



Mountain West Men's Basketball Championship – First Round

#9 Fresno State 77, #8 Wyoming 73

Championship Notes

- The No. 9 seed is now 8-10 in the opening round of the MW men's basketball championship, earning its first win since the 2020 tournament.
- The No. 9 seed has never won a MW men's basketball tournament quarterfinal contest, currently sitting at 0-7.

Fresno State Notes

- The Bulldogs advance to the quarterfinals for the third time in the last four years as Fresno State improves to 4-2 in the opening round.
- Fresno State is now 9-10 all-time in the Mountain West tournament, including a 1-1 record as a No. 9 seed.
- As a team, the Bulldogs shot 22-of-23 (.957) at the free-throw line, tying the tournament record set by Wyoming against Air Force on March 9, 2006. This free-throw percentage is an opening round record at the MW tournament.
- In the four-point win, Fresno State ended the game on a 12-1 run over the final 2:54.

Wyoming Notes

- The Cowboys drop to 16-24 all-time in the Mountain West tournament, and a 2-7 mark as a No. 8 seed.
- Senior Mason Walters recorded five steals, tied for the sixth-most in a tournament contest.
