#4 Grand Canyon vs. #5 Nevada Postgame Notes

Championship Notes

- Nevada advanced to the semifinal of the 2026 Credit Union 1 Mountain West Men's Basketball Championship with an 84-80 victory over Grand Canyon. The Wolf Pack will take on top-seeded Utah State at 6:30 p.m. PT. Nevada and Utah State split the season series with both teams winning at home.
- Nevada improves to 11-13 all-time in the Mountain West tournament, and 6-7 in the quarterfinals.
- This marks Nevada's first semifinal appearance since 2021. The Wolf Pack are seeking their first title game appearance since 2017.
- This is the first time that Nevada has won multiple games in the MW tournament since 2017, the lone year it won the Conference tournament.
- The 86 combined free-throw attempts are the most ever in a Mountain West tournament game, surpassing the previous high of 77 set by Air Force and UNLV in 2016.
- Additionally, this is the first time in Conference history, regular season or conference tournament, that two Mountain West teams have both attempted 40+ free throws.
- Nevada's 36 made free throws are the most in tournament history, surpassing the mark of 35 set by Utah State vs. New Mexico in the 2019 tournament.

Nevada Notes

- Corey Camer Jr. led Nevada with 27 points on 8-of-13 shooting. Yesterday, no Nevada player had more than 11 points against Air Force.
- This marked the 12th time this season that Camper Jr. has eclipsed 20 points in a game, the fourth most in the Mountain West. Nevada is now 13-5 when Camper Jr scores at least 15 points.
- Elijah Price tied his season high with three assists, which he had previously done two other times this season.

Grand Canyon Notes

- Prior to tonight, Grand Canyon had been 18-0 when leading at halftime this season, the only MW team to be undefeated when leading at the half in 2025-26.
- Grand Canyon's unbeaten streak when leading at the half stretched back 36 games, which had been the second-longest active streak in Division I.
- Makaih Williams (25) and Jaden Henley (19) scored in double digits in the same game for the 24th time this season. That tied them with Utah State's MJ Collins Jr. and Mason Falslev for the most such games by any Mountain West duo this season.
