Mountain West Men's Basketball Championship – Quarterfinals Postgame Notes | March 13 #1 New Mexico 63, #8 San José State 52

Championship Notes

- The No. 1 seed is now 24-1 in the quarterfinals of the MW men's basketball championship, with the lone loss coming back in 2004.
- The No. 8 is 1-14 in the MW tournament guarterfinals all-time.

New Mexico Notes

- **Donovan Dent**, the MW Player of the Year, finished with 25 points and five assists in the victory. This was Dent's 32nd consecutive game with at least 10 points and two assists, the longest such streak in MW history and the longest active streak in Division I.
- **Nelly Junior Joseph** pulled down 18 rebounds, his third straight game with at least 15 rebounds, tied for the longest such streak in MW history.

- The 18 rebounds are tied for the third-most in a single MW tournament game all-time. Eight of his 18 rebounds were offensive boards, tying for the fourth-most in a single game in MW tournament history and the most since Nevada's AJ West pulled down 12 on March 11, 2015 vs. UNLV.
- He also scored 14 points to record his 16th double-double of the season, which leads the MW. The 16 double-doubles are the most in a season by a UNM player since Drew Gordon had 19 in 2011-12.
- The Lobos have outscored its opponent in 10 consecutive halves in MW tournament games, the longest such streak all-time.
- New Mexico, which has earned a spot in the semifinals for the second straight year, improved to 23-20 in MW tournament games.
