# **Mountain West**

- The Mountain West is one of three conferences (Big 12, 8; MW, 6; SEC, 6) with six or more teams ranked among the top 35 of the current NET rankings.
- The Mountain West is 113-47 (.706) in nonconference action in 2023-24, the third-best nonconference record in league history and best since the 2012-13 season.
- The Mountain West is the only conference to have all its teams finish the nonconference slate with a winning percentage above .500.
- Best in the WEST. The Mountain West is 24-7 against the Pac-12 (6-1) and West Coast Conference (18-6) in 2023-24.

# San Diego State

- San Diego State currently ranks 18 in the NET rankings.
- The Aztecs are 10-9 against Quad 1 and Quad 2 opponents. Eight of nine losses are against Q1 opponents.
- SDSU is 10-8 away from home this season.
- San Diego State's average NET loss is 36 and average opponent NET rank is 22. SDSU's NET SOS is 28.

## **New Mexico**

- New Mexico currently ranks 22 in the NET rankings.
- The Lobos are 7-7 against Quad 1 and Quad 2 opponents this season.
- New Mexico is 12-6 away from home this season.
- UNM ended the nonconference slate with the ninth-best record in the country.

#### **Boise State**

- Boise State currently ranks 26 in the NET rankings.
- The Broncos are 6-5 against Quad 1 opponents, which ranks 19th in the nation. One of 21 teams with at least six Q1 wins.
- Boise State is 7-3 on the road this season, which ranks 14th in the country.
- The Broncos average NET loss is 46, average NET opponent rank is 48 and NET SOS is 50.

#### Nevada

- Nevada currently ranks 35 in the NET rankings.
- The Wolf Pack are 6-6 against Quad 1 opponents this season, which ranks 23rd in D1. One of 21 teams with at least six Q1 wins.
- Nevada finished the nonconference schedule with the fifth-best record in the nation.
- The Wolf Pack are 8-3 on the road this season, which ranks ninth in the country.

# Colorado State

- Colorado State currently ranks 37 in the NET rankings.
- CSU is 9-9 against Quad 1 (6-7) and Quad 2 opponents. One of 21 teams with at least six Q1 wins.
- The Rams have an average opponent NET rank of 45 and an average NET loss of 44.
- The Rams finished nonconference action with the 11th-best record in the country.

## **Utah State**

- Utah State currently ranks 39 in the NET rankings.
- USU won its first outright MW regular-season title in program history this season.
- The Aggies are 8-6against Quad 1 (4-5) and Quad 2 opponents. USU's average NET loss is 31.
- Utah State is 8-4 on the road, which ranks in the top 20 of country.
