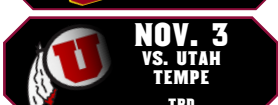

**THE GAME** - Sun Devil Football opens the 2018 season at home this week, taking on UTSA on Saturday, September 1 at Sun Devil Stadium in Tempe, Ariz. The game, scheduled for a 7:30 p.m. PT kickoff, will be broadcast live on the Fox Sports 1 with Chris Myers and James Laurinaitis on the call.

**#SUNDEVILSGRADUATE** - The Sun Devils enter the 2018 campaign with 15 student-athletes on the roster that have already concluded their undergraduate studies and will compete this season while working toward their graduate degrees. That list includes DB Jalen Harvey, WR Ryan Jenkins, LB Nick Ralston, OL Tyson Rising, P Michael Sleep-Dalton, DL, Doug Subtyl, DB Dasmond Tautalatasi, DL Renell Wren, QB Manny Wilkins, RB Goose Cosgrove, OL Quinn Bailey, LB Koron Crump, PK John O'Brien, OL Casey Tucker and OL Roy Hemsley.

The 15 total graduates on the roster represent the third-highest total in the nation, trailing only UAB (19) and Clemson (17).

**SUN DEVIL STADIUM** - The completion of Phase III of the Sun Devil Stadium reinvention concludes the three-phase project in 2018, which now features all new seating in the lower, club and upper levels, a 360-degree main concourse, the new Gila River Hotels & Casinos Southeast Plaza, new grand staircases in the southeast and northeast, and an additional beer garden in the east side 300-level. The east side club level will be completed during the 2018-19 offseason.

## AN ASU VICTORY WOULD...

- » Improve ASU to 77-27-2 on Opening Day in history and 59-15-1 on Opening Day at home.
- » Be the 20th straight victory in a home opener for the Sun Devils, dating back to 1999. ASU's current 19-game active home opener win streak is tied for the fourth-longest in the country.
- » Be ASU's 17th consecutive Opening Day win when the game is at Sun Devil Stadium.
- » Mark the first collegiate head coaching victory for Herm Edwards.
- » Improve ASU to 2-0 all-time in the series against UTSA.
- » Improve ASU to 39-14-3 all-time in games against teams from Conference USA - through 49 of those came against UTEP when the both they and ASU played in the WAC.

#### General

The Sun Devil Athletics media relations staff understands the importance of assisting the media in providing coverage of the institution, its athletics programs, administrators, coaches and student-athletes. We pride ourselves in being able to disseminate information as widely, uniformly and fairly as possible using normally accepted media standards. To this end, the best attempt will be made to fill reasonable requests by recognized media outlets. Members of the media are encouraged to work with the Sun Devil Football media relations staff to assist in that endeavor. It is not permissible for media members to contact any athletics department administrator, associate, coach or student-athlete directly without working through the media relations department.

#### Practice Policies

Due to the nature of Arizona State game dates this season, practices schedules each week will vary dependent upon that week's game. The ASU media relations office will provide a practice schedule prior to each game week for the media.

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4. At the conclusion of Period 3, a member of the media relations staff will escort the media out of practice. The typical viewing period will last approximately 35-40 minutes.

No member of the media may shoot any portion of practice that includes team activities (anything 11-on-11) or that includes any play-calling signals and/or audio. Members of the media may only photograph and shoot individual or positions groups working separate of a team setting.

Viewing periods are always subject to the discretion of the Sun Devil Football coaching staff and may change suddenly. Following that open viewing period, the members of the media will be escorted out of the facility and reconvene at the Student-Athlete Facility on the north end of Sun Devil Stadium for post-practice interviews. Under no circumstances will Periscope technology be permitted.

#### Interview Policies

All interviews will be conducted post-practice at the new Student-Athlete Facility, located at the north end of Sun Devil Stadium. Due to high demand, several players and members of the coaching staff might only be available on a limited basis each week. A full availability schedule will be provided to the media each week.

All interviews must be arranged through the Media Relations office. Under no circumstances are members of the media allowed to contact a student-athlete or member of the coaching staff without first contacting a member of the Media Relations staff. All coaches and student-athletes have been encouraged to check in with the Media Relations staff and not indulge any interview requests that have not been arranged through the proper channels. Every possible attempt will be made to accommodate all media requests.

Following home contests, Arizona State will bring several student-athletes to the media room at the new Student-Athlete Facility in the North End Zone for a post-game press conference. Head Coach Herm Edwards will follow

the student-athletes.

Please note that there is a new NCAA rule in effect that states that every NCAA athletic team must take one day off per week from all team-related activities, including practice, weight training, conditioning, meetings, interviews, etc. This means that one day per week (typically Monday for Sun Devil football), no SUN Devil student-athlete may conduct an interview. As this is an NCAA rule and will be monitored by compliance personnel, there can be no exceptions made.

#### Weekly Press Conferences

Head coach Herm Edwards will host his weekly press conferences each Monday prior to game week. The press conference is tentatively scheduled for 12 p.m. (Noon) Arizona Time each week.

#### Photography/Videography

Media attending practice will be allowed to view and shoot from the start of practice until Period 4 and those wishing to document practice via photograph or video will be able to do so during this time, so long as said documentation does not record play-calling signals. On-camera interviews will be conducted at the end of each practice.

For home games, a photographer work area has been established inside the Carson Student-Athlete Center (first floor). Internet access to transmit files is available in the photography workroom. Credentials must be worn in plain view throughout the game while on the field and all photographers must adhere to painted lines and instructions given by security personnel and/or Arizona State staff members at all times.

#### Weekly Media Teleconference

The Pac-12 Football Coaches Weekly Media Teleconference Call will take place each Tuesday during the season. Coach Graham is scheduled to speak at 12:05 PT/1:05 MT each Tuesday. The teleconferences will be recorded and available at Pac-12.com that same afternoon of the call. Members of the media may reach out to the Pac-12 (925-932-4411) for the media-only phone number for the teleconference.

### ON THE AIR

Hear the hometown call with broadcaster Tim Healey and color analyst Jeff Van Raaphorst as well as sideline reporter Jordan Simone providing all the action for Sun Devil Football this season. The hometown broadcasts are boosted by Bonneville's powerful sports/talk lineup of Arizona Sports 98.7 FM, ESPN Phoenix 620 AM and 92.3 KTAR News FM. This week's game broadcast will be broadcast on ESPN 620 AM.

### LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION

The Sun Devils will open the season with two nationally telecast games, beginning with the season opener against UTSA on FS1. Chris Myers will lead the call for the broadcast alongside analyst James Laurinaitis.

The Pac-12 will again provide access to Armed Forces Network for carriage of Pac-12 football games in 2017 for the benefit of the men and women in the military.

### LAST TIME - UTSA - 2016

**SAN ANTONIO (AP)** - Kalen Ballage scored on a 2-yard run with 3:15 to play and Arizona State rallied from 16 points down in the second half for a rugged 32-28 win over Texas-San Antonio.

Arizona State scored two fourth-quarter touchdowns. Ballage, who tied an NCAA record with eight touchdowns against Texas Tech, capped the rally when he took a direct snap and powered over the goal line. The touchdown was set up by a defensive pass interference penalty on third down one play earlier.

Zane Gonzalez kicked four field goals, including two from 54 yards, for Arizona State (3-0) and became the Pac-12 career scoring leader.

Manny Wilkins passed for 264 yards and two touchdowns for the Sun Devils. Wilkins threw a 27-yard score to N'Keal Harry with 3 seconds left in the first half. His 45-yard pass to Frederick Gammage in the fourth quarter cut the UTSA lead to 28-25.

## #BYTHENUMBERS

96

ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on **96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53).**

HOWEVER, the Devils took a knee in the red zone in the final seconds of the team's victories over fifth-ranked Washington and in the Territorial Cup contest against Arizona - the only two blemishes against the Sun Devils last year. The Sun Devils scored on 43-of-47 trips to the red zone in 2016 (91.5 percent), a total that ranked 10th in the nation. ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

During the regular season, Chase Lucas allowed just **40 catches despite being targeted 78 times for a menial 51.2 completion percentage** while allowing an NFL QBR of 72.4 with two interceptions and six passes defended. Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least 60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any Pac-12 corner. He became the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.

**N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 25 games of his career at Arizona State, the ninth-longest active streak of games for any returning player in the NCAA.**

His 140 career receptions are already tied for 10th in Sun Devil school history and he is already within 300 yards of cracking ASU's all-time Top-10 in career receiving yards. He was targeted 120 times last season, second among all Pac-12 receivers, but had just four drops on the year - the lowest drop rate of top returning receivers in the nation.

Manny Wilkins **is the nation's sixth-highest graded returning quarterback in the FBS this season, according to Pro Football Focus.** Wilkins graded out at 87.6 last season, an elite score that was 12th nationally and first among all Pac-12 quarterbacks. He was sixth nationally with a 122.3 NFL quarterback rating on deep passes last season, according to Pro Football Focus and completed a Pac-12-leading 14 passes of 40 or more yards. Wilkins also posted a 72.4 adjusted completion percentage according to PFF, fourth among returning Pac-12 quarterbacks and 34th nationally last season.

The Sun Devils return one of the top **receiving duos in the nation and arguably one of the top 1-2 punches in school history in N'Keal Harry and Kyle Williams.** ASU is one of just three FBS teams that return two receivers that had at least 60 receptions last year, joining North Carolina State and West Virginia. Harry's 82 receptions and Williams' 66 receptions mark a total of 148 catches for 1,905 yards that trails only WVU's Gary Jennings and David Sills (157 catches for 2,076 yards). In Sun Devil history, the 148 total catches are the most combined catches by a WR duo in program lore.

Kyle Williams recorded a 118.5 QB passer rating when targeted last season, the 18th-highest percentage in the country and second in the Pac-12. Williams posted just 1.43 drop rate according to Pro Football Focus, the lowest rate in the entire country, **dropping just one pass on 67 catchable targets.** Williams graded out at an 82.4 over the entirety of 2017, good for 32nd among all wide receivers playing in Power-5 conferences. Williams snagged seven touchdowns on the season on 66 receptions, averaging a score once every 9.4 times he touched the ball. Oh his 66 catches, 36 recorded either a first town or a touchdown on the year (54.5 percent).

## #10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

1. Arizona State returns 12 starters overall from what was the 37th-highest graded overall team in the nation last season, per Pro Football Focus
2. The Sun Devils return seven starters on offense in 2018 from the 15th highest-graded offense in the FBS last season according to Pro Football Focus
3. ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on 96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53), the lone blemishes coming in game-winning kneel downs vs. UW and UA.
4. ASU is fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU is sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
5. ASU was 20th nationally with just six fumbles lost last season, and none of those were by a running back. In fact, no ASU running back has coughed up the ball in 535 consecutive carries (19 games).
6. @MannyWilkins5 graded out at 86.6 by Pro Football Focus last season at the QB position, the top grade for a Pac-12 QB, the 12th-highest grade in the country and the sixth-highest grade among all returning FBS QBs.
7. Kyle Williams posted just 1.43 drop rate according to Pro Football Focus, the lowest rate in the entire country, dropping just one pass on 70 catchable targets.
8. The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011
9. N'Keal Harry has a reception in all 25 games of his career at Arizona State, the eighth-longest active streak of games for any returning player in the NCAA.
10. Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 121 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points.



**FOCUSING ON FOOTBALL**

- » Arizona State returns 12 starters overall from what was the 37th-highest graded overall team in the nation last season, per Pro Football Focus - a year removed from being the 67th ranked program in the nation. The +30 swing was among the top 10 largest turarounds for a Power Five team in the PFF rankings last year.
- » The Sun Devils return seven starters on offense in 2018 from the 15th highest-graded offense in the FBS last season according to Pro Football Focus, including the 13th highest-graded passing attack in the nation. This is notable as ASU was graded 54th in the nation in total offense in 2016 and 86th in the passing game that year.
- » The offense turnaround (+39 positions) was the eighth-largest in the FBS last season and ASU was one of just three programs to move from outside the Top 50 to inside of it in just one season. The 73-spot swing in the passing game rankings was the third highest in all of the FBS (second among Power Five schools).

**GOLD ZONE**

- » ASU finished fifth nationally in converting on 96.23 percent of its red zone appearances last season (51-of-53). HOWEVER, the Devils took a knee in the red zone in the final seconds of the team's victories over fifth-ranked Washington and in the Territorial Cup contest against Arizona - the only two blemishes against the Sun Devils last year.
- » The Sun Devils scored on 43-of-47 trips to the red zone in 2016 (91.5 percent), a total that ranked 10th in the nation.
- » ASU is the only team in the country to be ranked in the Top 10 in red zone scoring in each of the past two seasons.

**DON'T CROSS THAT LINE**

- » ASU is fourth in the country in averaging 2.83 sacks per game in the past six seasons. Additionally, ASU is sixth in the nation with an average of 7.32 TFL per game since 2013.
- » ASU has had 20 occasions of a player reaching double-digit tackles for loss in the last six years with after having just 17 TOTAL reach the mark in 10 previous seasons (2002-11).
- » ASU has had at least two players reach 10 tackles for loss in a season in each of the past six years, something that happened just six times from 2002-11.

**HOLD ON TO THAT BALL**

- » The Sun Devils turned the ball over just 15 times last season (four on tipped ball interceptions), a total good for 27th nationally. ASU finished 82nd in the country in 2016 with 21 turnovers.
- » ASU was 20th nationally with just six fumbles lost last season, and none of those were by a running back.
- » In fact, no ASU running back has put the ball on the ground in 535 consecutive carries, dating back to the 2016 season - a streak of 19 consecutive games.

**HE'S THE MANNY**

- » Last season, Manny Wilkins completed 260-of-410 (63.4%) passes for 3,270 yards and 20 touchdowns.
- » Starting all 13 games under center for the Sun Devils in 2017, Wilkins recorded four 300-yard and nine 200-yard performances,
- » Wilkins threw for over 3,000-passing yards, marking just the ninth time in the history of Sun Devil Football a player was able to accomplish the feat. His 3,270

passing yards on the season were good for fifth in ASU single season history and are the ninth-highest among returning quarterbacks in 2018.

- » He was sixth nationally with a 122.3 NFL quarterback rating on deep passes last season, according to Pro Football Focus and completed a Pac-12-leading 14 passes of 40 or more yards.
- » Wilkins also posted a 72.4 adjusted completion percentage according to PFF, fourth among returning Pac-12 quarterbacks and 34th nationally last season.
- » Wilkins has 5,599 passing yards in his career, good for 10th among all quarterbacks in ASU history.
- » His 12 career rushing touchdowns are fourth among quarterbacks in ASU history behind Mark Malone (21), Danny White (14) and Taylor Kelly (13). He had seven touchdowns on the ground last season, becoming one of just 10 quarterbacks in the FBS last season to pass for at least 20 touchdowns with at least 7 rushing touchdowns as well.
- » Wilkins broke the school record for most consecutive pass attempts without an interception last season at 192 between the end of the 2016 season and the first half of last year, breaking Rudy Carpenter's previous school record of 149 from the end of 2005 to 2006.

**DIRTY HARRY**

- » N'Keal Harry, a first-team all-Pac-12 selection in 2017, returns for his junior season looking to build on a stellar sophomore campaign in which he racked up 82 catches for 1,142 yards and eight touchdowns.
- » The 82 catches were good for a tie for third in ASU single-season history with Jaelen Strong (2014). Only Shaun McDonald (87, 2002) and Derek Hagan (83, 2004) rank ahead of him. The 1,142 yards receiving were seventh in ASU single season history.
- » He averaged over 87 yards receiving per game and nearly 14 yards per catch in 2017. His 87 yards per game were the best in the Pac-12, and he finished second in the conference in receptions and yards.
- » According to PFF, Harry averaged a 107.0 QB rating when he was targeted, over 16 points higher than the NCAA average. He is the third-highest graded returning Division I receiver in the country by PFF, but first among Power Five programs and first among all juniors (or younger).
- » Harry led ASU in receiving in eight of the 13 games last season, including three games of 140+ yards. He also showed his versatility and play-making ability throughout the season, rushing 13 times for 65 yards and also throwing one pass for 14 yards and a touchdown on the season.
- » He was targeted 120 times last season, second among all Pac-12 receivers, but had just four drops on the year - the lowest drop rate of top returning receivers in the nation.
- » Harry has a reception in all 25 games of his career at Arizona State, the ninth-longest active streak of games for any returning player in the NCAA.
- » His 140 career receptions are already tied for 10th in Sun Devil school history and he is already within 300 yards of cracking ASU's all-time Top-10 in career receiving yards.



## AIR IT OUT

- » Kyle Williams recorded a 118.5 QB passer rating when targeted last season, the 18th-highest percentage in the country and second in the Pac-12.
- » Williams posted just 1.43 drop rate according to Pro Football Focus, the lowest rate in the entire country, dropping just one pass on 70 catchable targets.
- » The Sun Devils had 5 different receivers with 100+ yards in a game last season, a total it had never reached in an entire season prior to 2017. Only six times in school history had ASU had even four different players with at least 100 receiving yards in a game in a single season (2004, 2005, 2012, 2015, 2016, 2017).
- » ASU finished with the 33rd-highest graded receiving corps in the country last season, according to PFF.

## GOLD RUSH

- » ASU has 27 rushing TDs last year as it reached 25 rushing touchdowns for the fourth time in the last six seasons. Those four times are notable as the Devils had just three previous seasons with at least 25 rushing touchdowns from 1980-2011 (1985, 1986 and 1996).
- » The Sun Devils have rushed for over 2,000 yards five times in the last six seasons seasons at ASU after doing so just one single time from 2000-2011 and only eight times total over 30 years from 1981-2011.
- » According to Pro Football Focus, the Sun Devils had the 27th-highest graded rushing attack last season after having the 41st worst-graded attack in 2016.

## KEEPING MOMENTUM

- » Arizona State and Louisiana Tech are tied for the active FBS record of 121 consecutive games scoring more than 7 points. The Sun Devils last scored a touchdown or less when they were shutout, 28-0, against eighth-ranked USC in the 2008 season. They have scored 30 or more points in 69 of those games (57.0 percent).
- » The Sun Devils have won at least seven games in four of the last six seasons, marking the first time ASU has done so in a six-year gap since doing it four straight times from 2004-07.
- » Prior to that, the last time ASU accomplished the feat was 1978-82, winning at least seven games four times in that five-year spread.

## THE CHASE IS ON

- » Chase Lucas was a standout during his first season on the field, being named a freshman first-team all-American by the FWAA and second-team by USA Today
- » Lucas earned Pac-12 Second Team honors at defensive back after an incredible freshman campaign in 2017, despite never playing a single snap at Division I cornerback prior to this season, and not playing as a day-to-day player at the position in high school.
- » He was the only freshman to be named to either the Pac-12 First or Second teams last season and became the first freshman to earn First or Second team honors on offense or defense since Oregon running back Royce Freeman earned Second Team offense honors in 2014 .
- » He was the first Pac-12 freshman defensive back to make the First or Second teams since Brandon Browner did so for Oregon State back in 2003.
- » During the regular season, Lucas allowed just 40 catches despite being targeted 78 times for a menial 51.2 completion percentage while allowing an NFL QBR of 72.4 with two interceptions and six passes defended.
- » Despite being targeted more than any of the 23 Pac-12 corners that played at least

60 percent of snaps in the regular season (once every 4.6 passing plays), Lucas allowed the fifth-lowest completion percentage of any corner in the conference – regardless of year.

- » Recorded 59 tackles, 46 unassisted and 13 assisted. His 59 tackles were the fifth most on the team.
- » Led the Sun Devil secondary with two interceptions and eight pass breakups in 2017.

## MAKE 'EM PAY

- » ASU has outscored opponents 587-328 in points off takeaways since 2012.
- » Since 2012, ASU has scored 68.8 percent of the time following an opponent turnover (99 of 144) while finding the end zone 75 times in that span (52.1 percent).
- » Conversely, opponents have scored just 52.4 percent of the time following an ASU turnover since 2012 (55 of 105) with 43 touchdowns (41.0 percent).

## A HAND IN THE COOKIE JAR

- » ASU has 16 interception returns for touchdowns in the last six seasons, tied with Ohio State for first in the nation in that time.
- » The Sun Devils have 91 interceptions in the last six seasons, ranked in the Top 10 nationally.
- » ASU has added four fumble return touchdowns as well for 20 defensive touchdowns since the 2012 season, good for fourth in the country in that time span behind Ohio State (25), Alabama (22) and Boise State (22).

## KEEP THEM IN FRONT OF YOU

- » The Sun Devils turned the tide on allowing explosive plays last season after being one of the worst team's nationally in the category in 2016. ASU finished tied for 16th in the FBS with just one play allowed over 70 yards last year after giving up 8 the previous season (127th nationally).
- » ASU was one of just 28 teams in the country last year that DID NOT give up a 70+ yard play in a conference game after doing so six times in 2016.

## RUIZ'S PIECES

- » Brandon Ruiz set an ASU record with his 52-yard field goal in the opener of last season, his first career field goal to make him the first Sun Devil to have their first career field goal go for 50 or more yards.
- » Ruiz became the first Sun Devil in school history to kick two or more field goals longer than 50 yards in their freshman season.
- » The true freshman finished 12th nationally and led all FBS freshmen in touchback percentage (69.3 percent) and 10th nationally with 52 total touchbacks.
- » Ruiz was second among all freshmen kickers in the country with 19 field goals last season - good for a tie for 18th among all kickers in the country.
- » Ruiz was twice honored as the Pac-12 Special Teams Player of the Week (vs. Oregon, at Utah).
