### LADY REBELS BEGIN MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIPS ON MONDAY

The UNLV Lady Rebels are ready to start their run to defend the Mountain West tournament title on Monday, March 10 after clinching the No. 1 seed for the fourth consecutive year to earn a first-round bye. The Scarlet & Gray will begin tournament play against No.8 Boise State on Monday, March 10 at 12 p.m.

UNLY won the Mountain West tournament title the past three tournaments for the first time ever in program history and only the second time in league history.

SQUAD LEADERS: UNLV currently has five players scoring in double-figures and are led by Amarachi Kimpson with 13.9 points per game. Kiara Jackson is the second leading scorer who is averaging 12.6 points per game and leads the Lady Rebels in assists with 5.0 per game and field goals made with 5.0 per game. Alyssa Brown leads the squad in rebounds, bringing down 7.8 per game. Meadow Roland is second for the Lady Rebels in rebounds with 6.1 per game.

league history and first in UNLV history, the Lady Rebels were honored for their accomplishments by the conference's coaches tying a school-record for the second consecutive season, and earned three MW best of the year honors, the league announced Sunday. Head coach Lindy La Rocque was named MW Coach of the Year for the third time in her five seasons at the helm and Meadow Roland was named the league's Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year. This is the second time in program history that a Lady Rebel has earned Freshman and Sixth player of the year in the same season. This marks the second straight year

the Scarlet & Gray collected Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year. UNLV has now collected four straight Sixth Player of the Year nods and a combined five Freshman of the Year nods. La Rocaue is the first coach in MW history to be named Coach of the Year three times in just her first five seasons, and marks the second time in program history UNLV has collected three Coach of the Year accolades. In addition, senior Kiara Jackson and sophomore Amarachi Kimpson were selected to the All-Mountain West team. Senior Alyssa Brown picked up All-Mountain West honorable mention and All-Defensive team accolades and Roland was also named to the All-Freshman squad.

THREE'S A CHARM AGAIN: After completing the four-peat Mountain West regular season title for only the second time in

FOUR-PEAT MW REGULAR SEASON CHAMPS: The Lady Rebels secured the No. 1 seed for the Mountain West Basketball Championships and the regular season title for the fourth straight year. UNLV defeated Boise State 83-53 to clinch and move to 15-1 overall in the MW standings. This marks the first time in program history the Scarlet & Gray claimed the MW regular season title and the second time in MW history and first time since Colorado State's four-peat in 2014-17.

**NON-CONFERENCE WRAP:** The Lady Rebels played the 23rd toughest non-conference schedule in the nation finishing with a solid 8-4 performance. UNLV collected two double-digit wins over Power Conference teams with 19-point wins over both UCF (Big 12) and DePaul (Big East). The Scarlet & Gray played opponents from nine different conferences in their nonconference slate.

JACKSON KEEPS DISHIN': Senior guard Kiara Jackson is the only Mountain West player thus far this season to record three nine assist games this season. Her first came against UCF on Nov. 27, the second was at Baylor on Dec. 8 and the most recent was at New Mexico on Jan. 12. Jackson's career-high of single-game assists is nine which happened twice last season. She also jumped into the top-10 all-time in career assists with a total of 449 and counting. She is currently in sole possession of third on the all-time list.

WELCOME TO THE 1K CLUB, KIARA JACKSON: Kiara Jackson collected her 1,000 career point in a Lady Rebels uniform on Wednesday, Dec. 29 in the Mountain West opener versus Fresno State. She became the 27th Lady Rebel in history to reach the 1K mark. Jackson had 10 points to total 1,006 career points in the 78-53 victory over the Bulldogs.

JACKSON JUMPS INTO TOP-25 ALL-TIME SCORING: After collecting her 1,000th career point, Kiara Jackson has not let off the gas when it comes to scoring. She dropped 20 points the game after against San Jose State on Jan. 1, and was 12 points away from tying 25th all-time in scoring. Against Boise State, Jackson put up 18 points to lead the Lady Rebels in a 61-57 victory. Jackson currently has 1,227 career points, which is good for 21st all-time.

LADY REBELS' DOUBLE-DIGIT WINS OVER POWER CONFERENCE TEAMS: UNLY has 19-point wins over both UCF (Big 12) and DePaul (Big East) this season. That is tied for the most wins by that margin or more against power conference teams in a single season in Mountain West history (ACC, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12, SEC).

WEEKLY HONORS: Redshirt freshman Meadow Roland was named MW Freshman of the Week on March 3 after leading the Lady Rebels to a 2-0 week averaging 20.0 points per game. She shot 62.5% from the field (15-for-24), and 10-for-11 (90.09) from the free throw line. Roland was third on the squad through two games in rebounds averaging 6.0 boards per game.

Redshirt freshman Meadow Roland was named back-to-back MW Freshman of the Week on Feb. 10 after leading the Lady Rebels to a 2-0 week averaging 14.5 points per game and 8.0 rebounds per game. She shot 63.2% from the field, 33.3% from the three and 66.7% from the charity stripe.

Redshirt freshman Meadow Roland notched the third Mountain West weekly honor for the Lady Rebels this season as she was named MW Freshman of the Week on Feb. 3 after leading UNLV with a career-high 17 points in a 68-59 win over UNR. She shot 7-for-9 from the field and did not miss a shot from the three-point line (1 of 1) and charity stripe (2 of 2). She also led the Scarlet & Gray in rebounds with nine and the Lady Rebels' lone block of the game.

Graduate guard Aaliyah Alexander tabbed the second Mountain West accolade for the Lady Rebels this season as she was named MW Player of the Week on Dec. 16 after putting up a season-high 25 points to lead UNLV to a 80-61 victory over DePaul. She shot 8-for-10 from the field, did not miss a three-pointer (3-for-3) and was 6-for-10 from the free throw line. Her 25 points against the Blue Demons have been the most thus far this season in a game by a Lady Rebel. She was only six points away from tying her career-high she set at Eastern Washington.

Redshirt freshman forward Meadow Roland collected the first Mountain West Freshman of the Week accolade on Nov. 11 after helping UNLV to a 2-0 start. Roland earned her first career double-double in her debut for the Lady Rebels with 11 points and 10 rebounds against LMU. She then had another double-figure rebounding night against NAU bringing down a season/ career-high 16 boards. Roland led the Lady Rebels in rebounds through two games.

WHAT UP SQUAD?: The Lady Rebels return 10 of the 14 players from its 2024 championship squad, including two starters and Mountain West Sixth Player and Freshman of the Year Amarachi Kimpson. UNLV added two freshmen guards Teagan Colvin and Elli Guiney, and junior transfer Aaliyah Alexander from Eastern Washington.

**THE PRESEASON POLLS:** For the second straight season, the Lady Rebels are receiving votes in the USA Today Coaches' poll. The Lady Rebels are receiving four points in the coaches poll (equivalent to No. 44). During the 2023-24 campaign, the Lady Rebels appeared in either the Associated Press or USA Today/WBCA poll seven times, which included a No. 20 AP ranking and No. 19 WBCA ranking as they headed into the NCAA Tournament. UNLV closed out the season ranked No. 24 in the WBCA Poll.

**MOUNTAIN WEST PRESEASON FAVS:** The Lady Rebels have been picked for the top spot of the Mountain West for the 2024-25 campaign, the league's predicted order of finish and preseason awards were released Wednesday morning prior to the MW Media Day at Resorts World on Oct. 16. UNLV is looking to defend its title for the fourth consecutive season and this marks the third straight season the Lady Rebels have been picked no. 1 in the preseason poll. UNLV was voted atop the league standings by media members and coaches, receiving 21 of 30 first-place votes and a total of 298 points. Individually, the Lady Rebels received three accolades with senior forward Alyssa Brown, senior guard Kiara Jackson and sophomore guard Amarachi Kimpson were all selected to the Preseason All-MW Team.

**THREE-PEAT LAST SEASON:** The Lady Rebels have continued to bring the heat last season, which culminated with a third consecutive Mountain West Regular Season and Tournament Titles. UNLV became the first program in MW history to claim both titles in three straight seasons. The Scarlet & Gray earned its third automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, a first in both program and league history. The Lady Rebels finished the season only one of two squads to have two (South Carolina) straight seasons with 30 wins. UNLV earned its highest ranking in both the AP and Coaches Poll coming in at No. 20 and No. 19. The Lady Rebels appeared in the Top-25 eight times this season and came into the season receiving votes for the first time in 19 years. UNLV claimed the MW's Player of the Year in Desi-Rae Young, and Sixth and Freshman of the Year with Amarachi Kimspon. Kiara Jackson earned All-MW team accolades and Alyssa Brown was named MW Tournament MVP.

### GAME 30 RECAP: LADY REBELS FALL 71-66 IN REGULAR SEASON FINALE AT WYOMING

The UNLV women's basketball team fell 71-66 in the regular season finale at Wyoming on Wednesday evening at Arena-Auditorium. Amarachi Kimpson led the Lady Rebels with 24 points by shooting 9-for-16 from the field, 2-for-4 from the three and was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line. Aaliyah Alexander was the second-leading scorer on the night with 12 points, as she shot 5-for-10 from the field, 1-for-2 from long range and was 1-for-1 at the charity stripe. Meadow Roland came off the bench and scored 11 points for the Scarlet & Gray. Alyssa Brown brought down 10 rebounds, which led the team.

#### GAME 29 RECAP: LADY REBELS WIN 89-56 ON SENIOR DAY VERSUS SAN JOSE STATE

The UNLV women's basketball team earned its eighth straight win after collecting an 89-5 victory over San Jose State on Saturday afternoon in a packed Cox Pavilion. Following the game, the Lady Rebels honored senior Alyssa Brown, Kiara Jackson, Macie James and Kenadee Winfrey. The Scarlet & Gray had four players in double-figures and were led by Meadow Roland's career-high 24 points. Roland shot 8-for-11 from the field and was a perfect 8-for-8 at the free throw line. McKinna Brackens and Kiara Jackson each had 15 points on the day. Jackson led the squad in assists with six, while Alyssa Brown led the squad in rebounds with 13. respectively. Amarachi Kimpson had 10 points against the Spartans and two steals.

### GAME 28 RECAP: LADY REBELS SECURE REGULAR SEASON TITLE AND NO. 1 MW SEED

The UNLV Lady Rebels secured the Mountain West Regular Season title and the No. 1 seed in the conference tournament for the fourth straight year, after a dominant 83-53 victory over Boise State on Wednesday night at Cox Pavilion. Amarachi Kimpson dropped 23 points to lead the Lady Rebels and shot 10-for-11 from the field and was a perfect 3-for-3 from the three-point line. Kimpson also dished four assists and had three steals on the night. Meadow Roland came off the bench and scored 16 points and brought down six rebounds. Kiara Jackson and Macy Spencer each had 12 points. Jackson also had four assists and three steals. Alyssa Brown led the squad in rebounds with 10 boards and tied her career-high in blocked shots with five.

### GAME 27 RECAP: LADY REBELS DEFEAT COLORADO STATE 69-65

The UNLV Lady Rebels have won their sixth straight game after defeating Colorado State 69-65 on Saturday afternoon at Moby Arena. The Scarlet & Gray completed the two-game regular season sweep over the Rams. With the victory against the Rams, the Lady Rebels clinched a share of the regular season title. The Lady Rebels again had four players in double-digits and were led by McKinna Brackens' who had 18 points. Brackens shot 5-for-10 from the field, 2-for-4 from the three and 6-for-8 from the free throw line. Aaliyah Alexander was second on the squad with 14 points, while Alssya Brown picked up her fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds. Brown did not miss a shot against the Rams, going 4-for-4 from the field and the three-point line. Amarachi Kimpson collected 10 points for the Lady Rebels and was second on the squad in rebounds with seven.

#### GAME 26 RECAP: LADY REBELS WIN 64-50 OVER UNR

The UNLV Lady Rebels collected a 64-50 victory over in-state rival UNR on Saturday afternoon at Lawlor Events Center. The Scarlet & Gray completed the two-game regular season sweep over the Wolf Pack. This game is part of the Silver State series presented by America First. UNLV had four players put up double-digit points and were led by Aaliyah Alexander who had 18 points. Alexander shot 7-for-12 from the field, 2-for-4 from the three-point line and was 2-for-2 from the charity stripe. Kiara Jakckson and Amarachi Kimpson each had 12 points, while McKinna Brackens put up 11 points. Jackson led the squad in assists with three and Meadow Roland was the leading rebounder with seven boards. Brown had four steals out of the Lady Rebels 11 total.

#### 2023-24: HISTORY CONTINUES: THREE-PEAT REGULAR AND TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS

- UNLV became the first team in Mountain West history to win both the regular season and tournament championship in three consecutive seasons with a 66-49 win over San Diego State in the MW Championship Game.
- Earned the third straight NCAA automatic bid for the first time since 1989-91. The Lady Rebels earned their highest seeding at No. 10 in the NCAA Championship First Round since 1994.
- Alyssa Brown was named MVP of the Mountain West Championship tournament and was joined on the all-tournament team by Amarachi Kimpson and Desi-Rae Young.
- UNLV earned its highest ranking in both the AP and Coaches Poll coming in at No. 20 and No. 19. The Lady Rebels appeared in the Top-25 eight times this season and came into the season receiving votes for the first time in 19 years.
- The Lady Rebels were in the AP Top-25 for four straight weeks from Feb. 26, 2024-March 18; UNLV was in the WBCA USA Today Coaches Top-25 Poll for five straight weeks from Feb. 27, 2024- April 8, 2024.
- The Lady Rebels have a 30-3 overall record and are one of only two (South Carolina) teams to collect back-to-back seasons with 30 wins. It is the first time in UNLV history to earn 30 or more wins in consecutive seasons.
- The Lady Rebels closed out the season receiving votes in the Associated Press Poll and No. 24 in the WBCA Coaches Poll.
- UNLV has a 19-0 MW road record dating back to the 2021-22 season.
- The Lady Rebels finished non-conference with 10 wins for the second consecutive season.
- UNLV marked a new program record in three-pointers made in a single game for the second time under La Rocque.
  This season, UNLV drained 16 as a team against Utah Tech on Nov. 14 and against San Diego State on March 3 and
  individually, Alyssa Durazo-Frescas marked a new single-game record in three-pointers going 8-for-11 at San Diego
  on Nov. 25.
- UNLV made 257 3-pointers, breaking the previous record for 3-pointers made of 223 which was set last season.
- UNLV's .769 free throw percentage surpassed the previous program record set last season (.763).
- UNLV's .464 field goal percentage (all games) eclipsed last season's field goal percentage (.461).
- The Lady Rebels ranked in the top 10 of all Division I in scoring defense (3rd), fouls per game (3rd), winning
  percentage (3rd), scoring margin (4th), assist/turnover ratio (7th), field goal percentage defense (9th), and
  defensive rebounds per game (9th).
- UNLV's 1,439 points and 79.9 points per game were the highest totals set in MW conference-only games.
- UNLV led the Mountain West in assist/turnover ratio, field goal percentage defense, fouls per game, defensive
  rebounds per game, scoring defense, scoring margin, scoring offense, three point percentage, three point percentage, three pointers per game, turnovers per game, winning percentage, and was second in six other statistical
  categories.
- Kiara Jackson led the nation and MW in Assist/Turnover Ratio (3.49).
- Alyssa Brown ranked in the top 25 nationally in total blocks and defensive rebounds per game.
- Senior Desi-Rae Young took sole possession of second on the all-time scoring leader list and has 2,017 career points and 1,081 rebounds (4th)
- Young earned her second Mountain West Player of the Year award and Freshman Amarachi Kimpson picked up
  Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year. This is the first time a Lady Rebel has earned Freshman and Sixth player of
  the year in the same season.
- Young led the conference in steals (44) and total rebounds (290).
- Head Coach Lindy La Rocque notched her 100th victory at UNLY in a 83-35 victory against Fresno State on Mar.11.
- Lindy La Rocque is the first Lady Rebels head coach to reach 100 wins in just her first four seasons.




