- **Defensive stalwarts:** Colorado State's defense has been elite this season, giving up an average of just 55.2 points per game which is No. 9 in the country. The Rams have held 22-of-32 opponents to 60-or-fewer points, with 11 being held below 50. CSU is limiting the opposition to just 35.4% shooting which is ninth nationally.
- **Making the Adjustments:** Head coach Ryun Williams and the Rams have had some massive third quarters this season, helping them enter the final frame with the lead in 25 games. The Rams have proven they can make effective halftime adjustments as they outscore the opponent by an average of 5.7 points in third periods this season (+181). The mark is better than any other MW team's single-quarter margin, regardless of which quarter.
- **BargessHER:** Lexus Bargesser transferred to Colorado State from Indiana over the summer and has become one of the top mid-major players in the country this season. The senior guard does everything on the floor for the Rams and averages 15.6 points, 5.9 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.3 steals per game. Bargesser has taken on a much larger offensive role than she had at Indiana, scoring 12.2 more points per game than last season (3.4) which is a top-10 increase among all DI players (min. 75% of team games each year)
- **Becoming A Habit:** Lexus Bargesser was named the Mountain West Newcomer of the Year prior to the start of the conference tournament. Ram fans were far from surprised, not only because her play was deserving of the recognition, but also because CSU has won the award five of the last six seasons. Bargesser joined McKenna Hofschild (2020-21), Upe Atosu (2021-22), Destiny Thurman (2022-23) and Emma Ronsiek (2024-25) in the recent run of winners, showcasing CSU's apt for securing talent in the transfer portal.
- **20-Or-More:** Colorado State has been a model of consistency under head coach Ryun Williams as the Rams have won 20-or-more games in each of the past five seasons. Throughout Williams' time at the helm of the program, CSU has won at least 20 games 10 times, with two separate 5-season streaks.
- **Kick It Up A Notch:** Sophomore guards Brooke Carlson and Kloe Froebe found an extra gear once Mountain West play began this season. Carlson has been the Rams' second-leading scorer in conference games (12.3 ppg), while Froebe has upped her numbers to average 11.8 points and 7.1 rebounds.
- **Hard Work Pays Off:** Kloe Froebe and Lexus Bargesser both put in serious work on their jumpshots during the offseason, which has led to dramatic improvements in their abilities to knock down the 3-ball. In her three seasons at Indiana, Bargesser managed just 31.0% (9-29) from deep, but has upped that to 41.1% (37-90) at CSU. Froebe has seen the 15.2% (5-33) conversion rate from her freshman season jump all the way to 40.0% (28-70) in 2025-26. Despite struggles earlier in their careers, the duo are now the top-two 3-point shooters for Colorado State.

Colorado State has averaged more than 2,000 fans per game in Moby Arena in three-straight seasons, doing so for the first time since 2000-03. CSU brought in an average of 2,642 fans into Moby Arena this season.

RAMS NOTES...*(Updated 3/9/26)***Ryun "W"illiams**

The winningest coach in program history, Ryun Williams surpassed 250 victories with Colorado State during the 2024-25 campaign. On Colorado State's final regular season game as a member of the Mountain West, Williams secured win No. 159 in MW regular season play which tied Joe Legerski (Wyoming, 2003-19) for the most all-time.

Rams Protect The Rock

The Rams do a lot of good things, but one of their secrets to success is actually something they DON'T do: Turn the ball over. The Rams have led the nation in fewest turnovers per game each of the past four seasons, coughing it up just 8.7 times per game in 2024-25 which was the only mark below 10.5 in the country. Over the past decade of NCAA DI women's college basketball, only two programs have averaged less than nine turnovers a game across a season: Villanova (14-15, 15-16), and Colorado State (22-23, 24-25). Same ole Rams in 2025-26 as they average 10.4 giveaways. No. 1 nationally, of course.

Road Rams

Colorado State has thrived on the road in recent seasons, going 18-5 (.783) in true road games since the start of the 2024-25 campaign. This included a run of 12-straight road wins over the course of the two seasons, which was the second-longest nationally at the time it was broken.

All About Balance

One of Colorado State's strengths on the offensive end of the floor has been its ability to get significant contributions from multiple players. CSU has had three-or-more players reach double-digit scoring in 27 games this season, compared to 20 times last season.

Dynamic Duo

Colorado State fans fell in love with the thrilling pair of Illinois freshmen Brooke Carlson and Kloe Froebe last season, and for good reason. The self-proclaimed best friends became the third-highest freshmen scoring duo in program history, putting themselves in pretty elite company. The Illinoisans combined for 521 total points, trailing program legends Becky Hammon & Katie Cronin (947 points, 1995-96) and Ellen Nystrom & Elin Gustavsson (643 points, 2013-14). The guards have each surpassed 500 career points this season, with Froebe reaching the mark against UNLV on Jan. 31 and Carlson joining the club against San Diego State on Feb. 11.

She's Guarded Who??

In her three seasons at Indiana before transferring to Colorado State, guard Lexus Bargesser was one of the Hoosiers' top defenders, and drew some difficult defensive assignments over the years. Bargesser has guarded the likes of Caitlin Clark and JuJu Watkins, no easy task even for a defender of her caliber.

3 and D

Hannah Ronsiek is the epitome of the 3-and-D player, getting it done on both ends of the floor. The 2024-25 All-Mountain West Defensive Teamer became the first player in CSU history to log 50 3-pointers, 40 steals and 25 blocks last season. This year, Ronsiek has already eclipsed those thresholds in 3-pointers (56) and steals (50), while closing in on blocks (21).

Elite Efficiency

Lexus Bargesser is turning in one of the best shooting seasons in recent Ram history. The guard is one of just three CSU players this century to shoot at least 45% from the field, 40% from 3 and 80% from the free throw line (min. 20 minutes per game).

Loyal Rams

In an age of college athletics where playing at multiple schools has become the norm, Marta Leimane and Hannah Ronsiek have shown that sometimes it's best to plant your roots and grow. The pair of fourth-year seniors have combined for 233 appearances and 132 starts over their four seasons in the Green and Gold, helping the Rams to four-consecutive 20-win campaigns. In their final season of eligibility, the duo are set on winning their first conference championship together.

Doing the Dirty Work

Despite standing just 5-foot-11, Hannah Ronsiek has established herself as one of the best rebounders in CSU history. Ronsiek is one of just three players in program history to log 500 career defensive rebounds (596), and owns the No. 2 spot in the record book. The Sioux Falls, S.D., native has two of the Rams' top-10 defensive rebounding seasons: 183/5th (24-25), 169/10th (23-24).

Second-Chance Creator

Kloe Froebe has a knack for securing offensive rebounds, having grabbed 83 already this season which is tied for 7th in CSU history. Standing 5-foot-10, Froebe is one of just 19 guards in the country - and one of two in the MW - with at least 80 offensive rebounds.

**RAM NOTES...****New Year, New Klo**

Kloe Froebe faced some heavy struggles from the free-throw line to start the season, shooting just 48.9% (23-47) from the charity stripe before the New Year. Since then, however, she's been as consistent as they come, knocking down 78.1% of her looks (50-64) from the line.

Leading the Pac

Colorado State is set to join the Pac-12 Conference in the summer of 2026, bringing forth a new era for CSU Athletics. Last season, CSU went 9-1 against its future Pac-12 foes which included wins over Gonzaga and Oregon State and season sweeps of Boise State, San Diego State and Utah State. This season, CSU is 5-3 against the future league.

Moby Madness

Moby Madness is one of the best home court advantages in the Mountain West, and the numbers back it up. Across the past six seasons (since 2020-21) Colorado State men's and women's basketball combine for the second-best home winning percentage in the league (.807), just below conference newcomer Grand Canyon. CSU is one of only two schools in the conference to win 80% of its home games during that stretch.

Hoosier Connection

Both Lexus Bargesser and assistant coach Linda Sayavongchanh came to Colorado State this summer after having been at Indiana the previous season. However, they did not necessarily come as a package deal. Bargesser committed to the Rams on April 19, while "Coach Sy" was announced on June 10th. Sy reached out to Bargesser prior to taking the job, surprising her by simply asking "What do you think of Fort Collins?" Coach Sy is also familiar with Hannah Ronsiek, as she recruited her sister - Emma - to Creighton.

Smart Cookie

Watching McKenna Murphy shoot the basketball is very impressive, but even more impressive are her endeavors off of the court. Murph is a biomedical sciences major with dreams of becoming a doctor. Over the summer she participated in an intensive internship at a local hospital, often starting her days in the early morning to get in the gym before heading in for a full day at the hospital.

Who's Winning it This Year?

It was far from a surprise when Emma Ronsiek was named the Mountain West Newcomer of the Year last season, both

because of her play and because it has become the expectation for Colorado State to win the award. CSU has taken home four of the last five MW Newcomer of the Year awards, showcasing the success of head coach Ryun Williams in the transfer portal.

Preseason Hype

Coming off her selection to the 2024-25 All-Mountain West Defensive Team, Hannah Ronsiek was named to the MW's preseason all-conference team. Additionally, the Rams were selected to finish third in the league's preseason media poll, making it four-straight seasons being picked to finish in the top three.

All-America

Each of the last three seasons, Colorado State has had a women's basketball player earn All-America honors. Emma Ronsiek was named all-America honorable mention by the WBCA in 2024-25, while McKenna Hofschild earned the same distinction in each of the previous two seasons. Additionally, head coach Ryun Williams was named a WBCA Coach of the Year Finalist in 2024-25.

Going Global

For the second year in a row, Colorado State senior guard Marta Leimane had the opportunity to represent her home nation of Latvia on the international basketball stage over the summer. Leimane laced it up in the FIBA 3x3 Women's Series.

From Here, There, and Everywhere

Despite just one international player (Marta Leimane, Latvia) Colorado State's roster of 14 come from all sorts of different places, with no single US state represented more than twice. In fact, CSU is one of just nine schools in the country with nine or more states represented on its roster according to a national poll of women's basketball communications contacts.

South Dakote Pipeline

A native of Aberdeen, S.D., Madelyn Bragg transferred to CSU over the offseason and continues a long tradition of Rams from the Mount Rushmore State. In addition to the likes Hannah Ronsiek and her all-American sister Emma, S.D. has produced legendary Rams such as Becky Hammon, Lindsay Thomas and Caitlin Duffy.


