STORYLINES

- THE MATCHUP, No. 13 ARIZONA ST — Missouri travels to Tempe for the first time since February 2019 to take on the ranked Sun Devils. The two programs were slated to meet in a neutral contest last season but it was canceled. The Tigers are 1-3-1 against ASU under head coach Brian Smith. In the last meeting, the Sun Devils defeated the Tigers 21-13 inside the Hearnes. Three Mizzou starters have wrestled against ASU in a dual setting: Zach Elam, Jarrett Jacques and Peyton Mocco. Of the three, Jacques is the only one with two duals under his belt against the defending Pac-12 champions.

— LAST TIME OUT — Mizzou took down No. 10 Oklahoma State in a season-defining win last Sunday inside the Hearnes. Redshirt freshman Sean Harman grabbed the win of the afternoon, taking down No. 10 Dustin Plott in a 5-4 decision. For his efforts, he was named the Big 12 Wrestler of the Week. The Tigers were buoyed to a six-point lead behind back-to-back pins from Zach Elam and Noah Surtin. With the only requirement to not lose by fall, Trey Crawford secured the Tigers victory by holding off World Silver Medalist Daton Fix.

— DAN HODGE WATCH — Freshman Keeqan O'Toole is FloWrestling's No. 3 ranked wrestler in its third rankings for the Dan Hodge Award for the nation's most outstanding wrestler. He also ranks No. 1 in the coaches' rankings at 165 pounds. O'Toole leads the Tigers' starting unit with 12 bonus-point wins this season, five of which were by fall. He also has six ranked victories.

- BIG 12 WOTW - 0'Toole logged his first two pins of the 2021-22 season in his first two matches. For his efforts, O'Toole was named the Big 12 Wrestler of the Week (Nov. 9-16). He became the first Missouri wrestler to be given the honor since Alan Waters in 2012. Noah Surtin became Mizzou's second Big 12 Wrestler of the Week (Dec. 21-28) following an outstanding run at the Collegiate Wrestling Duals where he beat two top-15 wrestlers in a row. Sean Harman is the Tigers' most recent award recipient (Feb. 1-8) following his top-10 upset.

— STONE HANDS HARMAN — Sean Harman enters the weekend on a tear, following three consecutive ranked victories. Starting the season as the second string at 174 pounds, Harman shot onto the scene in the last two weeks, beating No. 13 Hayden Hastings, No. 32 Kekana Fouret and No. 10 Dustin Plott.

- BONUS-POINT WINS - Tigers' starters have recorded 50 bonus-point wins during a dual or attached tournament. Beginning at 165 pounds, the heavier weights have combined for 30 (60%) wins with 0'Toole accounting for 25% overall.

STORYLINES (CONT.)

- **UNDERCLASSMEN IN THE SPOTLIGHT** Head coach Brian Smith has routinely run out a lineup of eight freshmen and sophomores. While none of the starters this season have been true freshmen, eligibility-wise, five of the eight hold freshmen status and three hold redshirt sophomore status
- MILESTONE VICTORIES Redshirt sophomore Peyton Mocco opened his 2021-22 campaign with win No. 50 for his career in a 13-5 major decision. He is the seventh active Tiger to eclipse the 50-win mark (Brown, Z. Elam, Hart...Jacques, Mauller, Schmitt). Redshirt sophomores Jeremiah Kent and Zach Elam also hit milestone wins, eclipsing 50 and 60, respectively. MOST WINS (ACTIVE, 50+): Mauller (87), Jacques (82), Hart, (78), Z. Elam (63), Mocco (59), Schmitt (59), Brown (53)
- *LIGHT THE GAUNTLET* The Tigers are 4-3 this season against ranked opponents. Missouri has wrestled three top-10 programs, going 1-2 with a win against No. 10 Oklahoma State (Feb. 6) and losses against No. 10 Virginia Tech (Dec. 4) and No. 5 North Carolina State (Dec. 20). The team is 3-1 against teams No. 11-25 with wins against No. 17 Northern Iowa (Dec. 4), No. 17 Lehigh (Dec. 21) and No. 20 Oklahoma (Jan. 20) and a loss against No. 23 South Dakota State (Jan. 22).
- **THE BIG 12 CHAMPS RETURN** Head coach Brian Smith leads his team into a stout Big 12 conference schedule for the first time in 10 seasons. Following the end of the 2020-21 season the program announced that after a nine-year stint in the Mid-American Conference, the Tigers would be rejoining its old conference for the 2021-22 season and beyond. Mizzou leaves the MAC as the nine-time defending conference champions, amassing 40 conference champions and four national champions. The team will return to the Big 12 to defend its 2012-13 conference championship, its lone team title in the conference.
- *BRING 'EM ALL BACK* Mizzou returns all 10 NCAA Qualifiers from the 2020-21 season, led by three-time All-American **Brock Mauller** (149 pounds). Noah Surtin (125 pounds), **Matt Schmitt** (133 pounds), Hart (141 pounds), **Jarrett Jacques** (157 pounds), Keegan O'Toole (165 pounds), Peyton Mocco (174 pounds), Jeremiah Kent (184 pounds), Rocky Elam (197 pounds) and Zach Elam (285 pounds) all retain at least one year of eligibility. The Tigers came into the season with 11 ranked wrestlers across multiple lists and is one of just two schools in the nation to have a ranked grappler in every WIN Magazine weight class rankings.
- *M-I-Z -U-S-A* Freshmen Rocky Elam, **Colton Hawks** and Keegan O'Toole traveled overseas to Ufa, Russia, in August to compete with Team USA at the 2021 Junior World Championships. The ONLY school in America to have three wrestlers on the junior worlds team, USA Wrestling head coach Kevin Jackson brought his team to Columbia, Mo.,for training camp the week prior to the trip.
 - **Hawks**, wrestling at 86 kg, was victorious in the first round. He toppled Bulgaria's Ilya Khamtsou by a 12-1 major decision for the first international win of his career.
 - **Elam,** wrestling at 92 kg, completed his junior world title after a hard-fought final against Iran's Mahdi Hajiloueianmorafah. In the dying seconds of regulation, Elam secured a takedown to win by 4-2 decision.
 - **0'Toole** was crowned a junior world champion in the 74 kg weight class with a massive 11-0 technical fall victory over Kazahkstan's Nurdaulet Kuanyshbay. The Hartland, Wisc., native finished the tournament with two major decision shutouts and two falls, including over 2020 Olympian Turan Bayramov.
 - Junior **Brock Mauller** also competed overseas prior to the season opener, competing in Belgrade, Serbia, at the U23 World Championships at 70 kg at the beginning of November.
- MILESTONE WATCH Junior Brock Mauller enters his fourth season in Black and Gold as the team's winningest active wrestler. At 87 career wins, Mauller has the chance to become the 29th Tiger to enter the exclusive 100-Win Club.
