MW BY THE NUMBERS

- 1** In 2023, San Diego State made the Mountain West's **first** Final Four appearance in league history. The Aztecs advanced to the title game before losing to UConn.
- 1** San Diego State's run in the 2023 NCAA tournament marked the Mountain West's **first** appearance in the Elite Eight in Conference history.
- 6** Mountain West programs have won **six** nonconference tournaments this season.
- 8** The Mountain West has **eight** NCAA Sweet 16 appearances in league history. San Diego State has reached the Sweet 16 two seasons in a row.
- 8** The Mountain West has had **eight** Oscar Robertson National Players of the Week in 2023-24.
- 10** The Mountain West has earned a record **10** units in the 2024 NCAA tournament. This season marks the third year in a row the MW has earned at least four units, including at least eight each of the last two tournaments.
- 10** This marks the **11th** poll this year that the Mountain West has had at least two teams ranked in the *Associated Press* poll.
- 34** With UNLV's bid to the 2024 NIT, the Mountain West has made **34** NIT appearances in Conference history.
- 60** Mountain West teams have posted **60** wins by 20 or more points this season.
- 65** With six teams in the NCAA tournament, the Mountain West has **65** NCAA appearances in league history.

MOUNTAIN WEST NOTEBOOK

- San Diego State made its second consecutive appearance in the NCAA Sweet 16, marking the first time in Mountain West history that a team advanced to the Round of 16 two seasons in row.
- For the first time in league history, three different MW teams (Colorado State, San Diego State and Utah State) recorded a win in the NCAA tournament.
- A record six Mountain West teams earned bids to the 2024 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament, marking the most NCAA bids in league history and the most since earning five in 2012-13.
- The Mountain West's six NCAA tournament bids in 2024 are tied with the Big Ten for the third-most, trailing the Big 12 and SEC, each with eight bids apiece.
- For the third consecutive season, the Mountain West sent four or more teams to the NCAA tournament.
- 2023-24 marked the sixth season in a row and the 21st in Conference history the league has had two or more NCAA bids.
- UNLV was the seventh MW team to earn a postseason berth after accepting an invite to play in the NIT.
- This was the second time since 2000 that the Mountain West has had seven teams playing in the postseason and the first since 2013.
- With six teams in the NCAA tournament, the Mountain West has 65 NCAA appearances in league history.
- With UNLV's bid to the 2024 NIT, the Mountain West has 34 NIT appearances in Conference history.
- The Mountain West is 120-55 (.686) in nonconference action in 2023-24, the sixth-best nonconference record in league history and the best since 2012-13.
- Best in the WEST. The Mountain West is 24-8 against the Pac-12 (6-2) and West Coast Conference (18-6) in 2023-24.
- The Mountain West was the only conference to have all its teams finish the nonconference slate with a winning percentage above .500.
- San Diego State concluded the 2023-24 season ranked No. 17 in the *Associated Press* poll and No. 18 in the *USA Today* Coaches poll, while Utah State finished the season No. 22 in the *AP* poll and No. 20 in the coaches poll.
- Boise State, Colorado State, Nevada and New Mexico are receiving votes in the national polls.
