OPENING TIP

- Colorado State advanced to its third Mountain West title game with a wire to wire 83-72 win over Utah State Friday night.
- The other two times the Rams were in the title game was 2003 and 2017.
- CSU has been the second seed three previous times (2013, 2017, 2022) holding a 6-3 record as it making the championship game in 2017.
- Colorado State has won the Mountain West Tournament once, back in 2003 as the No. 6 seed.
- The Rams extended their win streak to nine-games and are winners of 13 of the past 15 games.
- During the win streak, CSU has won every game by at least eight points, the longest such streak in program history.
- CSU won a program-best seven Mountain West road games this season.
- During the nine-game streak, the Rams' defense is allowing just 62.0 points per game and holding opponents to 40.9% leading to a margin of victory of 17.3 points.
- Two Rams earned All-Mountain West honors in Nique Clifford and Kyan Evans. Clifford was unanimous first team selection and on the all-defense team, while Evans earned honorable mention.
- Colorado State has the longest active streak of having a player on the first team All-Mountain West list at seven years. Nico Carvacho (2019-20), David Roddy (2021-22), Isaiah Stevens (2023-24) and Nique Clifford (2025)
- Clifford also picked up the Mountain West Player of the Week honor after he averaged 25.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals on 70.4% shooting.
- He tied former Ram Emmanuel Omogbo (3) with most double-doubles in the Mountain West Tournament for the program. Clifford scored 26 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to go with six assists and a steal.
- Clifford is averaging 18.8 points, 9.8 rebounds, 4.4 assists and 1.2 steals per game.
- He became the first Ram in program history to have 500 points, 300 rebounds and 100 assists. Clifford is also the only Division I players to have 575 points, 300 rebounds and 125 assists this season.
- Clifford became the fourth player in program history to eclipse the 600 point mark in a season. Hie is currently third on the list with 622.
- Clifford is third in the nation with 8.39 defensive rebounds per game and 12th for total rebounds at 9.8.
- Kyan Evans had his 11th straight double figures scoring game with 14 points and seventh straight with multiple 3s going 4-of-5, matching his career-high for makes.
- Evans found his way during conference season averaging 12.0 points and 3.4 assists while shooting 45.2% behind the arc.
- Jalen Lake is having a strong senior season averaging 11.3 points on 42.1% shooting including 34.1% from behind the arc. He had 14 points on 5-of-8 shooting in the semifinal win.
- The Rams are averaging 16.7 assists per game to rank 25th in the nation. Their assist rate of 62.8% is the eighth best in the NCAA.
- CSU ranks 21st in the nation making 77.8% of its free throw attempts this season.
- Head coach Niko Medved is in his seventh year leading Colorado State. He is 141-84 as the Rams' head coach. He has the second most wins in program history, trailing only Jim Williams (1955-80) and his 352.
- He became the fifth coach at CSU to reach 100 wins and only coach to have five season's of 20 wins.

Niko Medved

Head Coach (220-171 overall, 141-84 at CSU)
12th Season Overall, Seventh at CSU

Niko Medved became the 10th coach in Colorado State men's basketball history in March of 2018. Returning to Fort Collins after he was an assistant coach from 2007-13.

In his six years in charge of the Rams, he has compiled a 117-75 record including a trip to the NCAA Tournament in 2022 and 2024 and advancing to the NIT semifinals in 2021. The NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022 was the program's first in nine seasons. In 2024, The Rams earned their first win in the NCAA Tournament since 2012 defeating Virginia in the First Four. Over his first four years in Fort Collins, he saw his team's wins improve year over year.

Medved has a great record of developing talent having coached 18 all-conference selections, three conference players of the year and five NABC and USBWA all-district selections over his 11-year head coaching career. This long list of players includes 2021 All-America selection, David Roddy.

Roddy earned Colorado State's first All-America honors since Gian Clavell in 2017 and was just the fifth player in CSU history to be an All-American. He went on to be Medved's first NBA Draft pick, being selected by the Memphis Grizzlies with the 23rd overall pick in 2022.

Along with Roddy, Medved recruited and developed Colorado State's all-time leader in scoring and assists, Isaiah Stevens. Stevens is the lone player in Mountain West history to earn All-Conference honors five-times, including making the first team in 2023 and 2024. He ended his career with 2,350 points and 853 assists.

Medved's 2023-24 team saw Colorado State men's basketball reach new heights. CSU ascended to its highest ranking in program history at No. 13 and 12 in the AP and Coaches Poll, respectively. The rise in the polls came after a 9-0 start that including wins over Creighton and Colorado. The win over No. 8/7 Creighton on Thanksgiving was the program's first victory over a top 10 team since 1984, and second highest ranked win ever. CSU went on to earn its second NCAA Tournament bid in three seasons as an at-large selection. The Rams defeated Virginia in the First Four in the program's first NCAA Tournament win since 2012.

The 2021-22 season was a special one for Colorado State going 25-6 and making the NCAA Tournament. Medved earned USBWA District Coach of the Year honors. David Roddy was the Mountain West Player of the Year along with a finalist for the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year, Lute Olson National Player of the Year and John Wooden Award. Meanwhile, Isaiah Stevens was a finalist for the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year.

Medved helped the Rams improve from 11 to 12 wins in his first season at the helm of the Green and Gold but took it to another level posting three straight 20-win seasons.

He made his head coaching debut at Furman, leading the Paladins from 2013-16. He had an overall record of 62-70 at Furman, taking them to the CIT in 2016 and 2017 and earning the Southern Conference Coach of the Years honor in 2017. He twice coached the SoCon Player of the Year.

Before returning to Colorado State, Medved spent one year at Drake for the 2016-17 season. He saw instant success with the Bulldogs going 17-17 and leading them to their first postseason tournament in six years competing in the CIT.

Medved started his coaching career at the University of Minnesota as a student manager and assistant before taking his first full-time job at Macalester College. He became an assistant coach at Furman, Minnesota and CSU before becoming a head coach.

During his stint as an assistant coach with Colorado State, Medved was on staff for teams that went to five straight postseason tournaments, including back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in his final two seasons.

He earned his bachelor's degree and master's degree from Minnesota in kinesiology and sport management, respectively.

Medved and his wife Erica have two daughters, Aly and Taylor.

Last Time Out

Colorado State led wire-to-wire in its semifinal win over Utah State Friday night 83-72.

The Rams had a dominate first half and grew its lead to 28 points before Utah State cut it to single digits late, but it was too little too late sending CSU to its first Mountain West title game since 2017.

The trio of Nique Clifford (26), Kyan Evans (14) and Jalen Lake (14) led the team. Clifford picked up his 15th double-double of the year with 26 points and 11 rebounds.

Scouting the Broncos

Boise State upset top-seed New Mexico in the semifinals to advance to Saturday's title game 72-69.

Three-time first team All-Mountain West selection Tyson Degenhart is the guy for Boise State averaging 17.8 points and 6.1 rebounds to lead the team.

Point guard Alvaro Cardenas pulls the strings for the Broncos offense averaging 6.9 assists while scoring 12.0 points per game.

History against Boise State

The series between Colorado State and Boise State has been a tight one. The Broncos hold a slight 18-17 advantage, but CSU has won the last three matchups including both this season.

The Rams defeated BSU just a week ago in Boise 83-73 thanks to Nique Clifford's 36-point performance. CSU won at home on Jalen Lakes last second 3-pointer 75-72.

CSU and BSU have met twice in the Mountain West Tournament splitting the affairs. Colorado State won in the quarterfinals in 2016 and Boise State in the 2019 opening round.

Rams against the Mountain West

Part of the original eight founding members of the conference, CSU has been in the Mountain West since 1999. The Rams are 451-472 all-time against current conference members.

Since the conferences inception, Colorado State is 255-222.

CSU in the Mountain West Tournament

Colorado State is 21-24 all-time in the Mountain West Tournament. The Rams have won it one time in 2003 as the No. 6 seed.

This is the fourth time CSU has earned the No. 2 seed and holds a record of 6-3 as it.

Saturday marks the team's third appearance in the title game. Colorado State won it in 2003 against UNLV and lost to Nevada in 2017.

20 Win Season

Colorado State picked up its fifth 20 win season under head coach Niko Medved with its win over Utah State on March 1. It is the most 20 win seasons by any coach in program history.

The 24 wins this season is tied for the fifth most in program history.

Nique Clifford enjoyed his first season in the green and gold on his way to a third team All-Mountain West honor. Clifford averaged 12.2 points and 7.6 rebounds for the Rams while shooting 52.2% from the field and 37.6% behind the arc.

Clifford had the second-largest improvement in shooting efficiency in the NCAA last year at 14.4%. He went from 37.4% in 2022-23 at Colorado to 52.2% last year with the Rams.

He proved he was one of the top players in the league this season earning first team All-Mountain West honors along with being on the all-defensive team.

Clifford is leading the team averaging 18.8 points, 9.8 rebounds and 4.4 assists per game. He is third in the nation with 8.39 defensive rebounds a game. The 9.8 total rebounds have him 12th in the nation.

In the history of NCAA Division I basketball, a player has averaged 17.5 points, 9.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists as Clifford currently is doing

just 25 times. Others on that list include Oscar Robertson and Larry Bird twice, along with Jerry West and Bill Walton.

He is the only player in the NCAA this season that has scored 600 points, grabbed 300 rebounds and dished out 125 assists.

Clifford is the first player in CSU men's basketball history to record a season of 500 points, 300 rebounds and 100 assists.

He became the fourth occurrence in program history to score 600 points on the year.

He had a team-leading nine double-doubles last year including a 17 points, 10 rebounds, six assists performance against Virginia in the First Four.

Clifford surpassed the 1,000 career points mark in his 25 point performance against TCU. He now has 1,500 overall with 1,060 of them in the Green & Gold.

Clifford wasted no time reintroducing himself to Rams fans, opening the season with a 20 points and 14 rebounds double-double. The 14 rebounds matched a career-high while he shot 75.9% (9-12).

He helped will the Rams to an overtime win over Tennessee State with a career-high 31 points. He was the first Ram since Isaiah Stevens in 2023 to reach the 30-point mark. He collected his second double-double of the season in the win with 13 rebounds.

Clifford did a little bit of everything for Colorado State in its 76-72 overtime win against TCU. He recorded his third double-double of the year with 25 points and 12 rebounds. The fifth-year added in six assists and three blocks to his stat line.

The 5th-year had a double-double by halftime and recorded his fourth of the season with 19 points, career-high 17 rebounds and six assists in the win over LMU.

He was the first Ram since Nico Carvacho to grab 15+ rebounds in 2020.

Clifford had at least seven rebounds in 22

Colorado State Athletics is honoring Lt. Col. John Mosley in 2024-25. The department is retiring his No. 14 across all sports. Any current student-athlete with the No. 14 will wear the number until their eligibility is up.

Pioneer, patriot, ground-breaker, legend -- All words which describe Colorado State great Lt. Col. John Mosley. He came to Colorado A&M, at the time, in 1939 where he played football and wrestling. Lt. Col. Mosely was the second African American wrestler in school and state history and the first african american to earn a letter in football at CSU.

HONORING LT. COL. JOHN MOSLEY

He went on to serve his country upon graduation. He enrolled in the Tuskegee flight training school coming an airman. He served in the Korean and Vietnam Wars.

CSU developed the Lt. Col. John Mosley Mentoring Program as a resource for Black Student-Athletes and to serve and welcome all student-athletes in 2011. Lt. Col. Mosley died at the age of 93 on May 22, 2015.

straight games, the fourth MW player to have at least 20 straight such games. Two of the other three also played at Colorado State (Nico Carvacho, 24 & 23) and David Roddy (22). The other was Nevada's AJ West (23).

His fifth double-doubles of the year came against VCU when Clifford posted a line of 12 points, 10 rebounds, four assists, two steals and a block.

Clifford helped the Rams open conference play with a win recording his sixth double-double of the year scoring 16 points and grabbing 12 rebounds.

The Colorado Springs native capped off 2024 with his seventh double-double of the year against San Jose State. He scored 22 points on a smooth 8-for-11 shooting while grabbing 10 rebounds in the win.

He had a complete impact on all aspects of the team's win over UNLV at home. He tied for the game-lead with 22 points while adding in seven assists, five rebounds and four steals. Clifford matched his career-highs for assists (7), steals (4) and made 3-pointers (4) in the win.

Clifford has recorded a double-double every time he has faced Wyoming. In this season's first installment of the Border War, he finished with 23 points, 11 rebounds, five assists and a steal. It was his eighth double-double of the year.

He made it his third 20 point game in the past four when he poured in 20 against Boise State. Clifford had a complete performance in the 75-72 win matching his career-high in assists with seven and grabbing seven rebounds.

Clifford rounded out the week of January 20 with a 24 points, eight rebound, seven assist and two steal performance in a win over Fresno State. For the week he posted a stat line of 22.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 7.0 apg, a 4.7 assist-to-turnover ratio while shooting 48.8% from the field and 40.0 from behind the arc.

For the third straight game, he scored 20 plus points to go with seven or more rebounds and seven assists in the win over Air Force. His final line was 22 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists.

Clifford is the only player in Mountain West history to record three straight games of at least 20 points, seven rebounds and seven assists.

He followed up a tough game at New Mexico with his 10th double-double of the season to help the Rams defend its home court with 21 points, 13 rebounds, three steals and two assists.

Clifford had another eye popping stat line against Utah State in Logan with his 24 points and 16 rebounds as the Rams comeback fall short.

He made it a perfect 4-for-4 on double-doubles against Wyoming with his 22 points, 11 rebounds, five assists and steal performance in the team's 35-point win inside Moby Arena.

His 13th double-double of the year came at UNLV when he scored 12 of his 14 points in the second half adding in 14 rebounds and five assists.

Clifford put on a show in the second half of a blowout win over Utah State at home with 19 of his 26 points in the final 20 minutes. He finished the game with the 26 points, career-high nine assists, six rebounds, two blocks and a steal.

His final game inside Moby Arena did not disappoint as he led the team with 15 points to go along with six rebounds, six assists and three steals.

He turned in one of the best performances ever by a Ram in the road win at Boise State. Clifford scored 36 points on 72.2% shooting to help CSU earn the No. 2 seed in the Mountain West Tournament.

Clifford joined Emmanuel Omogbo (and Jason Smith (2) as the only Rams to record multiple doubles-doubles in the Mountain West Tournament with his 25 points and 14 rebounds performance in the quarterfinals win over Nevada.

In the semifinals against Utah State, he continued to be the best player on the floor with 26 points, 11 rebound, six assists and a steal.

J-Lake

Jalen Lake has been a consent for Colorado State since stepping foot on campus in Fort Collins. The senior does all the little things that impact winning for the team. While the numbers are not flashy he is the team's best perimeter defender.

Lake has proved time, consistency and patients pay off this year. The senior is averaging 11.3 points and shooting 42.1%

from the field and 34.1% from three.

He opened his final season in Fort Collins with seven points and three assists, while continuing to do all the little things that do not show up in the box score.

The basket looks like a giant hole against Tennessee State for Lake as he poured in a career-high 22 points against Tennessee State. He shot 50.0% from the field in the game and made a career-best seven free throws.

Lake followed up the career-best scoring effort with 19 points on 70.0% (7-10) shooting in the win over Denver. The seven made shots were a career-high.

The hot streak continued at Ole Miss when he knocked down a career-high tying five 3-pointers leading all players with 21 points. He has scored in double figures in 13 of the 17 games.

With 4.8 seconds left in the game and two on the shot clock, Lake knocked down the game-winning 3-pointer against Boise State at home. It capped off a 13 point night for the senior.

He ended a shooting slump with his 14 points and three 3s in the home win against Nevada.

Following a tough night in the quarterfinals, Lake responded with 14 points in the semifinals against Utah State. Twelve of them came in the first half as he drained a pair of 3s and shot 5-of-8 from the field.

Lake has made three-plus 3-pointers nine times this year averaging 1.88 makes a game.

His scoring increase has led to more openings for his teammates. The senior dished out a career-high tying seven assists against the Radford.

Lake turned in one of the gutsiest performances in CSU history against Colorado. With a broken finger on his left hand and knowing he was going to have surgery on it the next day, Lake came out and scored 16 points in the win over the rival Buffs.

Lake averaged 6.1 points and 1.6 rebounds per game in 2023-24.

The Mbemba Factor

Rashaan Mbemba provides a big presence for the Rams on the floor. While battling injuries

earlier this year, he is averaging 7.4 points and 3.5 rebounds.

As his health improved, Mbemba has posted lines of 10 points and seven rebounds against a physical VCU team and followed it up with 16 points and six rebounds against Radford.

The seven rebounds against VCU was a career-best and 16 points the next game the same for scoring.

Mbemba topped that rebound number on New Year's Eve against San Jose State when he pulled down eight to go with his 12 points.

The Austrian recorded the first 20-point game of his career with 22 at home against UNLV. Mbemba was 8-for-9 from the field in the performance and made all six of his free throw attempts.

Over the nine game stretch from December 14-January 18 he averaged 11.1 points on 72.2% (39-54) shooting with 4.8 rebounds.

Missing the Boise State game at home in January due to an illness, Mbemba returned to form a few games later with his 17 points at New Mexico.

Mbemba recorded his first career double-double in the home win over Nevada when he scored 12 points and grabbed 10 rebounds.

He came up big against Nevada against in the Mountain West quarterfinals. While his state line read nine points, four rebounds and a steal, he was +21 when on the floor.

Crock is Cooking

Transfer Jaylen Crocker-Johnson joins CSU after spending a season at Arkansas Little Rock where he was named the Ohio Valley Freshman of the Year.

The San Antonio native, averaged 9.1 points and 5.3 rebound for the Trojans.

Crocker-Johnson battled foul trouble in the first two games of the season before breaking out off the bench against Denver. He scored 14 points and grabbed six rebounds.

Coming off the bench, he had a career-high 21 points against UC Riverside, connecting on a career-best three 3s.

Crocker-Johnson missed out on his first

double-double of the year with a 13 points and nine rebound performance against New Mexico at home off the bench.

The sophomore finished a point shy of his career-high at home against Fresno State with his second 20 point game of the season. He made a career-high four 3-pointers and was a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line.

Crocker-Johnson scored the first seven points at Wyoming to set the tone in the rivalry win. He finished the game with 11 points and seven rebounds.

His biggest rebound on the year to date came in the final seconds against Boise State. The sophomore grabbed his sixth rebound of the night and third on the offensive end to feed Jalen Lake for the game-winning 3.

Crocker-Johnson's seventh double figures scoring game of the year came at Fresno State when he scored 11, but his biggest play of the game came at the other end of the court. Following Evans made 3 he made a key block the next possession that hit off of the FSU player to give CSU the ball.

He once again set the tone against Wyoming at home hitting his first two 3s on the way to 11 points in the historic 35-point win.

Crocker-Johnson missed just two shots against Utah State with a 7-for-9 performance including a perfect 3-for-3 behind the arc to finish with 18 points.

He had a stretch of scoring double figures in eight of 10 games (1/25-3/1) near the end of conference season where he averaged 11.6 points per game.

Crocker-Johnson scored key baskets at key times for CSU in its quarterfinals win over Nevada, finishing with 10 points on 3-of-3 shooting including a made 3.

On the year he is averaging 9.0 points and 4.3 rebounds.

Ballin Bowen Born

Colorado State continued its connection to Northern Iowa with the addition of Bowen Born. He comes to CSU after spending his first four years at UNI like associate head coach Ali Farokmanesh.

Born comes to CSU with plenty of accolades earning Missouri Valley Freshman of the Year (2020-21) and Sixth Man honors (2021-22). He came to Fort Collins having scored 1,486 points at UNI. He eclipsed the 1,500 mark

in the game against Denver. He now sits at 1,643.

The guard averaged 12.6 points and 2.2 assists a game while being a sharp shooter making 34.5% of his threes.

In his first game for the Rams, Born showed his ability to distribute the ball with a game-high seven assists to go with his seven points.

Born gave his teammates a unique gift early in the season presenting each with their own bobble head.

He found his sharp shooting ways in the win over TCU with a CSU-career-high 13 points including making three 3s. All of those were timely for the Rams including the game-tying three to send it to overtime.

Born had his best game in the Green & Gold when the Rams hosted Utah State. He hit a trio of his 3-point attempts and all five free throw attempts on his way to 18 points off the bench.

K.C. Evans

Sophomore Kyan Evans had all eyes on him to replace the large shoes of Isaiah Stevens entering the 2024-25 season. He was also reminded by coach Niko Medved, to be himself.

After seeing some action his freshman season, Evans is came into his own this year. The Kansas City native is averaging 10.5 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game. He earned honorable mention on the All-Mountain West team.

Evans has scored in double figures in 17 of the past 23 games and set his career-high for assists with eight against Air Force at home.

He is now on an 11-game streak of double figures scoring and made multiple 3s in seven straight game.

The sophomore reached double figures for the first time in his career with 11 points against Washington.

Two games later her reset that high with 14 in the win over LMU. He shot an impressive 4-for-5 from behind the arc in the game.

Evans had another 11 point game against Colorado.

His ability to stay calm and cool over the final minutes against Radford helped him connect

on free throws on his way to a career-high 15 points.

Evans hit the biggest shot of his young career in the Mountain West opener at Nevada with an NBA range 3 to put CSU up four with 1:30 remaining on his way to a career-best 16 points.

He dished out a quarter of the team's 28 assists against Fresno State, setting a career-high for himself. He added in 10 points in the game shooting perfect for the night from the field and charity stripe.

Evans hit another go-ahead shot at Fresno State with 54.8 seconds left to put the Rams up for good. Similar to Nevada he connected on a step back deep 3.

He did a little of everything for the Rams against Air Force with eight points, eight assists and six rebounds in the win.

Despite battle foul trouble for most of the night, Evans finished a point shy of his career-high at the Pit with 15 points on 6-of-11 shooting including a pair of 3s.

Evans recorded his seventh game of three-plus made 3s in the trip to Utah State where he finished 3-for-6 from behind the arc scoring 14 points.

He followed it up with another against Wyoming as CSU defended its home court in the Border War. He finished the game with 15 points and four assists going 3-of-7 behind the arc.

Evans finished +21 in the win over UNLV at the end of February where all 14 of his points came in the second half, adding in five assists for the game.

The sophomore had his first 20-point game of his career at Air Force when he led the team with 20 in the win. Eighteen of his 20 points came in the second half.

Facing foul trouble against Utah State at home he still found a way to score 15 points in 19 minutes of play, including make three 3-pointers.

He filled up the stat line against San Jose State with 13 points, seven assists and six rebounds.

Evans wasted no time getting things started for the Rams in the quarterfinals with a pair of early 3s on his way to an 11 points, four rebounds, two assists game against Nevada.

The sophomore matched his career-high in made 3s with four on his way to 14 points, three assists and two rebounds in the semifinal win over Utah State.

Boilin' Man

Ethan Morton joins the CSU men's basketball program after spending four seasons at Purdue including helping the team to national runner's-up honors last season.

The versatile guard cracked the team's starting line up on opening night scoring four points, grabbing five rebounds and dishing out two assists in 23 minutes of play.

Morton grabbed a career-high eight rebounds in the win over Denver to go with his seven points, three assists, two steals and two blocks.

It was the little things Morton did against San Diego State that were key in the Rams win. He finished the night with seven points, three rebounds, two assists and a steal.

He does a little of everything for the Rams averaging 3.6 points, 3.1 rebounds and 2.3 assists with a 3.4 assists-to-turnover ratio.

The Long Journey Back

When Keshawn Williams stepped on the floor at Moby Arena on the night of November 4 he was returning to the game he loves for the first time in 333 days. For Williams he counts it more as 667 having just played nine minutes of action last year as he tried to come back from a leg injury.

Williams has become a key contributor off the bench averaging 5.3 points and 1.6 rebounds in 14.2 minutes per game.

His first game action did not disappoint, scoring 14 points off the bench showing off his play making, high flying ability.

Williams reached double figures in the loss to UC Riverside with 10 points.

William scored 30 combined points off the bench in back-to-back games with 14 vs VCU and 16 against Radford.

He once again provided a spark off the bench for the Rams against Fresno State with a CSU career-high 18 points.

Young Big

Kyle Jorgensen came to Colorado State and made an instant impact earning the conference's Freshman of the Week honors in the first week after averaging 9.0 points,

6.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 steals.

Jorgensen came up big for the Rams in overtime against Tennessee State. He scored seven of his nine points in the extra five minutes. All seven of those points came in succession for the team.

Jorgensen scored a career-high 13 points against UC Riverside including making a pair of 3s.

He dished out a career-best four assists at home against New Mexico and matched his career marks for made 3s (2) and steals (1).

Jorgensen reached double figures for the second time in his career with 10 points off the bench against Fresno State. He did most of his work at the free throw line going 6-for-7 adding in five rebounds.

The freshman big man is averaging 4.3 points and 2.0 rebounds per game.

Zay Mode Deactivated

Isaiah Stevens will go down as most likely the greatest player in Colorado State men's basketball history. After five years in Fort Collins Zay Mode has been deactivated with his eligibility running out.

The program's all-time scoring (2,350) and assists (863) leader leaves a big hole in the Rams' lineup.

Stevens is the first and only player in Mountain West history to earn a spot on the All-Conference team all five seasons, including first team honors his final two year.

He signed a two-way contract with the Miami Heat on December 26. He started the year with the Heat's G-League affiliate Sioux Falls Skyforce. He averaged 13.3 points and 10.8 assists per game. The assists mark led the G-League at the time of his signing.

Stevens helped lead the Heat's Summer League to the championship leading the league in assists.

He was announced as a member of the G-League's Up Next Game.

Lost Production

Colorado State will have to fill some lost production from last season with the loss of Isaiah Stevens, Joel Scott, Patrick Cartier, Josiah Strong and Joe Palmer from last season's team.

Getting Defensive

Colorado State's defense was on a continues climb up the rankings last year. They ended the season ranked 27th in efficiency on KenPom and 28th Bartorvik. Both the best finishes in the Medved era.

In Mountain West play, CSU held opponents to 67.9 points a game and they are shooting 42.7%.

The Rams had the second most efficient defense on Bartorvik behind only San Diego State and third on KenPom trailing SDSU and Boise State during conference play.

Colorado State displayed its defensive ways in the First Four of the NCAA Tournament holding Virginia to 42 points on 25.0% shooting. CSU held the Hoos to 14 points in the first half.

The 25.0% shooting tied for the sixth lowest percentage by a CSU opponent ever.

CSU is once again flexing their muscles on the defensive end with an adjusted defensive rating of 99.5 to rank 54th in the nation.

The Rams continued the strong defensive ways holding UND to the 56 points on 35.4% shooting, while turning them over 21 times in the season opener.

CSU turned Tennessee State over 21 time as well. The most a Colorado State opponent turned the ball over in 2023-24 was 20 times.

Colorado State held its opponent to 33.9% shooting in two straight games first TCU in overtime and then LMU, both wins for the Rams.

The Rams held the San Jose State to an opponent season-low 50 points, 15 in the first half as they shot 29.5% from the field and 8.7% from 3-point range on New Year's Eve.

During the current nine-game win streak, Colorado State is holding its opponents to 62.0 points per game on 40.9% shooting.

The Rams have held an opponent under 60 points nine times this season, the second most in the conference behind Boise State (10).

CSU has defended inside the 3-point line well holding opponents to 47.7% shooting inside the arc, the 56th best mark in the nation.

Love the Paint, Like the 3

A favorite quote of head coach Niko Medved is "love the paint, like the three". The Rams have heard it so much it's translated in the stats. CSU shot 57.0% on two-point shots last year, ninth in the nation.

CSU is once again one of the top 2-point shooting teams in the nation with a 57.0% mark that ranks 20th nationally.

The Rams have outscored its opponents in the paint 20 times this season.

Sharing is Caring

Ball movement and sharing the ball are key components of Niko Medved's offense. The Rams averaged 16.5 assists per game in 2022-23. That ranked second in the Mountain West and 12th nationally.

Good ball movement and taking care of the ball also helped the Rams turn in the 14th best assist-to-turnover ratio in the nation at 1.48.

The Rams recorded 20-plus assists in 12 games and 15-plus, 24 times.

Colorado State averaged 18.0 assists per game to rank seventh in the nation and had the nations seventh best assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.72.

Guard Isaiah Stevens was eighth in the nation with 6.8 assists per game.

CSU continues that way of play in 2024-25 with 25 assists on 35 made baskets in the season opener.

They recorded a season-high 28 assists on 29 made baskets at home in the win over Fresno State.

The Rams are averaging 16.7 assists per game this year, the second most in the Mountain West and ranks 25th in the NCAA.

Colorado State has recorded 15-plus assists in 22 games this season.

CSU's assist percentage of 62.8% is the eighth best in the nation.

Rams in the NCAA Tournament

Colorado State played in its 12th NCAA Tournament last year. The Rams are now 5-13 in it.

Prior to last season, CSU's last NCAA Tournament win came in 2012. The Rams defeated Virginia in the First Four 67-42.

The 1969 team went the furthest of any team in program history making it to the Elite Eight.

Rank'em

Colorado State reached new heights for the program in the 2023-24 season. The Rams earned the highest rankings in program history for both the AP and Coaches Poll at No. 13 and 12, respectively in the December 4 polls.

The Rams set their longest consecutive weeks ranked mark at five by appearing in the December 25/26 polls. The streak reached seven weeks before dropping out of the January 15 poll.

Party Like It's 1984

Colorado State picked up their first win over a top 10 team in 39 years last year when they defeated No. 8/7 Creighton on Thanksgiving Day 69-48. In the win CSU held the Bluejays to just 27.9% shooting. The second lowest mark by an opponent ever.

Non-Conference Warriors

Colorado State has become non-conference warriors over the past six seasons. CSU is 48-16 in the regular season non-conference games.

Its 15-game win streak was snapped with the

Cardiac Rams

Colorado State has a knack for the comeback under head coach Niko Medved.

The three biggest comeback wins in program history have come in the past six years under Medved.

In 2021-22 CSU had four comebacks of 10-plus points including erasing a 20-point deficit in the USVI Paradise Jam Championship game against Northeastern.

CSU's rally from 26 points down at No. 23 San Diego State on Jan. 2, 2021 made history as the largest comeback in both school and Mountain West history. The win was the largest comeback win in Division I men's basketball that season and one of just five road comebacks of 26 points or more between two DI opponents in the past 10 years.

The previous largest comeback occurred just the year before against Wyoming when the Rams rallied from down 19 in Laramie.

For the second straight year, CSU came back from double figures in there season opener. The Rams over came an 11-point second half deficit to defeat Louisiana Tech 81-73. The Rams once again trailed by double figures against Wright State early on, but came back from down 11 to win by 28.

CSU's largest comeback of the season came against Air Force on January 16 when they overcame a 12-point deficit. Nique Clifford's layup with 6.0 seconds left forced overtime in which the Rams went on to win 78-69.

It was two straight double digit comebacks when the team earned the 78-75 win over UNLV, after trailing by as much as 10 during the game.

Moby Madness

CSU has a record of 622-252 (.711) all-time at Moby Arena, including 78-17 (.821) the last six years.

2019-20's 12-4 mark had to do with some significant difference in major categories in favor of the Rams, with similarities returning in a 10-1 mark in 2020-21, tying for the fifth-best single-season win percentage in Moby.

2021-22's 14-1 record at home follows a

similar trend, as CSU tied for the second best home win percentage.

Colorado State had a 13-game home win streak that extended from the 2020-21 season to the 2021-22. It tied for the fourth-longest in arena history and sixth-longest in program history.

CSU recorded the second most home wins in program history with 15 last season.

What's Ahead

A win punches Colorado State's ticket to it's 13th NCAA Tournament and third in four years.
