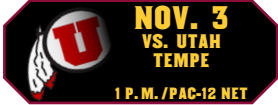

**THE GAME** - Sun Devil Football returns home for its annual Homecoming game this Saturday, Nov. 3 against the #16 Utah Utes. The tilt is scheduled for a 1 p.m. kickoff at Sun Devil Stadium and will be aired live on the Pac-12 Network. Ted Robinson, Yogi Roth and Jill Savage will be on the call. The game will be broadcast over the airwaves on Arizona Sports 98.7 FM with the Voice of the Sun Devils, Tim Healey, on the call alongside analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst and sideline reporter Jordan Simone

**ASU VS. UTAH/HOMECOMING** - ASU has a 64-21 all-time record in its homecoming game, though it has lost its last two after a three-game winning streak from 2013-15. The Sun Devils are 21-8 all-time against the Utes with a 15-4 record at Sun Devil Stadium. The Sun Devils have lost just once to Utah at home in the past 40 years (8-1 since 1977).

**#STAYTRUE2ASU** - Arizona State University has over 100 athletes that hail from the state of Arizona that made the decision to #StayTrue2ASU and commit to Arizona State University to play their respective sports. At 938 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin is well on pace to have the best single season during the Pac-12 era for an ASU running back, already within 291 yards of Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era school record of 1,229 yards for a season (2006). Mario Bates (1993) and J.R. Redmond (1999) are the only other running backs since 1978 to average over 100 yards per game in a single season. Benjamin is currently at 117.2 yards per game. In the Pac-12 era, no running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently sixth nationally at 938 yards.

No ASU running back has **lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 742 consecutive carries**, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 27 consecutive games. That includes 167 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only RBs on rushing plays and does not include receptions). The fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back. If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1081 carries over 39 games (since 2015).

N'Keal Harry **has a reception in all 33 games of his career** at Arizona State, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players. Harry is now in 4th place in program history with 186 receptions, and just 2 shy of moving into the Top 3 in program history. Harry is currently 6th in school history with 2,468 career receiving yards, within 300 yards of the top four all-time. At 5.64 receptions per game in his career, Harry is third among the NCAA's active career leaders in the category. Harry has a 120.1 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 14th nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50

Renell Wren has scored a **positive grade on 19.1 percent of his plays on running snaps**, the 5th-highest percentage of all Pac-12 front-seven players this season. He is **19th nationally among all defensive linemen in the category**. Wren has the 6th-highest run defense score among Pac-12 interior defenders with a 72.2 grade from PFF. Shannon Forman is currently 20th nationally among 3-4 defensive ends in Pro Football Focus' run-stop percentage, logging seven solo tackles in rush defense - all of which constituting as a "stop" - and a 8.2 run stop percentage. Jalen Harvey has made 34 tackles within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage as a safety - the fifth-highest total among all safeties

**The Devils have 4 games this year without allowing a sack** (UTSA, UW, OSU and USC). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack. Cohl Cabral is one of just 25 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year. Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 12.8 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 10th-best percentage among FBS centers in the country. Quinn Bailey is one of just 22 offensive tackles on a Power Five team to not allow a quarterback sack this season and one of just 8 tackles in the Pac-12 to lay claim to such a feat.

The Sun Devils ranking **2nd nationally in opponent's average starting field position (23.8 yard line)**. However, ASU's defense has done well in holding opponents to just 2.33 points per possession on "short" field drives (drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 12th-lowest total nationally. The defense has been exceptional in limiting scoring in general, logging in a 1.02 IsoPPP (points per play) score based on Bill Connelly's metrics, the 17th-best total among FBS defenses.

## #10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- At 938 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin is well on pace to have the best single season during the Pac-12 era for a Sun Devil running back, already within 291 yards of Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era school record of 1,229 yards for a season (2006).
- ASU's defense has held opponents to just 2.33 points per possession on "short" field drives (drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 12th-lowest total nationally.
- ASU has 4 games this year it hasn't allowed a sack. Since 2000, ASU had not had more than TWO games like that in an entire season. Has allowed 10 total all season. School record for fewest allowed is 7 (1987). 8 in 1986.
- ASU touchdown scoring distances vs. USC: 44, 3, 49, 92, 45. In 7 previous games, ASU had just 5 TD plays over 40 yards. (58 yd pass vs. UTSA, 44 yd run vs. OSU, 41 yd pass vs. OSU, 40 yd pass vs. COLO).
- No ASU running back has coughed up the ball on a rushing play on 742 consecutive carries (27 straight games without a fumble).
- Kyle Williams is the 14th-highest graded receiver in the FBS this season as a run-blocker (78.2).
- .@Renell\_Wren has scored a positive grade on 19.1 percent of his plays on running snaps, the 5th-highest percentage of all Pac-12 front-seven players this season. He is 19th nationally among ALL defensive linemen in the category.
- ASU's defense as a 1.02 IsoPPP (unadjusted points per play) tally this season, based on @SBN\_BillC's #FiveFactors. That is the 17th-best total nationally.
- ASU is forcing opponents to start, on average, at their own 23.8 yard line this season. That is the second-best total nationally.
- .@cohl\_cohlcabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 12.8 percent of his rushing snaps this season according to @PFF\_College - the 10th-best percentage among FBS centers in the country.



## FOCUSING ON FOOTBALL

- » N'Keal Harry is the 10th-highest graded offensive player in the Pac-12 this season according to Pro Football Focus, regardless of position, currently with a 79.0 overall mark from the outlet.
- » Eno Benjamin is the highest-graded running back in the league (78.5) and the 23rd-highest graded running back nationally. His 84.3 score purely as a rusher is good for 12th nationally among all running backs.
- » Manny Wilkins is the fourth-highest graded quarterback in the Pac-12 this year (76.5) and the 22nd highest-graded offensive player in the league, regardless of position.
- » Cohl Cabral is the league's second-highest graded center this season (71.1) and the 23rd-highest graded center in the FBS.
- » Freshmen Merlin Robertson and Darien Butler are the 36th and 37th-highest graded pass rushing linebackers in the country, logging a 67.5 and 67.3 score, respectively.
- » Chase Lucas is the 20th-highest graded pass rushing corner in the FBS, scoring a 65.4 score as a pass rusher this year.

## DON'T CROSS THAT LINE

- » ASU is currently 15th nationally and first in the Pac-12 in averaging 7.9 tackles for loss per game this season.
- » The Sun Devils are 35th in the nation and second in the Pac-12 in sacks per game, averaging 2.63 per game thus far.
- » 21 players have logged a tackle for loss this season for ASU, making the Sun Devils one of just one of 14 teams nationally to lay such a claim. 11 different players have scored a sack.
- » ASU entered the season ranked fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU was sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU recorded nine sacks against UTSA, the most since the Sun Devils sacked the UCLA Bruins the same amount of times on Nov. 23, 2013. ASU recorded 15 tackles for a loss, the most since the Sun Devils recorded that same amount against Washington State on Oct. 30, 2010.

## DON'T CROSS THAT ONE, EITHER

- » The Sun Devils have allowed just 22.8 points per game this season, good for 32nd nationally and fourth in the Pac-12.
- » ASU did not allow more than 30 points in the first 7 games of the season, one of just 11 teams in the nation to do so in 2018.
- » This was just the fifth season in the Pac-12 era that ASU has opened the year with seven consecutive games not allowing 30 points, joining the 1982, 1986, 1991 and 1997 campaigns
- » The Sun Devils defense did not allow a single point in the first quarter of games against non-conference opponents and haven't allowed one in six of eight games this year. ASU has allowed just 3.5 points per first quarters this season, good for 20th nationally. Last season, ASU allowed 6.7 first quarter points per game - the 82nd worst tally nationally.
- » The tough scoring defense has kept ASU in every game this season, with six games this year being decide by one possession - tied for the most in the FBS this year. Unfortunately, ASU has been on the wrong end of four of those games - one of just three teams in the nation to have lost at least four games by a touchdown or less this year (Eastern Michigan and Western Kentucky).

## HOLD ON TO THAT BALL

- » No ASU running back has lost a fumble (or even put the ball on the ground) in 742 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 27 consecutive games. That includes 167 running back carries this season (NOTE: this stat includes only running backs on rushing plays and does not include running backs on receptions).
- » Of note on the above stat, the fumble that ended the streak occurred on a direct snap play to a running back (Kalen Ballage against UCLA in 2016). If only conventional running plays were included, the streak of carries without losing a fumble is 1081 carries over 39 games, dating back to Utah in 2015.
- » ASU ranks tied for fourth nationally with only 6 turnovers this season. ASU is outscoring

opponents 28-13 in points off turnovers this season.

- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.

## HE'S THE MANNY

- » Manny Wilkins currently sits at 7,564 career passing yards, good for fifth in Sun Devil football history. Wilkins will have a chance as moving into the Top 3 in ASU history (8,827 yards by Jake Plummer).
- » His 617 career completions are good for sixth in program history and just 15 shy of fourth in ASU lore while his 44 career touchdown passes are tied for 9th in program history.
- » Wilkins has 16 rushing touchdowns in his career, good for second among all ASU quarterbacks in school history behind only Mark Malone (21). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins broke the school record for most consecutive pass attempts without an interception last season at 192 between the end of the 2016 season and the first half of last year, breaking Rudy Carpenter's previous school record of 149 from the end of 2005 to 2006. He has just two interceptions in 2018, tied for the 15th-fewest in the country this season.
- » Wilkins has accounted for 60 career touchdowns (44 passing and 16 rushing).
- » Wilkins holds a 95.7 NFL QB rating this season, according to Pro Football Focus, the 13th-best total among QBs with at least 300 dropbacks in the FBS.
- » The Sun Devil offense has scored a successful play (as graded by Pro Football Focus) on 37.9 percent of Wilkins' passing attempts this season - the 32nd-best total among all quarterbacks in the FBS with 400+ snaps.
- » Wilkins has a 120.4 NFL passer rating when facing blitzing plays this season - the 11th-best total in the country.
- » Wilkins has just an 11.0 sack percentage that sits as the 17th-lowest total in the nation.
- » Wilkins is 21st nationally in adjusted completion percentage (73.4 percent), which excludes QB spikes, throwaways, dropped passes and passes thrown while being hit.
- » Wilkins is one of just six quarterbacks in ASU history to win a game at the Los Angeles Coliseum and just the second one since 2000 (joining Mike Bercovici).

## DIRTY HARRY

- » N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 33 games of his career at Arizona State, tied for the 10th-longest active streak among all current FBS players.
- » N'Keal Harry is now in 4th place in program history with 186 receptions, and just 2 shy of moving into the Top 3 in program history.
- » Harry is currently 6th in school history with 2,468 career receiving yards, within 300 yards of the top four all-time.
- » At 5.64 receptions per game in his career, Harry is third among the NCAA's active career leader in the category. His 74.8 career receiving yards per game are fifth among all active players.
- » With 19 career receiving touchdowns, Harry is 9th in ASU school history in that category as well and needs just one more to move into eighth.
- » Harry has at least one touchdown reception in 9 of last 13 games. He has 11 touchdown receptions in those 13 games after he had just 8 in the first 20 games of his career.
- » Harry has a 120.1 NFL QB rating when targetted this season, good for 14th nationally among receivers that have logged at least 50 percent of their team's targets.
- » Harry has forced 12 missed tackles this season, which is good for 13th-most among all FBS receivers.





## ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

- » Eno Benjamin has forced 56 missed tackles this season (46 rushing, 10 receiving) - second among all FBS players in the category.
- » He has posted a for a 107.8 elusive rating from Pro Football Focus, good for 11th nationally.
- » Benjamin has forced a missed tackle 28.6 percent of the time - good for 16th nationally.
- » 37.5 percent of Benjamin's rushes this season have resulted in a "win" for the Sun Devil offense, the 13th-highest total among FBS running backs with at least 300 snaps. 31.7 percent of his rushes have resulted in a first down or touchdown, the 8th-highest percentage in the FBS.
- » Benjamin's 22 explosive runs this season (runs for over 15 yards) are second nationally and his explosive run percentage of 13.1 percent is 4th in the FBS.
- » Benjamin has been equally impressive in the passing game, currently in the top 10 among the nation's running backs with 28 catches this season and 35 targets this season
- » He has an offensive success score of 45.7 percent as a receiver, according to PFF (which measures plays that are considered a "win" by the offense), a total good for 6th nationally among running backs with at least 15 targets.
- » Benjamin is averaging 37 yards after contact per rush this season, the 21st-highest total nationally.

## NEVER ENO-OUGH

- » At 938 rushing yards this year, Eno Benjamin is well on pace to have the best single season during the Pac-12 era for a Sun Devil running back, already within 291 yards of Ryan Torain's Pac-12-era school record of 1,229 yards for a season (2006).
- » The Sun Devil school record was 1,565 yards - set by Woody Green in 1972 - mark that will be worth keeping an eye on through the remainder of the season.
- » Mario Bates (1993) and J.R. Redmond (1999) are the only other running backs since 1978 to average over 100 yards per game in a single season. Benjamin is currently at 117.2 yards per game.
- » In the Pac-12 era, no running back has finished in the Top-10 nationally in single-season rushing yards. Benjamin is currently sixth nationally at 938 yards. Darryl Clack (1984) and Mario Bates (1993) both finished 18th nationally - the highest for a Sun Devil Running back in the Pac-12 era.
- » Benjamin set a single-game school rushing record with 312 yards against Oregon State, placing him eighth all-time on the Pac-12 conference single-game rushing list.
- » With his 47-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter, Eno Benjamin set the school record for rushing yards in one half (185).
- » Benjamin's 312 yard performance was the most in the NCAA Division I FBS this season. Coming into the contest, Benjamin had only recorded 283 rushing yards this season and 425 rushing yards in his career.
- » His 339 all-purpose yards (312 RUSH, 27 REC), are the second-most in school history, falling just short of J.R. Redmond's 350 all-purpose yards in 1998 vs. USC (214 RUSH, 34 REC, 17 PR, 85, KOR).
- » Benjamin forced or avoided 20 missed tackles on carries against Oregon State, tying the Pro Football Focus single-game record for most missed tackles forced on runs by a running back. He had 177 yards after contact in the contest, averaging 5.9 yards after contact per play.

## THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas has made his presence felt all over the field and has been especially efficient in run defense, where he has made 17 solo tackles this season - tied for 4th among all FBS corners.
- » Lucas is the 20th-highest graded pass rushing corner in the FBS, scoring a 65.4 score as a pass rusher this year. He has four quarterback pressures this season, 6th among FBS cornerbacks.
- » Lucas was named a freshman first-team all-American last season by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today.
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back and was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first

freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014 .He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.

- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference - regardless of year.

## MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 615-341 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 67.8 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (103 of 152) while finding the end zone 79 times in that span (52.0 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 52.3 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (58 of 111) with 44 touchdowns (39.6 percent).

## A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 17 interception returns for touchdowns in the last seven seasons, good for third in the nation behind only Alabama (20) and Ohio State (17) in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 94 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 21 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (27), Alabama (26) and Boise State (25).

## KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » Renell Wren has scored a positive grade on 19.1 percent of his plays on running snaps, the 5th-highest percentage of all Pac-12 front-seven players this season. He is 19th nationally among all defensive linemen in the category.
- » Wren has the 6th-highest run defense score among Pac-12 interior defenders with a 72.2 grade from PFF.
- » Shannon Forman is currently 20th nationally among 3-4 defensive ends in Pro Football Focus' run-stop percentage, logging seven solo tackles in rush defense - all of which constituting as a "stop" - and a 8.2 run stop percentage.
- » Jalen Harvey has made 34 tackles within 8 yards of the line of scrimmage as a safety - the fifth-highest total among all safeties nationally.

## LOCKING IT DOWN

- » ASU is tied for 20th nationally in allowing just 5 plays over 40 yards this season, an area the Devils have struggled in in recent seasons (allowing 20, 16, 30, 21 in the previous four seasons and finishing 103rd, 79th, 128th, 110th, respectively). ASU is also tied for 3rd nationally in allowing just 1 play of over 50 yards on the year.
- » The Devils have given up just 12 plays over 30 yards, tied for 24th-fewest nationally. In the past four years ASU had given up 38, 44, 40, 40 such plays, ranked 116th, 124th, 117th and 119th.
- » ASU is tied for 12th nationally for fewest passing plays over 40 yards allowed this season, allowing just three. ASU was 90th in the category a year ago with 12 such plays allowed and 127th in 2016 with 22 passing plays over 40 yards allowed.

## BEND BUT DON'T BREAK

- » The Sun Devil defense has seen much of its success this season by forcing opponents into third-and-long situations and then doing what it's supposed to do in these moments.
- » ASU is 32nd nationally in average opponent third-down distance (8.0 yards).
- » In those passing downs, opponents are averaging a marginal explosive tally of -0.24, according to Bill Connelly's advanced metrics, the sixth-best score nationally.
- » A testament to ASU's ability to crack down on the big play, the Sun Devils are 20th nationally with a -0.20 defensive marginal explosiveness rating.
- » On passing downs, ASU has a sack rate of 11.5 percent - the 22nd-best total nationally - and 11th nationally with a 17.3 percent sack rate on blitzing downs.
- » The defense has been exceptional in limiting scoring, logging in a 1.02 IsoPPP (points per



play) score based on Connelly's metrics, the 17th-best total among FBS defenses.

- » ASU's defense has held opponents to just 2.33 points per possession on "short" field drives (drives that start with 60 or fewer yards to go to the end zone). That's the 12th-lowest total nationally.

### TAKING OFFENSE

- » ASU is sixth nationally in Offensive Ball Control Rate (drives that last 4 plays or more) - doing so 75.6 percent of the time.
- » The Devils are 18th nationally in Offensive First Down rate (drives that result in at least a single first down) with 79.3 percent of its drives resulting in at least one first down.
- » ASU has capitalized on short field position, scoring 4.67 points per drive when the possession STARTS within 60 yards of the opponent end zone - 13th nationally.
- » ASU's offense has been fairly successful when backed up against their own goal line, scoring a successful play 46.7 percent of the time - the 32nd-best total nationally - and gets itself into manageable third-and-short situations 16.2 percent of the time (7th nationally).

### RUIZ'S PIECES

- » Brandon Ruiz connected on all three of his field goal attempts (49, 24, 28), including the game-winning kick from 28 yards as time expired in ASU's 16-13 upset of then-No. 15 Michigan State to earn Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week Honors for the third time in his career.
- » Ruiz is 21st nationally with a 68.18 percent touchback percentage this season (30 of 44) while his 29 total touchbacks are 29th in the nation.
- » Ruiz has missed just two field goals on the season and is 9-for-11 for the campaign with both misses coming from 50+ yards. His 81.8 field goal percentage is good for 28th nationally.

### DON'T SLEEP ON HIM

- » Michael Sleep-Dalton is 27th nationally (3rd in Pac-12) in averaging 43.8 yards per punt and has played a pivotal role in the Sun Devils ranking 2nd nationally in opponent's average starting field position (23.8 yard line).

### THE YOUTH MOVEMENT

- » Only four Pac-12 TRUE freshmen have played at least 400 defensive snaps this season and three of them play for Arizona State (Merlin Robertson, Darien Butler, Aashari Crosswell).
- » Robertson's 533 snaps are 102 more than any other true freshman in the league and the third-most among any Power Five true freshman in the country.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, there are just 22 3-4 outside linebackers to not miss a tackle on a running play this season that play at least 100 snaps on rushing plays - with Merlin Robertson being one of those.
- » Freshmen Merlin Robertson and Darien Butler are the 36th and 37th-highest graded pass rushing linebackers in the country, logging a 67.5 and 67.3 score, respectively.
- » ASU's top three tacklers on defense this season had not played a single down of FBS football prior to the 2018 campaign (Jalen Harvey, Merlin Robertson, Darien Butler)

### IN THE TRENCHES

- » ASU went consecutive games without allowing a sack for the first time since 2005 (LSU and Northwestern) against Washington and Oregon State
- » The Devils now have 4 such games this year (UTSA, UW, OSU and USC). Since AT LEAST 2000, ASU had never had more than 2 games in a SEASON where it didn't allow a sack.
- » Cohl Cabral is one of just 25 Power Five centers to not allow a sack on the year.
- » Cabral has scored a positive run-blocking grade on 12.8 percent of his rushing snaps this season - the 10th-best percentage among FBS centers in the country.
- » Quinn Bailey is one of just 22 offensive tackles on a Power Five team to not allow a quarterback sack this season and one of just 8 tackles in the Pac-12 to lay claim to such a feat.
- » Bailey's 7 pressures allowed are tied for 4th-fewest among Pac-12 tackles.

- » Getting it done on the outside has been important also, as wide receiver Kyle Williams is the 14th-highest graded receiver in the FBS this season as a run-blocker (78.2).
- » Eno Benjamin is 20th nationally in averaging 1.0 yards before contact per rushing play this season, a testament to the offensive line in front of him.

### GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has had a 100-yard rusher in 9 of its last 13 games dating back to last year (Demario Richard with 4 and Eno Benjamin with 5).
- » The last time that occurred was across the 1997 and 1998 campaigns, where ASU had 10 such performances over a 13-game span (last 6 of '97, 4 of 7 to open '98).
- » ASU has 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.
- » ASU currently has the 20th-highest graded rushing attack of 2018, according to Pro Football Focus.

### KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 129 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 72 of those games (55.8 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.
- » The Sun Devils are 29-8 at home since 2013 with the 29 wins representing the 18th most in the FBS in that time frame.

#### General

The Sun Devil Athletics media relations staff understands the importance of assisting the media in providing coverage of the institution, its athletics programs, administrators, coaches and student-athletes. We pride ourselves in being able to disseminate information as widely, uniformly and fairly as possible using normally accepted media standards. To this end, the best attempt will be made to fill reasonable requests by recognized media outlets. Members of the media are encouraged to work with the Sun Devil Football media relations staff to assist in that endeavor. It is not permissible for media members to contact any athletics department administrator, associate, coach or student-athlete directly without working through the media relations department.

#### Practice Policies

Due to the nature of Arizona State game dates this season, practices schedules each week will vary dependent upon that week's game. The ASU media relations office will provide a practice schedule prior to each game week for the media.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4. At the conclusion of Period 3, a member of the media relations staff will escort the media out of practice. The typical viewing period will last approximately 35-40 minutes.

No member of the media may shoot any portion of practice that includes team activities (anything 11-on-11) or that includes any play-calling signals and/or audio. Members of the media may only photograph and shoot individual or positions groups working separate of a team setting.

Viewing periods are always subject to the discretion of the Sun Devil Football coaching staff and may change suddenly. Following that open viewing period, the members of the media will be escorted out of the facility and reconvene at the Student-Athlete Facility on the north end of Sun Devil Stadium for post-practice interviews. Under no circumstances will Periscope technology be permitted.

#### Interview Policies

All interviews will be conducted post-practice at the new Student-Athlete Facility, located at the north end of Sun Devil Stadium. Due to high demand, several players and members of the coaching staff might only be available on a limited basis each week. A full availability schedule will be provided to the media each week.

All interviews must be arranged through the Media Relations office. Under no circumstances are members of the media allowed to contact a student-athlete or member of the coaching staff without first contacting a member of the Media Relations staff. All coaches and student-athletes have been encouraged to check in with the Media Relations staff and not indulge any interview requests that have not been arranged through the proper channels. Every possible attempt will be made to accommodate all media requests.

Following home contests, Arizona State will bring several student-athletes to the media room at the new Student-Athlete Facility in the North End Zone for a post-game press conference. Head Coach Herm Edwards will follow

the student-athletes.

Please note that there is a new NCAA rule in effect that states that every NCAA athletic team must take one day off per week from all team-related activities, including practice, weight training, conditioning, meetings, interviews, etc. This means that one day per week (typically Monday for Sun Devil football), no Sun Devil student-athlete may conduct an interview. As this is an NCAA rule and will be monitored by compliance personnel, there can be no exceptions made.

#### Weekly Press Conferences

Head coach Herm Edwards will host his weekly press conferences each Monday prior to game week. The press conference is tentatively scheduled for 12 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time each week.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4 and those wishing to document practice via photograph or video will be able to do so during this time, so long as said documentation does not record play-calling signals. On-camera interviews will be conducted at the end of each practice.

For home games, a photographer work area has been established inside the Carson Student-Athlete Center (first floor). Internet access to transmit files is available in the photography workroom. Credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times.

### Saleaumua, Dixon Among Finalists for Polynesian Football Hall of Fame Class

HONOLULU - Arizona State football alums Dan Saleaumua and David Dixon were named as two of the 12 Finalists that will be on the ballot for induction into the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame Class of 2019.

An Honorable Mention All-American in 1985, Saleaumua was twice a Second-Team All-Pac-10 pick. Beyond ASU, he had a 12-year NFL career including All-Pro honors in 1990 and a Pro Bowl selection for the Kansas City Chiefs in 1995. He played in 125 games over eight seasons in Kansas City. He finished his career with 35.5 sacks and 18 fumble recoveries - 17 of which came with the Chiefs, a franchise record that still stands. He also spent time with the Detroit Lions and Seattle Seahawks.

David Dixon, a member of the Sun Devils' offensive line for the 1990 and '91 seasons, played 11 professional seasons in the National Football League, and was just the second player of Maori descent to ever play professional football.
