#2 UNLV vs. #3 Colorado State Postgame Notes

Championship Notes

- Colorado State defeated UNLV 66–59 to advance to the title game of the Credit Union 1 Mountain West Women's Basketball Championship. The Rams will take on ninth-seeded Air Force. CSU won both regular season meetings.
- The Rams have advanced to the title game of the MW tournament for the first time since 2022. CSU last won the MW tournament in 2016.
- The last No. 3 Seed to win the MW tournament was San Diego State in 2010.

Colorado State Notes

- CSU's 26 wins are its most since the 2015-16 season, when the Rams won 31 games and the Mountain West tournament.
- Colorado State connected on 8-of-20 from 3-point range. The Rams are now 16-3 this season when making at least six 3-pointers.
- Marta Leimane's 16 points off the bench are the most for a Rams player off the bench in the MW tournament since Emily Neal had 17 in 2008 against Utah.
- Maddy Bragg had three blocks in the game. It is the 11th game this season she has had multiple blocks, which is the third most in the Mountain West.
- Additionally, it is just the second time that Bragg has had three blocks in Division I. She also had three blocks at Oregon State on November 21.
- The Rams now have 17 wins against Mountain West teams this season, tied for the second-most in program history.
- CSU has held both of its tournament opponents to 59 points in this tournament.

UNLV Notes

- UNLV was led by Aaliyah Alexander, who notched a season-high 22 points.
- Shelbee Brown added seven points and 12 rebounds. It marked the 16th game this season that Brown registered double-digit rebounds, the most by any Mountain West player this season.
