Mountain West Men's Basketball Championship – Quarterfinals Postgame Notes | March 13 #5 Boise State 62, #4 San Diego State 52

Championship Notes

- The No. 5 seed is now 11-16 in the quarterfinal round of the MW men's basketball championship.

Boise State Notes

- Boise State has earned a spot in the MW tournament semifinals in three of the last four years.
- Guard **Alvaro Cardenas** tallied four assists. It was his 35th consecutive game with at least three assists, the second-longest active streak nationally, trailing only Purdue's Braden Smith (49).
- This is also the second-longest streak all-time in MW history, behind Nevada's Grant Sherfield (44; 1/2/21-3/10/22).
- Boise State shot 40 3-pointers, a MW tournament record. The previous record was held by Fresno State (2019) and Air Force (yesterday), which shot 38 3-pointers.
- The Broncos limited San Diego State to just 19 points in the second half, the second-fewest allowed in any half by Boise State.
- Boise State improved to 10-12 all-time in the MW championship.

San Diego State Notes

- 2025 marks the first time San Diego State has failed to make the MW tournament semifinals since 2007, ending a streak of 17 consecutive trips. The Aztecs had also made seven straight MW championship game appearances.
- San Diego State was held without a field goal for the final 9 minutes, 11 seconds.
- SDSU falls to 44-19 (.698) in the MW tournament, this remains the most wins and highest win percentage amongst all MW teams.
