## UP NEXT

The Sun Devil women's basketball team (4-4) concludes its road trip to the DMV on Saturday (1:45 p.m. EST/11:45 a.m. MST) when it faces Maryland Eastern Shore in the fourth annual Coaches Vs. Racism (CVR) Roundball Classic.

Saturday's game is the fourth in a seven-game stretch in which ASU is on the road for either a neutral site contest or as the away team in a true road game. ASU's game at Coppin State on Thursday was its first true 'away' game of the season. Saturday's contest – being played at the Entertainment & Sports Arena in Washington D.C., home of the WNBA's Washington Mystics – is the last of the three neutral site games in the current seven-game stretch.

After this weekend's games, ASU will take an extended break for final exams before once again leaving the state of Arizona for road games at UC Davis (Dec. 15), at San Francisco (Dec. 17) and at Utah (Dec. 21). The contest at Utah will be ASU's first ever Big 12 Conference game.

Pregame coverage will begin at 11:15 a.m. Veteran broadcaster and the state of Arizona's 2010 & 2019 Broadcaster of the Year Jeff Munn is in his 21st season as the voice of ASU women's basketball.

## SERIES NOTES

- This will be the first ever meeting between ASU and Maryland Eastern Shore. Prior to Thursday's game at Coppin State, the last time ASU played in the DMV area was March of 2008 when it had NCAA Tournament games vs. Temple and vs. Duke at the University of Maryland.

## WELCOME BACK

- Head coach Natasha Adair and Sun Devil players Jalyn Brown, Kennedy Fauntleroy, Tyi Skinner and Kadidia Toure all have ties to the DMV.
- Adair served as an assistant coach at Georgetown (1998-2004). She returned to Washington DC in 2016 when she was named the head coach at Georgetown, where she led the Hoyas for three seasons.
- Brown is from Baltimore and played basketball at both Riverdale Baptist in Upper Marlboro, Md., and St. Frances Academy in Baltimore.
- Originally from Upper Marlboro, Md., Fauntleroy played at New Hope Academy in Maryland before moving on to Georgetown. In her one season with the Hoyas, was unanimously named the 2023 Big East Freshman of the Year and was named to the league's all-freshman team.
- Hailing from Washington DC., Skinner played TPLS Christian Academy in Virginia before transferring to National Christian Academy in Maryland midway through junior season.
- Toure (Silver Springs, Md.) was a four-year varsity player for Our Lady of Good Counsel (Olney, Md.). As a senior in 2022, Toure averaged 14 points, 13 rebounds and four blocks on her way to WCAC Player of the Year honors and first-team All-Met recognition.

## RANKINGS OF NOTE

- Through games played Dec. 5, ASU is ranked among the top 60 teams in the nation in FT percentage (11th/79.9/1st in the Big 12), defensive rebounds per game (28th/29.0/6th in the Big 12), scoring offense (55th/76.5/7th in the Big 12) and free throws made per game (60th/13.88/6th in the Big 12), and blocks per game (48th/4.6/6th in the Big 12).
- Individually, Tyi Skinner is 27th in the nation in FT percentage (90.0/1st in the Big 12), 44th in points per game (18.8/7th in the Big 12), 48th in 3-pointers per game (2.63/6th in the Big 12) and 50th in minutes per game (34.99/1st in the Big 12). Kennedy Basham is 29th in the nation in blocks per game (2.13/2nd in the Big 12).

## LAST GAME

ASU's road trip started with a 74-68 overtime loss at Coppin State on Thursday in the team's first true road game of the season.

Jalyn Brown led the Sun Devils with 17 points to go with six rebounds and three assists. Tyi Skinner added 14 points and Nevaeh Parkinson just missed a double-double, scoring nine points and grabbing a team-high 10 rebounds. Parkinson, who scored a career-high 26 points in ASU's prior contest vs. South Dakota at the Music City Classic, knocked down the second 3-pointer of her career in the game.

Trailing 46-37 with 5:54 remaining, ASU used a 9-1 run to get back within a point, 47-46. Jyah LoVett, who scored nine points in the game, started ASU's rally with a 3-pointer. Also contributing to the run were Brown (four points) and Heavenly Greer (two points).

Neither team led by more than three in the fourth quarter until Brown hit a triple to give ASU a 59-55 lead with 3:33 remaining. The Eagles scored the next four points to tie the game at 59-59 and the teams subsequently went to overtime tied at 61-61. In the extra session, Skinner's 3-point play gave the Sun Devils a 68-67 lead – the fifth lead change in overtime – with 1:28 left.

Unfortunately for ASU, Skinner's free throw was the last of its offense as the Eagles closed the game with a 7-0 run to claim the win.

## OUTSTANDING OFFENSE

Prior to its loss at Coppin State, ASU showed what its offense was capable of, eclipsing the 90-point mark for the second time this season in a 95-88 win over South Dakota (Nov. 27).

Five players – Parkinson (career-high 26 points, 12-13 FGs), Skinner (20 points, team high-tying seven assists, 6-11 3FGs, 6 rebounds), Brown (19 points, team-high 7 rebounds, 4 assists, career-high 4 blocks), Jyah LoVett (14 points, 5 assists) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (14 points, team high-tying 7 assists, 5 rebounds) – scored in double figures for the Sun Devils (4-3), who surpassed the 50-percent mark in shooting (52.2) for the second time this season.

ASU knocked down 12 triples, two short of tying the school record of 14 and the most since hitting 13 against Marist on Nov. 21, 2021. All six of Skinner's field goals were from beyond the arc, one triple shy of tying the school record of seven accomplished by five Sun Devils, most recently Taya Hanson vs. Cal on New Year's Day in 2021.

As a team, the Sun Devils dished out 27 assists, the most helpers since it also had 27 vs. Arkansas on December 21, 2017. Earlier that season, the Sun Devils amassed a season-high 31 assists vs. Sacramento State on November 18, 2017.

## STATE OF PLAY

- The Sun Devils (4-4), who have eight new players on this season's roster, have experienced the ups and downs that can sometimes go with combining the talents of several outstanding players in the early stages of the season.
- After wins over SMU (80-73 on Nov. 16) and former Pac-12 foe Oregon State (79-60 on Nov. 17) in the annual Briann January Classic, the Sun Devils split their contests in Nashville, Tenn., falling to No. 14 Kentucky 77-61 before beating South Dakota 95-88. Nevaeh Parkinson was named to the Music City Classic All-Tournament Team.
- Against Kentucky, Parkinson came one rebound short of a double-double, scoring nine of her 12 points and grabbing seven of her nine boards in the second half to help keep ASU within striking distance. The following day vs. South Dakota, she once again came off the bench and scored a team- and career-high 26 points. Parkinson's single-game field goal percentage of 92.3 percent on 12 of 13 shooting vs. South Dakota, was the best individual performance for a Sun Devil attempting 10 or more shots in a game since Betsy Boardman made all 10 of her shots (1.000) vs. UCLA on February 17, 2001. Parkinson was also ASU's top rebounder in the two contests (6.5 rebounds per game).
- ASU opened the 2024-25 campaign with a 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Tyi Skinner, who missed the entire 2023-24 season due to injury, scored a career-high 30 points to go with a team-high five assists. Two of the newest members of the team – local product Kennedy Basham (8 points, game-high 10 rebounds, 4 blocks) and Parkinson (8 points) – combined for 16 points.
- Despite scoring 96 points – the most scored by ASU during head coach Natasha Adair's time at ASU – the Sun Devils were edged in a 100-96 decision to Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Five players scored in double figure against the Red Wolves: Jalyn Brown (24 points), Parkinson (18 points), Skinner (16 points), Basham (14 points) and Kennedy Fauntleroy (13 points).
- In mid-November, ASU played three games in four days. The stretch started with a 70-59 loss against Grand Canyon in the Hall of Fame Series played at Footprint Center in downtown Phoenix. ASU led by as many as 12 in the first half and went to the locker room with a nine-point advantage, 42-33. Unfortunately for ASU, it experienced a 180-degree turnaround on both ends of the floor as it was outscored 37-17 over the final 20 minutes.
- The Sun Devils bounced back with consecutive wins over SMU (80-73 on Nov. 16) and former Pac-12 foe Oregon State (79-60 on Nov. 17). Against SMU, Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) both came through with marquee performances as the duo combined for 51 points. In its win over Oregon State the following day, ASU recorded opponent season lows for points (60), field goals (19), 3-point field goals (3) and 3-point field goal percentage (13.0/3-23) and had season highs in shot blocks (8), turnovers forced (19) and points scored off turnovers (26) in what added up to ASU's largest margin of victory this season. Skinner scored 20 or more points for the third time this season (21 points/8-11 FGs, 4-4 FTs). Brown had 12 points (5-8 FGs) and Basham and Jazon Jackson had identical double-doubles (10 points, 10 rebounds) in the win.

## DYNAMIC DUO DEBUT

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were dealt a serious blow when it was announced a month before the start of the season that superstar guard Tyi Skinner would miss the entire season due to a knee injury.

Skinner, who played her first two seasons at Delaware, joined Natasha Adair in Tempe after Adair was named ASU's head coach. In 2022-23, Skinner (2023 All-Pac-12 honorable mention) scored 20 or more points 15 times, including 29 points twice. A starter in all 28 games, Skinner averaged 19.3 ppg, (most by a Sun Devil since the 1988-89). She concluded her first campaign as a Sun Devil among the leaders in the Pac-12 in points per game (19.3/2nd/27th in the nation), 3-pointers per game (2.43 per game/2nd), minutes per game (36.59/3rd/29th in the nation), FTs made (79/3rd) and attempted (91/4th), steals per game (1.71/5th), 3-point FG pct (34.7/6th) and FT percentage (78.1/8th).

The 2023-24 Sun Devils were left pondering, 'what might have been,' had Skinner been able to share the court with Louisville transfer Jalyn Brown. Much like Skinner did in 2022-23, Brown would emerge as one of the top performers in the Pac-12. In league games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56). She scored in double figures 26 times (12 20-point games) including

a pair of outings in which she had the two highest-scoring games by a Sun Devil since 2000: 35 vs. Colorado (Jan. 7, 2024) and 34 points at Washington (Jan. 21).

Brown, who earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 recognition from media who cover the league, went on to lead the team in scoring (17.3 ppg) and 3-pointers per game (1.4), was 2nd in FT pct. (76.9), 3-pointers (1.3 per game), minutes (35.54 mpg) and FTs made (103) and attempted (134), 3rd in assists (1.6 apg), tied for 3rd in steals (0.9 spg) and 4th in O-rebounds (1.1 rpg).

In her first game since the end of the 2022-23 season, Skinner scored a career-high 30 points – the 17th time she scored 20 or more points in a Sun Devil uniform – in ASU's 74-66 win over Jacksonville State (Nov. 4). Brown led ASU in scoring (24 points) vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8). Combined with Skinner's 16 points, the duo combines for 40 points in the game. Skinner had a team-high 15 points in ASU's contest vs. Grand Canyon (Nov. 14).

In ASU's 80-73 win over SMU (Nov. 16), Skinner (26 points) and Brown (25 points) combined for 51 points. In addition both Skinner (8-16 FGs, 5-10 3FGs) and Brown (10-18 FGs, 3-7 3FGs) were efficient with their opportunities as they teamed up to shoot 53 percent (18-34 FGs) from the field, including 47 percent (8-17) from long range. Brown also led the team with five assists.

Out of the eight games ASU has played thus far, Skinner has led ASU in scoring four times and Brown three times.

## MEET THE NEWCOMERS

Half the players on the 2024-25 squad are making their debut in the Ma-ron and Gold. Read on for a thumbnail summary of each player.

### #0 /// Kennedy Basham /// F /// 6-7 /// Jr. /// Phoenix, Ariz.

- Kennedy Basham will be returning home after playing two seasons at the University of Oregon where she played in 47 games with 24 starting assignments (all 24 starts came sophomore season).
- Led team with 48 blocks and led or tied for team lead in 13 games, finishing with multiple blocks 15 times.
- Scored a season-high 15 points at Washington (Feb. 23) and followed that up with 14 points at Washington State (Feb. 25) for her first career games in double figures.

- Currently leads ASU in blocks per game (2.1/29th in the nation and 2nd in the Big 12) is 2nd in rebs per game (7.1/12th in the Big 12), and is 4th in scoring (8.8 ppg)... Grabbed a career-high 13 boards vs. Grand Canyon (Npv. 14)... Had strong Sun Devil debut scoring 8 points, grabbing a game-high 10 rebounds and blocking 4 shots vs. Jacksonville State (Nov. 4)... Accounted for 14 points and tied for the team lead in rebounds (6) vs. Arkansas State (Nov. 8)... Had her first double-double as a Sun Devil (10 points, career-high 13 rebounds) and had 3 blocks vs. Grand Canyon (Nov. 14)... Had 3rd double-digit rebounding performance (10) and a career-high 6 blocks vs. OSU (Nov. 17).

### #4 /// Jyah LoVett /// G /// 5-8 /// So. /// San Gabriel, Calif.

- LoVett is coming to ASU from San Jose State where she earned Mountain West All-Freshman Team honors for a season in which she played and started in 17 games as the team's primary point guard.
- Earned Mountain West Freshman of the Week honors three times.

# HEAD COACH NATASHA ADAIR



- On March 27, 2022, Natasha Adair was introduced as the new head coach of Sun Devil Women's Basketball.
- Adair, who brought 10 seasons of head coaching experience to ASU, came to Tempe after five seasons at Delaware where she compiled a 95-58 record, including a 48-13 record in her final two seasons.
- In 2021-22, Adair's final season at Delaware, the Blue Hens captured the program's third Colonial Athletic Association tournament title and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in nearly a decade.
- In 2021, Adair was named the CAA's Coach of the Year for a season in which she guided Delaware to its first regular season conference championship since 2013.
- Prior to her five seasons at Delaware, Adair also had successful head coaching stints at College of Charleston (two seasons) and Georgetown (three seasons).
- Despite a spate of unlucky injuries to key personnel, the Sun Devils had several noteworthy accomplishments during Adair's inaugural season in Tempe, including: Starting 5-0 for the first time since 2002-03; Finishing the season No. 2 in the Pac-12 and 10th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game (12.3/only ASU's 2017-18 squad averaged fewer turnovers per game (11.7) in a season; Even with all its injuries, ASU nearly pulled off three Top 25 upsets in the season's final five games: vs. No. 21 Colorado (62-70), vs. No. 4 Utah (69-74) and vs. No. 19 UCLA (70-81-OT) in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. In their 75-73 win at Oregon State, the Sun Devils

overcame their second-largest deficit in school history (17 points).

- ASU was once again hampered by injuries in 2023-24 as it lost leading scorer Tyi Skinner before the season started. Despite the injury issues, the Sun Devils still increased their overall win total and conference win total from the season before. Individually, Jalyn Brown flourished in her first season as a Sun Devil. The transfer from Louisville earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention recognition from the league's coaches and All-Pac-12 notice from media who covered the league. In conference games, Brown finished 3rd in the Pac-12 in scoring (19.6 ppg), 9th in FT percent (80.6) and tied for 14th in 3-pointers per game (1.56).
- In addition to the 2021-22 team (NCAA Tournament), Adair's leadership while at Delaware was instrumental in the 2017-18 (WNIT) and 2020-21 (WNIT) squads earning postseason appearances. Playing a big role in Delaware's success in Adair's final two seasons as head coach was the Blue Hens' resiliency on the offensive glass as they finished among the top three teams in the nation in offensive rebounding in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- Under Adair's tutelage, three Delaware student-athletes earned Player of the Year honors, two were named Rookie of the Year and multiple players collected All-Conference honors.
- In recent years, Adair has taken on an increasingly prominent role within USA Basketball. In 2017, she was appointed as the U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach. In 2018, Adair was a speaker at USA Basketball's Las Vegas Coach Academy. In 2018 and 2019, Adair earned gold medals while serving as an assistant coach for the USA teams that won the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup.
- Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned a four-win program into a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, Georgetown finished 2016-17 with 17 wins, the most for the Hoyas since 2011-12 and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.
- In only her second season at Georgetown, Adair helped the Hoyas experience a 180-degree turnaround as they finished 16-14 – the third-best NCAA DI turnaround in 2015-16 – and made the program's first postseason appearance since 2012.
- While at Georgetown, Adair coached a Big EAST Rookie of the Year, two players who were named to the league's All-Rookie team and pair of All-Conference standouts.
- Adair's first head coaching job was at College of Charleston, where (35-31 overall in two seasons). She was the first coach to lead the

program to consecutive postseason appearances.

- In 2013-14, Adair's second season and the Cougars' first in the Colonial Athletic Association, Adair guided College of Charleston to a record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era. Additionally, the squad finished third in conference play, defeated five postseason teams from the previous year and advanced to the semifinals of both the CAA Championship and the Women's Basketball invitational.

- In her first season at College of Charleston, Adair led the Cougars to 16 wins and a WBI postseason bid. Her first squad broke 22 school records along the way.

- While leading the College of Charleston, Adair coached two all-conference players and an all-rookie team performer who would go on to be named a three-time CAA Defensive Player of the Year.

- Adair previously spent 14 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with eight years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor five WNBA draft picks and several players who went on to play professionally overseas.

- A founding member of the Black Coaches United, Adair has been recognized by the organization, as well as Advancement of Blacks in Sports (ABIS), as one of the top women's basketball coaches in the country. Adair prides herself on being known as a game-changer as it

relates to social justice and creating a safe space for athletes to find and use their voice; where she was a guest on ESPNW's "Around the Rim" with LaChina Robinson and Delaware's UD Winning Women in Athletics: Trailblazers and Changemakers Webinar Series.

- Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990- 92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994.

- Coach Adair has two children, a son Aaron M. Adair (27), graduated magna cum laude from Johnson C. Smith University. A four-year member of the university's President's Council for his academic achievement, he also earned four letters playing for the men's basketball team. Daughter Allyssa M.
