OPENING TIP

- Colorado State's advanced to the Mountain West quarterfinals with a gritty 67-63 win over Fresno State on Wednesday night.
- Jase Butler had a career-night hitting six 3-pointers on his way to 20 points and finishing a rebound shy of a double-double.
- Butler's six 3s tied for the most by a CSU player in a Mountain West Tournament game, joining Prentiss Nixon and Gian Clavell and tied for the seventh-most in a Mountain West Tournament game.
- Carey Booth had a strong game for the Rams with 18 points and six rebounds.
- CSU had 18 assists in the game. Jevin Muniz (7) and Kyle Jorgensen (5) combined for 12 of those 18.
- The Rams had two players earn All-Conference honors in Jevin Muniz (third team) and Brandon Rechsteiner (honorable mention).
- Muniz averaged 10.3 points, 4.9 assists and 3.7 rebounds during conference play, while Rechsteiner led the team with 12.6 points per game, making 2.45 threes per game and shooting 38.9% behind the arc.
- CSU enters the Mountain West Tournament as the No. 7 seed. This is the third time the Rams have been the seventh seed; the others came in 2002 and 2024. The program is 3-2 as the seven seed.
- The Rams reached 20 wins for the sixth time in the past seven years this season.
- Ali Farokhmanesh became the third first-year head coach at CSU to reach 20 wins. He joins Larry Eustachy (26, 2012-13) and Boyd Grant (22, 1987-88)
- The Rams and Aztecs split the series this season, defending their home courts.
- CSU and SDSU have met eight times previously in the Mountain West Tournament, with SDSU owning a 6-2 advantage. The last time was in 2023, when the Rams fell the Aztecs 64-61 in the quarterfinals.
- Colorado State has won 10-plus conference games 17 times in the program's history; six of those 17 occurrences have come with coach Ali Farkohmanesh on staff. (2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26).
- The charity stripe has been a key to success for CSU during conference play, in wins they are averaging 27.5 free throw attempts per game compared to just 14.8 in losses. The Rams are shooting 75.1% from the free throw line in conference play.
- The Rams rank 30th in the nation, making 76.9% of their free throws overall this year.
- CSU ranks 88th in the nation and third in the Mountain West in assist-to-turnover ratio at 1.37.
- The Rams' 16.1 assists per game are the second best in the Mountain West and 61st in the nation.
- Jevin Muniz is the team's main distributor, averaging 5.0 assists per game, which leads the Mountain West and ranks 61st nationally. His 3.33 assist-to-turnover ratio is 14th in the nation and also the best in the conference.
- Colorado State is assisting on 63.3% of its made field goals on the year, the 11th-best mark in the nation.
- CSU's effective field goal percentage of 58.9% is ninth in the nation and leads the Mountain West.

Head Coach (21-11 overall & at CSU)

First Season Overall, First at CSU

Ali Farokhmanesh was named the 21st head men's basketball coach in program history on March 26, 2025.

He spent seven seasons in Fort Collins as an assistant coach and associate head coach before taking over as the lead man of the Rams.

During his seven years as an assistant, he helped the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances (2022, 2024, 2025) and advanced to the semifinals of the NIT in 2021. Along with bringing home CSU's first Mountain West Tournament title in 22 years.

Over his final four seasons as an assistant coach, Farokhmanesh has played a key role in developing NBA talents David Roddy, Isaiah Stevens and Nique Clifford. That trio, along with Nico Carvacho, has led Colorado State to have the longest active streak of first team All-Mountain West selections, standing at seven years.

Colorado State has won 25-plus games in three of the past four seasons and 20-plus five times since Farokhmanesh arrived on the campus.

Farokhmanesh came to Fort Collins from Drake, where he was also an assistant coach for a season.

Before Drake, he worked as a graduate assistant and then Director of Player Relations and Development at Nebraska. He managed and oversaw the off-the-court responsibilities of the student-athletes, including implementing mentoring programs and community outreach. On campus, he directed recruiting operations, including on-campus hosting duties.

Farokhmanesh's coaching career follows a storied playing career at Northern Iowa. He helped UNI to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances, including the program's first-ever Sweet 16. He hit one of the most memorable shots in March Madness history to send the Panthers to the Sweet 16 with his fastbreak 3-pointer with 34 seconds left to knock off top-seed Kansas.

He went on to play four years of professional basketball in Europe, competing for teams in the Netherlands, Austria and Switzerland.

Farokhmanesh received his degree in finance from UNI in 2010 and earned his master's degree in educational administration from Nebraska in 2016. Ali and his wife Mallory have sons Tai, Liam and Luka and daughter Mila.

His parents Mashallah Farokhmanesh and Cindy Fredrick were long-time college volleyball coaches at Iowa, Washington State and UNLV.

Last Time Out

Survive and advance is the name of the game in March and that's just what Colorado State did in the opening round of the Mountain West Tournament. The Rams defeated Fresno State 67-63 to move on to the quarterfinals.

Jase Butler was a man on fire behind the arc sinking six 3s to lead CSU with 20 points. He finished a rebound shy of his first career double-double.

Carey Booth had a strong game for the Rams as well with 18 points and six rebounds.

The Rams shared the ball well with 18 assists on 23 makes. Jevin Muniz (7) and Kyle Jorgensen (5) combining for 12 of them.

Scouting the Aztecs

San Diego State finds itself in a familiar spot having earned a bye in the Mountain West tournament, entering it as the No. 2 seed after going 20-10 overall, 14-6 in conference play.

The Aztecs are led by the conference's Defensive Player of the Year, Miles Byrd and second team all-conference selection Reese Dixon-Waters.

Dixon-Waters leads the team with 13.2 points per game. Byrd is third on the team in scoring at 10.6 points per game while adding in 4.5 rebounds, 2.7 assists, 1.9 steals and 1.2 blocks per game.

SDSU enters the Mountain West Tournament having lost four of its last six games, including a game in Fort Collins three weeks ago.

History against San Diego State

The series between Colorado State and San Diego State heavily favors the home team with CSU having 29 wins in Fort Collins and SDSU with 33 in San Diego.

The programs have met eight times in the Mountain West Tournament with the Aztecs leading it 6-2. The most recent match up came in 2023 with SDSU winning 64-61 in the quarterfinals.

The Rams two wins came in the 2007 quarterfinals (69-64) and 2007 semifinals (71-63).

Rams against the Mountain West

Part of the original eight founding members of the conference, CSU has been in the Mountain West since 1999. The Rams are 464-481 all-time against current conference members.

Since the conference's inception, Colorado State is 268-231.

CSU in the Mountain West Tournament

Colorado State is 23-24 all-time in the Mountain West Tournament having won it in 2003 as the No. 6 seed and 2025 as the No. 2 seed.

CSU enters the Mountain West Tournament as the No. 7 seed. This is the third time the Rams have been the seventh-seed, the others coming in 2002 and 2024. The program is 3-2 as the seven seed.

{U}Nique Talent

Nique Clifford was in Fort Collins for only two seasons, but he left his fingerprints on the program, becoming just the fourth first-round pick in its history.

In his final year at CSU, Clifford earned AP All-America honorable mention, All-Mountain West selection and the Mountain West Tournament MVP.

Clifford set the program's single-season scoring record and the first player in CSU men's basketball history to record a season of 500 points, 300 rebounds and 100 assists.

Drafted by the Oklahoma City Thunder with the 24th overall pick and rights traded to Sacramento, Clifford is averaging 7.3 points, 3.5 rebound and 1.9 assists for the Kings this season.

The Mbemba Factor

Rashaan Mbemba provides a big presence for the Rams on the floor.

He missed the first four games of the year due to an ankle injury, but started to find his form at the Battle 4 Atlantis against Virginia Tech. He scored 12 points off the bench, including 10 in the second half, where he was a perfect 4-for-4 with a pair of free throws.

Mbemba sustained an injury at the end of the Virginia Tech game, keeping him out until January 9. In his return, the Austrian scored 11 points and grabbed six rebounds off the bench. He played a key role down the stretch in the win over UNLV.

He continues to round into form since his return with a strong 17 points, 6-for-7 shooting performance at Boise State. That included making a career-best two 3-pointers in the game.

Mbemba recorded a double-double against San Jose State at home. It was his first of the season with 11 points and a career-high 11 rebounds.

The Austrian had a strong performance off the bench in the team's win at San Jose State. He finished the game with 15 points, going 5-for-6 both from the field and the free throw line in 17 minutes of play.

The big man showed he has an outside game to match his physicality at New Mexico when he drained a career-high three 3s in the win over the Lobos.

In a move to add depth to the lineup, Mbemba was moved to come off the bench at the beginning of February and is averaging 8.8 points and 3.9 rebounds since then.

He has been a big factor when he plays 15-plus minutes in a game for the Rams. Over his career, CSU is 36-11 when Mbemba plays at least 15 minutes.

The Austrian recorded the first 20-point game of his career with 22 at home against UNLV in 2024-25. Mbemba was 8-for-9 from the field in the performance and made all six of his free throw attempts.

Over the nine-game stretch from December 14, 2024, to January 18, 2025, he averaged 11.1 points on 72.2% shooting (39-54) with 4.8 rebounds.

Mbemba recorded his first career double-double in the home win over Nevada in 2024-25 when he scored 12 points and grabbed 10 rebounds.

Young Big, Growing Up

Kyle Jorgensen has taken a big second-year leap, averaging 11.9 points and 4.2 rebounds per game while shooting 54.8% from the field and 43.3% behind the arc.

The sophomore has shown he enjoys opening week. After winning the Mountain West Freshman of the Week honor to open the 2024-25 season, he added to it with the Mountain West Player of the Week to start his sophomore season.

The Minneapolis native averaged 20.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.0 steals to start the 2025-26 season.

Jorgensen finished a rebound shy of his first career double-double against Incarnate Word. He had career-highs in points (15) and rebounds (9).

He upped that performance with a 25-point effort against Omaha the next time out, adding in another nine rebounds. He scored his 25 points on 8-of-12 shooting, adding seven made free throws. After battling foul trouble against Cal Poly, he responded with a 15-point effort against Loyola Chicago, including a career-best three 3-pointers.

He looked to put the team on his back in the second half against Denver, with 27 of his career-high 29 points coming in the final 20 minutes.

Jorgensen again flirted with his first career double-double against Virginia Tech, finishing the game with 11 points and a career-high matching nine rebounds and four assists.

He was a perfect 6-for-6 against Wichita State, scoring 16 points to go with a career-high tying four assists.

Jorgensen surpassed the 20-point mark in the win over rival Colorado with 21 points. It was a complete game from him, matching his career-high in made 3s with three and grabbing a career-best three steals. He added in seven rebounds and three assists.

He missed time after sustaining a knee injury to open conference play at Utah State on December 20. He returned to action on January 16, playing 16 minutes off the bench, making a 3-pointer to go with a rebound and assist.

A month after his injury, Jorgensen returned to the starting lineup against Air Force, scoring nine points to go with four assists, two rebounds and two steals in the win.

The sophomore was in a zone in the first half against Utah State at home as he finished the game with 24 points, including a career-best five made 3-pointers alongside five rebounds, three steals and two assists.

Jorgensen found his range against New Mexico again when he buried five 3s in the win. The sophomore led the team with 19 points and career-high-tying made 3s.

His passing skills were on display in the opening round of the Mountain West Tournament recording five assists to go with eight points, three rebounds and a block.

Pa[SCORE]lli

Josh Pascarelli can score and score in bunches for Colorado State. The junior transfer from Marist is averaging 10.6 points per game, making 2.35 3-pointers a contest on a mark of 41.8%.

Pascarelli has made at least three 3-pointers in nine games this season.

He opened the 2025-26 season with 18 points against Incarnate Word, connecting four times behind the arc.

The New Yorker started hot against Omaha, making his first three 3-pointers and finishing the night with 15 points, four rebounds and four assists.

Pascarelli put on a show behind the arc against Cal Poly with six makes on his way to a team-leading 22 points.

He broke out of a shooting slump in a big way against South Florida, going a perfect 8-for-8 behind the arc on the way to 28 points.

The eight made 3s were one off, tying the program record for 3-pointers in a game.

There was no cooling off or slowing down for him against Colorado. Pascarelli turned in another eight 3s performance, going 8-for-10 from the field. His biggest basket was a step-back two inside the final minute to cap off his 26-point game and secure the win for CSU.

Injuring his lower body against Wyoming on March 14, he missed the next games, returning for the opening round game of the Mountain West Tournament scoring five points with a steal in 11 minutes of play.

The New Yorker surpassed 1,000 career points in the game against UNLV on January 9. He currently sits at 1,082.

Rec[steiner] & Roll

Brandon Rechsteiner and his family are no newcomers to show business, and he put on a show for his first time on the Moby Arena court.

The junior transfer scored a career-high-tying 19 points, including hitting four 3-pointers while adding in six assists in the 2025-26 season-opener against Incarnate Word.

Rechsteiner torched the nets against Wichita State at the Battle 4 Atlantis. His seven made 3s tied for the ninth most in a game in program history. The 21 points were also a career-high.

Against rival Colorado, he turned in a complete performance, making a trio of threes on his way to 11 points alongside a team-leading six assists.

In conference play, he has reached double figures in 15 games, averaging 12.6 points. He made 2.45 threes per game and shot 38.9% behind the arc.

Rechsteiner's performance in conference play earned him honorable mention honors.

He had back-to-back games of 14 points against Nevada and Grand Canyon.

Rechsteiner led the team with 15 points and four assists in the win over UNLV.

He continued the hot streak with 17 points at Boise State, making five 3-pointers.

The junior missed just one shot at Air Force, scoring a team-high 14 points on 5-of-6 shooting, including a pair of 3s. He also led the team with four assists.

Rechsteiner had a strong second half at UNLV, scoring 12 of his 18 points in it. The junior added four rebounds, three assists and a steal in the win.

The junior turned in another strong second half against San Diego State at home. He scored 12 of his 16 points in the half, including making three straight triples on his way to five for the game.

Rechsteiner made it two straight games with five made 3s when he went 5-for-8 against Fresno State, sparking a 13-point comeback with three straight triples. The junior finished the game with 19 points, two assists, two rebounds and two steals.

He stayed hot at San Jose State with a team-leading 20 points. The scoring output was fueled by his six 3s. That made it three straight games with five-plus 3s.

He has become a dynamic playmaker for the Rams, averaging 12.1 points and 2.7 assists per game. He is shooting 40.2% behind the arc with 2.56 makes per game to rank 101st in the nation.

Rechsteiner is the son of "Big Poppa Pump" Scott Steiner.

Show me the Muniz

Jevin Muniz did a little bit of everything for Colorado State in their season opener. The FGCU transfer had 13 points, a team-high seven assists and four rebounds in the win.

Muniz showed off his court vision and ability to dish out the ball again against Cal Poly with seven assists to go along with seven rebounds.

While scoring only four points in the win over Wichita State, he added eight rebounds, six assists, and three steals.

Muniz became the first Rams since Isaiah Stevens in 2024 to dish out at least 10 assists in a game when he had 10 against South Florida. He finished the game with 10 assists, seven points, six rebounds, a steal and block.

He had his best scoring game of the year against Nevada, leading the team with 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting. He added five rebounds, two assists and a steal.

Muniz followed up the performance against Nevada with a strong showing at GCU. The senior scored 14 points, grabbed six rebounds, added three steals and two assists.

He had a strong game off the bench, scoring 14 points to go with eight rebounds and five assists at Boise State.

Muniz was consistent again off the bench in the Border War in Laramie, finishing the game with 14 points and seven assists.

He led the Rams in scoring with 15 points, six rebounds and five assists off the bench against San Jose State in the win.

Muniz connected on a season-high three 3-pointers in the win at Air Force. He ended the game with 12 points.

He once again provided a lift off the bench for the Rams with his 15 points, five rebounds and three assists in the win over Wyoming. Despite not starting, he played a team-high 36 minutes in the game.

Muniz returned to the starting lineup at UNLV with a thinned-out backcourt and didn't disappoint. He scored a CSU career-high 20 points while adding four assists, three rebounds and two steals.

The senior posted his first double-double of the season at San Jose State. He had 12 points and dished out 10 assists. The 10 assists tied his career high.

His performance in conference play earned him third-team All-Mountain West honors. Muniz averaged 10.3 points, 4.9 assists and 3.7 rebounds during conference play

Muniz has been dropping dimes all year long, leading the Mountain West averaging 5.0 per game and ranking 61st in the nation. His 160 assists are tied for the fifth most in a season in program history.

Not only is he dishing the ball to his teammates but taking care of it too. Muniz has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.33 to rank 14th in the nation and lead the Mountain West.

The team's lone senior is averaging 9.3 points, 5.0 assists and 3.9 rebounds per game.

Engelwood, Up to No Good

Carey Booth returned to the Centennial state this year after spending a year at Notre Dame and a year at Illinois. The junior attended Cherry Creek High School for three years before playing his final year of high school ball at Brewster Academy in New Hampshire.

Booth has settled in nicely at CSU, averaging 10.8 points and 5.7 rebounds. He can stretch the floor, shooting 53.4% from the field and 39.7% behind the arc. He has reached double figures scoring in 18 games this season.

He had a strong start to his season with 11 points and six rebounds against Incarnate Word.

Booth recorded his first career double-double in the win over Omaha with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

He made it two straight double-doubles with a 15 point, 10 rebound game against Cal Poly.

The junior missed out on a third straight double-double by a rebound against Loyola Chicago with 11 points and nine boards.

Booth recorded his third double-double in four games with an 18 points, 10 rebounds game against Denver.

He was flying around the court in the first half against Virginia Tech finishing the game with a team-leading 15 points. Eleven of those 15 game in the first half.

Booth became the first Rams to record five-plus blocks in a game since Stanton Kidd in 2015 with his career-high six against Nevada.

He finished a rebound and point shy of his career-highs with a 19 points, 12 rebounds game against Grand Canyon. It was his fourth double-double of the year.

In the win over UNLV, Booth stuffed the stat sheet with 13 points, six rebounds and three blocks going a perfect 3-for-3 behind the arc.

He had another strong game at Fresno State with 15 points, nine rebounds and a block.

Booth matched his career-high in blocks on Valentine's Day against Wyoming with six. He added in six points and four rebounds.

The junior had a career-high scoring against San Diego State with 22 in the win. He made his presence felt early with a thunderous poster dunk before the first media timeout.

After being held scoreless in the first half, Booth had 15 points all in the win at San Jose State. His free throw shooting was a big role, making 8-of-9.

Booth was key in the Rams opening round win at the Mountain West Tournament with 18 points and six rebounds contently providing pressure at the rim.

The Butler

Jase Butler has been a consistent presence for Colorado State all season long, working his way from a rotation player to a starter.

The transfer from Washington had a career game against Cal Poly with 13 points, five rebounds and three assists, all career-highs at the time.

He then had a three-game stretch against South Florida, Colorado and Dartmouth, where he reached double figures each game, scoring 11, 10 and 10, respectively.

In the South Florida game, he made a career-best three 3-pointers.

Butler reached his career-high scoring with 14 points off the bench against New Mexico to go with his third straight five-rebound game.

He made his first career start at Boise State, where he scored five points to go with a rebound and an assist.

Butler had his second three 3-point game of his career against Air Force, where he finished with 11 points, four rebounds and three assists.

He had a career game, playing a key role in the team's comeback win over Wyoming. Butler led the team with a career-high 18 points to go along with six assists and three steals, both career-bests too. The sophomore finished the game +25 when on the floor.

Butler continues to improve with a career-high 25-point game at home against San Diego State. The sophomore made a career-best four 3s and matched his best performance from the line, going 11-for-12 in the win.

His ability to attack the rim once again led to a high free throw attempt number against Boise State. Butler finished the game 6-for-8 from the line, helping lead to his 15 points while matching his career-high in rebounding with five.

Butler turned in the best shooting performance of his career in the opening round of the Mountain West Tournament making six 3-pointers. He led the team with 20 points and finished a rebound shy of his first career double-double.

The six 3s tied for the most by a CSU player in a Mountain West Tournament game, joining Prentiss Nixon and Gian Clavell and tied for the seventh-most in a Mountain West Tournament game.

This year, he is averaging 9.1 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.7 assists in 25.3 minutes of play.

First Year Success

Ali Farokhmanesh became the sixth coach in Colorado State history to reach 15 wins in his first season when the Rams defeated Wyoming on Valentine's Day.

He then became the third coach in program history to reach the 20-win mark with the team's win at New Mexico on March 4.

In 2025-26 the Rams have recorded 15 assists 19 times and eclipsed the 20 assists mark six times.

Free for a Reason

Colorado State has taken advantage of its free throws this season, making 76.9 of them. That ranks 30th in the nation.

The Rams eclipsed the 40 free throw attempt mark for the first time since the 2023-24 season with 44 attempts against Denver.

Free throws were a key factor in the team's win at Air Force. The Rams went 29-36 (80.6%) from the charity strip compared to Air Forces 45.5% (10-22)

Again, the Rams took care of business at the free throw line in the comeback win over Wyoming, going 25-30 (83.3%). Meanwhile, the Cowboys only went to the line eight times, making five (62.5%).

During its eight-game win streak, CSU has reached the foul line often, recently averaging 26.1 free throw attempts per game. The Rams made 78.9% (169-214) of their attempts.

The charity stripe has been a key to success for CSU during conference play, in wins they are averaging 27.5 free throw attempts per game compared to just 14.8 in losses. The Rams are shooting 75.1% from the free throw line in conference play.

Sharp Shooters

Colorado State is one of the best shooting teams in the country. The Rams rank in the top 30 in the nation in effective field goal percentage (58.9%, 9th), field goal percentage (49.4%, 21st), 3-point field goal percentage (39.1%, 9th) and free throw percentage (76.9%, 30th).

Not only is CSU shooting the ball well, but the Rams are making a lot of their 3-point attempts. Colorado State averages 9.8 3-pointers per game, ranking 43rd in the nation

Josh Pascarelli and Brandon Rechsteiner have led that charge behind the arc, with Rechsteiner averaging 2.56 makes per game each and Pascarelli 2.35, ranking 101st and 160th in the nation for 3-pointers per game.

Six Rams have at least 30 3-point makes or more this season.

Down but Not Out

Colorado State has shown the ability to be down, but not out in games during conference season. CSU has twice overcome double-digit deficits.

The Rams first came back after trailing by 10 to rival Wyoming in the second half to win at home 79-68.

CSU then put together its best comeback since 2022-23 when they erased a 13-point deficit against Fresno State in Moby to win 70-74.

Non-Conference Warriors

Colorado State has become non-conference warriors over the past seven seasons. CSU is 57-18 in the regular season non-conference games. Its 15-game win streak was snapped with the loss at College of Charleston in 2022-23.

Moby Madness

CSU has a record of 635-258 (.710) all-time at Moby Arena, including 90-22 (.811) the last seven years.

2019-20's 12-4 mark had to do with some significant difference in major categories in favor of the Rams, with similarities returning in a 10-1 mark in 2020-21, tying for the fifth-best single-season win percentage in Moby.

2021-22's 14-1 record at home follows a similar trend, as CSU tied for the second-best home win percentage.

Colorado State had a 13-game home win streak that extended from the 2020-21 season to the 2021-22. It tied for the fourth-longest in arena history and sixth-longest in program history.

CSU recorded the second-most home wins in program history with 15 last season.

CSU rolled through the Mountain West Tournament to its first title since 2003 behind the All-America efforts of Nique Clifford. The Rams defeated Boise State in the title game.

Colorado State defeated Memphis in the first round of the NCAA Tournament 78-70 before falling to Maryland in the Round of 32 on a buzzer-beater.

Rams in the NCAA Tournament

Colorado State made its 13th NCAA Tournament and third in four years in 2025. The Rams are 6-14 in it.

CSU advanced to the Round of 32 for the first time since 2013 and just missed out on the program's second-ever trip to the Sweet 16. The only time came in 1969.

The 1969 team went the furthest of any team in program history, making it to the Elite Eight.

20 Win Season

Over the past seven seasons Colorado State has won 20-plus games six times. It is the best stretch in program history.

The 26 wins last season is tied for the second most in program history.
