogs' earned their second true road win of the season at Utah State with a 20 point victory over the Aggies, 70-50. Back on the road this week, 'Dogs will travel to Fort Collins, Colorado to take on the Rams. Bulldogs have seen their struggles on the road this season of the four conference road games thus far, Fresno State has not seen a loss of more than seven points. The Bulldogs largest loss on the road came during the non-conference portion of the season at Cal Poly, 84-55.

### MAKING HISTORY

Head coach Jaime White surpasses 100 conference wins this past Saturday in Logan. This milestone marks Coach White as the only active women's head coach in the Mountain West and the third active head coach in the Mountain West to have a 100 or more conference wins. Coach White joins the short list of women in the history of the Mountain West to have 100 or more wins and writes her name next to Elaine Elliott, 130 and Kathy Olivier, 106. In her ten seasons as the head coach, Jaime has finished with three 20+ win seasons, finishing 23-10 (13-5 MW) and 22-12 (15-3 MW) in her first two seasons (2014-15, 2015-16) leading the Bulldogs.

In her nineteen games as a Bulldog, Jacobs has seen only six games scoring in single-digits, with her last one in early January at San Diego State. Jacobs is the only Bulldog to have more than one game scoring 20 or more points.

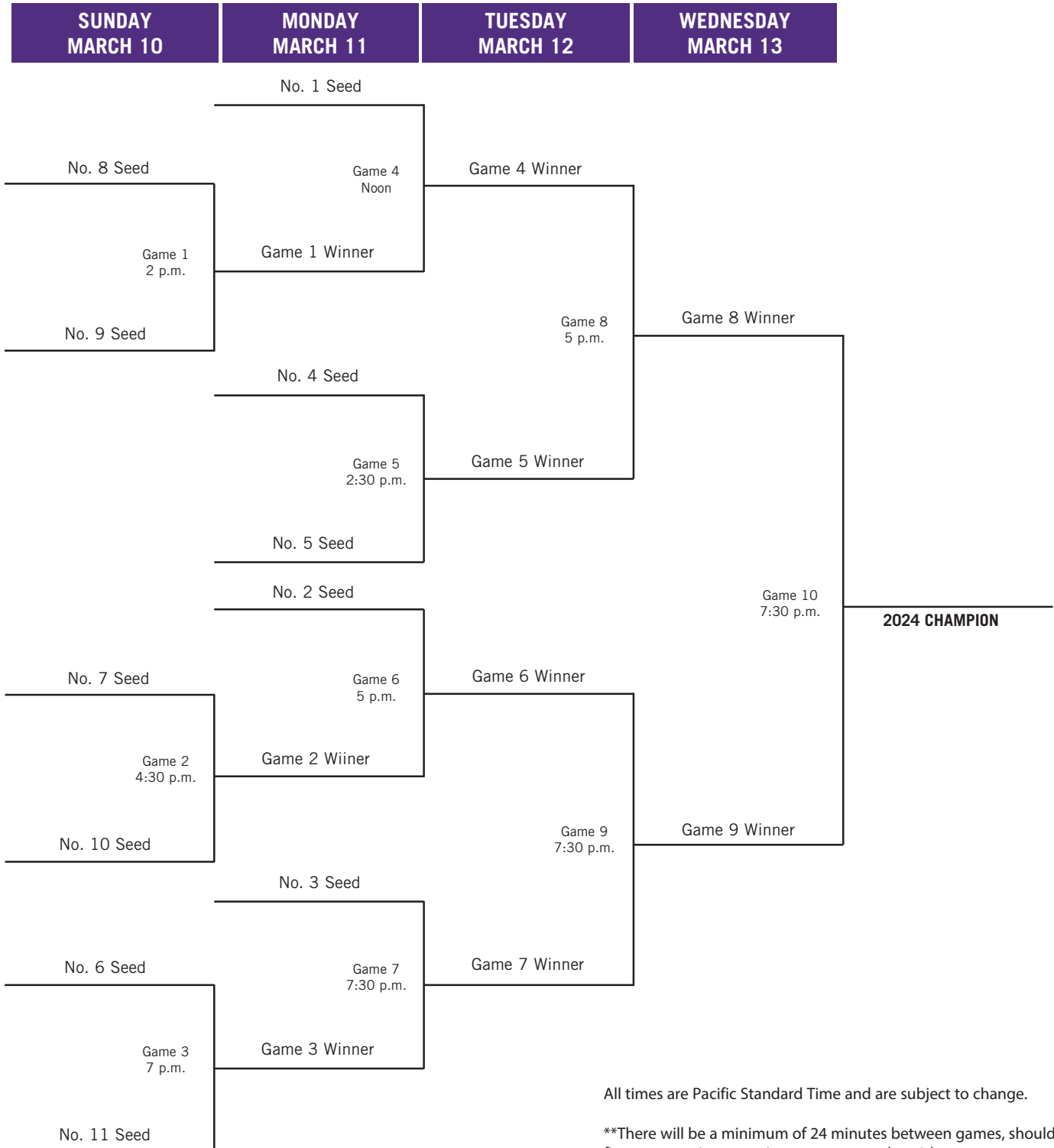

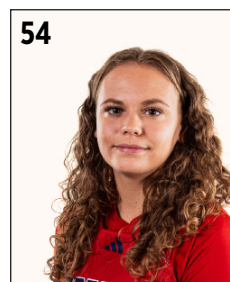

Jaime White enters her tenth season as the head coach of the Fresno State women's basketball program. In her ten seasons with the Bulldogs, White has guided the 'Dogs to three 20-win seasons, five postseason appearances and four appearances in the Mountain West tournament championship game. White holds a .677 winning percentage (96-65) in Mountain West games and has an overall .757 winning percentage at Fresno State (169-128).

As her tenth season begins head coach Jaime White is starting on the stronger side. With a fresh set of players the team is making strong progress to close out non-conference play on a high note. A strong set of freshman starters in Taija Sta. Maria and Kylee Fox, each earning conference honors this season, and a core of veterans to lead in: Sydney Dethman, Franka Wittenberg and Keely Brown.

In her ninth season, Coach White would see her toughest conference record at Fresno State, going 3-15 and a first round elimination to Nevada in the Mountain West Tournament Championship. Fresno State would close out the season on a three game losing streak going 39% from the field (663-of-1701), 29% from the three (163-of-552) and 74% from the foul line (396-of-530).

In the 2021-22 season that was shortened by nearly a month, and saw cancellations, postponements and program shutdowns across the country due to Covid-19, the 'Dogs successfully played 28 of its 30 scheduled games and avoided any program shutdowns during the pandemic while finishing with a 17-11 record (12-6 MW). Under unprecedented conditions, White guided the Bulldogs back to the postseason as one of 32 teams selected to the WNIT. The 'Dogs also returned to the MW Championship game, following an upset of top-seeded New Mexico in the semifinals. Fresno State's offensive production increased to 77.8 per game which ranked 13th in the nation, second-highest in program history. The Bulldogs' efficiency also moved up to 45.2 percent, 26th nationally, and fourth-best at all-time at Fresno State.

For the second consecutive year, Haley and Hanna Cavinder were named to the All-MW Team. Haley was tabbed as the conference's Player of the Year. It was the first time in league history that a player had won the award a year after being selected Freshman of the Year.

White's sixth season in Fresno was a banner year as she guided the Bulldogs to a 25-7 record on the program's first MW regular season championship with a 16-2 record, and only third outright regular season conference title. The 'Dogs also reached their third MW championship game in five seasons. White's team won its first 15 games of league play, the second-longest win streak to open a season for Fresno State. The Bulldogs also won 14 consecutive games from Dec. 28-Feb. 15, a streak that is also second in the program's history. The wins added up as Fresno State averaged its highest scoring average (76.1 ppg) in more than 30 years and posted its second-best free-throw percentage (76.2%) behind only last season's school record. Limiting turnovers was key to the team's offense, breaking program records for assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30) and turnovers per game (12.1).

The Bulldogs racked up their most postseason honors in a season (9) as White was named Coach of the Year, Maddi Utti was selected Player of the Year and Haley Cavinder was tabbed Freshman of the Year. It was just the second time in conference history that a team claimed all three awards in the same season.

Led by Candice White in 2018-19, the senior paced the MW in scoring for the second season in a row with 18.4 points per game, the Bulldogs earned their third trip to the WNIT under White. The 'Dogs finished the year with a 19-13 record after placing fourth in the MW while reaching the semifinals of the conference tournament for the sixth time in their seven seasons in the league. Fresno State averaged 69.7 points per game, the highest during White's tenure. The Bulldogs' scoring was aided by the team shooting a program-record 78.4 percent from the free-throw line.

While Candice White earned her second All-MW selection in her final season, Maddi Utti garnered a honorable mention nod. The sophomore was also selected to the MW All-Defensive Team after being the only player in the league to rank in the top 10 in rebounds, blocks and steals.

With her youngest roster to date, White navigated the 2017-18

season by starting three true freshmen in 24 games, the most of any Division I team during a year in which they finished 17-15. Fresno State finished fourth in the league (11-7) to earn a first-round bye in the tournament for the fifth time in its six years in the conference. The 'Dogs returned to the postseason with a bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational where they captured the program's first postseason win in a true road game at CSU Bakersfield, 77-66.

Junior Candice White led the young group of Bulldogs as she garnered All-MW honors after leading the team in points, rebounds, assists and steals while being one of the most well-rounded players in the conference. She became just the second Fresno State player to score more than 600 points in a season (605). Joining the junior with postseason accolades were freshmen Aly Gamez and Maddi Utti who were both named to the MW All-Freshman Team after being instant impact players for the Bulldogs as each ranked second or third on the team in points, rebounds, assists and steals.

Through an up-and-down 2016-17 season in which the 'Dogs finished 18-15, White's team came together late in the season to propel it to a run of three wins in three days at the MW Tournament to reach its second-straight championship game. Along the way, the Bulldogs became the first No. 7 seed to defeat a No. 2 seed, and the lowest seed to reach the championship game in tournament history.

The Bulldogs were led by two-time MW Defensive Player of the Year, Bego Faz Davalos, and a breakout season from sophomore guard Candice White who earned All-MW honorable mention honors. Faz Davalos ranked in the top 10 in the NCAA in seven stat categories while breaking multiple season and career records at Fresno State and in the Mountain West. White ranked 15th in the NCAA in free-throw percentage and 37th in 3-point percentage. The sophomore's 87.7 percent from the free-throw line set the Fresno State single-season record while also moving into the top 10 in points in a season, 3's made in a season and career 3-point percentage.

White's 2016 squad went 22-12 overall and reached the second round of the WNIT with a 59-53 win over Santa Clara. It was the second consecutive season with a postseason victory for the Bulldogs, a first in the program's history.

A year after turning Fresno State into one of the top defensive teams in the Mountain West, White's defensive brand of basketball set a program low for opponent field-goal percentage (.371) and allowed 59.4 points per game, the team's lowest since 2006 and the third lowest in program history. A big piece to that was the shot blocking of Bego Faz Davalos who was named MW Defensive Player of the Year after leading the NCAA with 136 blocked shots.

Faz Davalos also garnered postseason All-MW honors along with Toni Smith who earned honorable mention accolades and Breanne Knishka who was selected to the MW All-Freshmen Team.

In her first season, White guided the 'Dogs to their seventh consecutive season of 20 or more wins (23) and to the postseason for the eighth consecutive year, reaching the second round of the Women's National Invitational Tournament. The team's 79-73 win over San Francisco at the Save Mart Center in the first round of the WNIT was the program's first postseason win since 2006. During the middle of the season, White's group recorded the second-longest win streak in Fresno State's history at 13 games, an unbeaten stretch that lasted nearly two months. The final win of that streak gave the 'Dogs a 17-3 record to open the season, a mark that ranks as the best 20-game start in school history.

It took White little time to put her stamp on the Bulldogs' defense as her squad was the only team in the conference to finish in the top two in the Mountain West in scoring defense, field goal percentage defense, 3-point percentage defense, blocks and steals during the conference season. The 'Dogs led the MW in scoring defense (55.8 ppg), 3-point defense (.259), block shots (5.7 bpg) and steals (12.3 spg).

Under White's tutelage, a trio of Bulldogs garnered a total of five postseason conference honors, with Alex Sheedy highlighting the group after being named Co-Player of the Year. Sheedy was subsequently also selected to the All-MW team. Fellow senior Raven Fox earned Sixth Player of the Year and was named to the All-Defensive Team. After breaking three conference records
