Mountain West Men's Basketball Championship – Quarterfinals Postgame Notes | March 13 #3 Utah State 70, #6 UNLV 58

Championship Notes

• The No. 3 seed is now 14-12 in the quarterfinal round of the MW men's basketball championship.

Utah State Notes

- Utah State earned a spot in the MW tournament semifinals for the seventh time in the last eight seasons, including three straight appearances.
- The Aggies defense held the Runnin' Rebels scoreless over the final 6 minutes, 20 seconds of the game.
- Thursday marked the sixth time this season that the Aggies held an opponent to fewer than 60 points.
- Utah State improved to 18-9 all-time in the MW championship.

UNLV Notes

- UNLV is now 30-22 all-time in MW tournament history.
- UNLV is the first team to have multiple players make 9+ free throws in a MW Tournament game since Boise State did so against Nevada in 2014.
- The Runnin' Rebels played seven players on Thursday night, including three which played the full 40 minutes.
- Forward **Jalen Hill** played every minute on Thursday evening, after playing 40 minutes in each of his last two games. He is one of two UNLV players this century to play 40-plus minutes in three straight games, joining Justin Webster (March 4-9, 2023).
- UNLV's field-goal percentage of 23.6% was the second lowest in a MW tournament game all-time.
