SUN DEVIL MEN'S BASKETBALL HOSTS NO. 3 IOWA STATE Arizona State welcomes the Cyclones to Desert Financial Arena on Saturday at 12 PM MST

Sun Devil Men's Basketball is back at Desert Financial Arena to host No. 3 Iowa State on Saturday at 12 PM MST. Arizona State (11-7, 2-5) is coming off a win over a Top-25 opponent and will look to follow that up facing a second straight ranked team in the third-ranked Cyclones (16-2, 6-1). The Sun Devils have four wins over Top-10 foes in the Bobby Hurley era.

THE MATCHUP

Following a lengthy road trip, Arizona State will return to Tempe for one of their biggest home games of the season. The Sun Devils will host No. 3 lowa State in one of the most anticipated games at Desert Financial Arena. ASU won the lone previous meeting in Tempe, 87-69, back in 1977, with the Cyclones claiming both games taking place in Ames.

DFA DOUBLEHEADER

For the second time this season, the Sun Devil Men's and Women's Basketball teams will

play on the same day at Desert Financial Arena. First up, the men's squad will take on No. 3 Iowa State at 12 PM MST. Later in the day, the women's side hosts Cincinnati at 4 PM MST.

HOW TO FOLLOW

ONE OF ONE

Freshman forward Jayden Quaintance has proven to be one of the nation's most unique and versatile athletes. He is currently the ONLY PLAYER IN THE NATION averaging at least 9.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 3.0 blocks. He produces at that high of a level while playing 32.1 minutes per game. Quaintance is averaging exactly 10.3 points, 8.8 rebounds, and 3.2 blocks with room to spare on each qualifier.

BUYING "STOCKS"

Quaintance added six more 'stocks' and has combined for 78 'stocks' (57 blocks + 21 steals) in 18 games so far this season. He is the only player in the nation to boast these numbers (55+ blocks and 20+ steals). The next closest Power 4 + Big East player is Creighton senior center Ryan Kalkbrenner with 65 stocks (53 blocks + 12 steals). For comparison, National Defensive Player of the Year candidate Johni Broome from Auburn has 56 stocks in 16 games (43 blocks + 13 steals).

BLOCK PARTY

Freshman Jayden Quaintance has recorded 57 blocks thus far in the 2024-2025 season and averages the second-most blocks per game (3.2) of any player in the nation. He added three more blocks in the win over No. 23 West Virginia, making him the new single-season record holder by a freshman in program history. He now has 57 blocks and has done it in only 18 games. He has two or more blocks in 16 of 18 games this year, including eight 4+ block performances.

WE WILL BLOCK YOU

Arizona State is second in the Big 12 and 20th nationally averaging 5.2 blocks per game. Freshman Jayden Quaintance is a big reason why, contributing a league-best 3.2. Basheer Jihad, Shawn Phillips Jr., and BJ Freeman each have seven or more blocks this season.

MR. RELIABLE

Alston Mason has been a steady presence in the lineup for Head Coach Bobby Hurley at point guard. Mason has led the team in minutes in 15 of the 18 games, including playing 37+ minutes in five straight games. He once again was relied upon in the win over West Virginia. In the matchup of the two players that average the most minutes in the Big 12, Mason finished with 39 compared to West Virginia's Javon Small's 35. He is now up to 35.4 minutes per game, which is neck-and-neck with Small (36.0)

for the most in the Big 12 and also Top-50 nationally (46). Mason is also shooting a team-high 79.3% from the free-throw line, which is ninth-best in the Big 12.

FREE'D UP

Senior guard/forward BJ Freeman recent emergence has come at an important time with the absence of Joson Sanon. He once again scored in double figures against West Virginia, extending his streak to eight-straight. Freeman has finished with 10+ points in 15 total games this season, the most of any Sun Devil. In the win on Tuesday, he added eight rebounds to go with 15 points in 27 minutes of action despite playing banged up from an injury suffered against Cincinnati.

GETTING ACQUAINTED

Jayden Quaintance continues to show improvement throughout the season. Take a closer look at a comparison between his first four and last 14 games.

Last 14 Games: 11.7 pts, 9.9 reb, 55.5% FG First 4 Games: 5.5 pts, 5.0 reb, 38.9% FG

DOUBLE DOUBLES

Jayden Quaintance now has six double-doubles this season after registering another against West Virginia. It was his second straight game with a double-double as he now has four over his past eight contests. Quaintance is currently one of only five Big 12 players and one of only five freshmen nationally with six or more double doubles this year.

THE HURLEY ERA

Bobby Hurley has won 166 games at ASU and is only the third coach in program history to reach the mark. He is now the second-winningest coach in program history.

AD COACH BOBBY HURLEY

One of the most recognizable names in college basketball history became the 14th men's head coach of the Sun Devil Men's Basketball program, as Arizona State named 1992 NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player Bobby Hurley as the head coach on April 9, 2015. What has followed is aggressive scheduling, lots of fast-paced hoops, playing hard, several big-time wins both home and away and back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for Arizona State for the first time since Byron Scott, Fat Lever and Alton Lister were starring in Tempe (1980-81 to be exact). In his ten seasons as head coach, Sun Devil Men's Basketball has matched its highest ranking in school history (third in the

Associated Press Poll in December of 2017), notched its best two average attendances in history (10,603 in 2017-18 is the ASU record), reached the NCAA Tournament three times, notched its best two non-conference wins in school history (vs. No. 1 Kansas on Dec. 22, 2018 and at No. 2 Kansas on Dec. 10, 2017) and defeated two eventual 2018 No. 1 seeds in a span of a few weeks (Kansas and Xavier).

Following a three-year drought without a First or Second Team Pac-12 All-Conference selection, ASU had at least one in six straight seasons under Hurley (2018-23) and Frankie Collins received Honorable Mention distinction in 2024. Hurley has

coached two Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year winners in addition to the 2019 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Lu Dort). Three Sun Devils have been selected to the Pac-12 All-Tournament team and three received All-Defensive Team distinction during Hurley's tenure.

A signature of Hurley's teams have been their successs in close games and ability to erase deficits. Arizona State is 40-20 (.666) in close games (two possesions or less) over the past five seasons. The 40 wins are a Top-10 total in the nation during that span. To take it a step further, ASU is 25-17 in two point or less games under Bobby Hurley. Arizona State has come back to win a game when trailing at halftime 44 times during the Bobby Hurley era. The 44 comeback wins place Arizona State in the Top-15 nationally since 2015-16.

- Four Big 12 teams are ranked in this week's AP Top 25 Poll. No. 3 Iowa State, No. 7 Houston, No. 12 Kansas, and No. 23 West Virginia comprise the Conference's ranked teams. Texas Tech is ranked No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
- Four Big 12 teams rank inside the nation's top-10 of the NET Rankings, tying for the nation's most. 3. Houston, 5. Iowa State, 9. Kansas and 10. Texas Tech lead nine Big 12 teams in the top 50 as of Jan. 23.
- -Houston holds the nation's longest home winning streak at 33 games and is tied for second with an 11-game overall win streak. Iowa State has the second-longest home winning streak in the nation at 29 games.
- Arizona State's Jayden Quaintance is fourth in Division I with 3.18 blocks per game. He is looking to be the first player in Big 12 history finish the season as the national leader in blocks.
- Big 12 defenses lead the nation, allowing 67.8 points per game this season.
- The Big 12 embarks on its first season as a 16-team league, with league games starting December 30. The Conference schedule increases to 20 games, with teams playing five opponents twice and 10 foes once.
