#10THINGS (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- 1. ASU was first in the nation with 60 double plays turned last season. It has turned 7 through the first 7 games - 20th in the nation.
- 2. Sun Devil pitchers inherited 205 runners in the last year and just 58 to score (28.3 percent). That tally sits at 36/11 (30.3%) this season.
- 3. Conor Davis is currently the toughest player in the Pac-12 to strike out, doing so just once in 22 at-bats this year.
- 4. Adam Tulloch is 17 in the nation and tops in the Pac-12 so far in allowing just 1.64 hits per nine innings.
- 5. McLain was tabbed by Baseball America as the No. 33 overall collegiate prospect for this year's MLB Draft.
- 6. Ethan Long is the No. 38 overall collegiate prospect for the 2022 MLB Draft according to Baseball America
- 7. And looking ahead, Hunter Haas is Baseball American's No. 38 overall collegiate prospect for the 2023 MLB Draft.
- 8. ASU's played 86 midweek games (Mon-Wed) combined since 2012 and the Nevada game was only the 5th time it allowed one run or fewer.
- 9. ASU is currently 24th in the nation with a .985 fielding percentage. The team has just four errors and only two from position players.
- 10. Christian Bodlovich has inherited 27 runners in his career at ASU, with only five scoring (18.5

beginning with the Oklahoma State series this week. The two games against the Cowboys mark the first of five games over the next six days, seven games over the next nine and 11 games over the next 14. All told, ASU will play 18 non-conference games over a span of 25 days to start the year. The team will finally get a four day break following its four-game San Francisco series at Phoenix Muni before then heading on the road to open Pac-12 play at Oregon State the weekend of

The Sun Devil pitching staff has inherited 36 baserunners through four games and allowed just 11 to score (30.3 percent), continuing a trend that began last season in which ASU inherited 205 baserunners for the year and allowed just 58 to score (28.3 percent). That total was the second-lowest of any season since 1998 (28.1 percent in 2010). Christian Bodlovich has led this charge in his time at ASU, inherited 27 baserunners and allowing just five to score (18.5 percent). Will Levine has inherited 23 and allowed only 6 to score (4 and 0 this season).

The Sun Devils are currently fielding at a .985 clips this season and have post just four errors on the year - and only two of those have come from position players. That .985 percentage is currently 24th among all Division I programs while ASU has turned seven double plays on the year - a tally good for 20th in Division I. ASU has had one or fewer errors in six of seven games this year. This is especially notable with ASU featuring essentially four players in new or different positions this year (Long - DH to 3B, Haas - 3B-SS, Davis - New, Baez - New...ish)

The one run allowed by the Sun Devils against Nevada was the fewest in a Tuesday game since shutting out Long Beach State on February 27, 2018. There were 22 Tuesday night games played in between that span. It marked just the fourth time in the past 55 Tuesday games dating back to 2012 that an opponent has been held to one or fewer runs. Arizona State has played 86 midweek games (Mon-Wed) combined since 2012 and Tuesday's victory over Nevada was only the fifth time it had allowed one run or fewer.

PHOENIX -- Sun Devil Baseball continues its busy start to the year this week and next beginning with a two-game midweek series against No. 4 Oklahoma State beginning on Tuesday, March 1. The contest is scheduled for a 5 p.m. AZT first pitch and will be available nationally on the Pac-12 Networks. Wednesday's game is scheduled for a 1 p.m. AZT start.

The Sun Devils will then hit the road for the first time this season with a three-game weekend series at San Diego State beginning on Friday followed by two midweek games at UC Irvine next week. Friday and Saturday's game against the Aztecs will get underway at 6 p.m. locally/7 p.m. AZT while the finale is scheduled for 2 p.m./3 p.m.

- Tuesday's contest will be broadcast on by the Pac-12 Network nationally with Dominic Cotroneo and Andy Lopez on the call. The game will also be available on the airwaves on 1440 AM with Tim Healey and Max Rossiter.
- Wednesday's game will be available online through the Sun Devil Athletics/Pac-12 Live Stream and can be viewed at https://pac-12.com/live/arizona-state-university. There will be no radio for that game.
- Fans are encouraged to follow along pre-game and in-game content throughout the weekend on the Sun Devil Baseball Twitter account: @ASU_Baseball, especially for key weather updates and time changes.

On the Cowboys/Early Schedule

- ASU leads the all-time series against Oklahoma State, 17-13, though the Cowboys took the last game
 in the series in a 2-1 decision in 2020 before the season came to an abrubt close due to the COVID-19
 pandemic.
- Cowboy head coach Josh Holliday was on the Sun Devil coaching staff in 2008 and 2009, helping the Sun Devils advance the the 2009 College World Series.
- Oklahoma State is 4-2 this season and unanimously ranked in the Top-5 of every major Division I baseball poll. The Cowboys openened the season by taking the 2-out-of-3 on the road from perennial powerhouse Vanderbilt, before dropping a midweek tilt to Sam Houston State and then taking both games from Wright State this last week - with one of the games in the series canceled due to weather.
- The two games against the Cowboys mark the first of five games over the next six days, seven games over the next nine and 11 games over the next 14.
- All told, ASU will play 18 non-conference games over a span of 25 days to start the year before getting a
 four day break following its San Francisco series before then heading on the road to open Pac-12 play at
 Oregon State the weekend of March 18.

The Long Con-or

- Sun Devil super senior Conor Davis might be among the oldest players in college baseball, but there is not denying his impact on the Sun Devil program early on.
- After his senior season at Auburn was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Davis came to ASU as a graduate transfer expecting to fill some of the void left at first base with the departure of 2020 MLB No. 1 overall pick Spencer Torkelson. In ASU's very last fall scrimmage prior to the 2021 campaign, Davis blew out his knee and was forced to sit out the season with ACL surgery.
- Davis' appearance in the lineup on Opening Night was special regardless of the outcome but the
 "grandpa" as his teammates call him made it a night to remember as he launched a 1-2 offering to left
 field in his very first plate appearance in nearly two seasons a solo shot that set the pace for ASU in a
 3-1 victory.
- Davis has started the year with a team-best .455 average and an insane .600 OBP for the first two
 weeks of the year while slugging .727.
- Davis has drawn a team-best eight walks including a four walk game against BYU that was tied for fifth
 in ASU single game history and has struck out just once in 22 at-bats.
- His OBP is currently third in the Pac-12 and Top-50 in the nation while his eight walks lead the league
 and are 39th nationally. He is currently the hardest player to strikeout in the Pac-12 with his 22.0 AB:K
 ratio and 41st in the NCAA.

Adam's Family

- Junior Adam Tulloch had about as solid of a Friday night debut as the Sun Devils could have hoped for as the West Virginia transfer fanned 7 batters in 4.1 innings pitched with no hits and no runs allowed before leaving the game to keep his pitch count reasonable.
- Tulloch followed that with ASU's only quality start from the pitching staff so far this season, going 6.2
 innings against BYU with 8 strikeouts and just 2 runs on 2 hits the only two hits he has allowed this
 season.
- Tulloch is currently 17th in the nation and first in the Pac-12 in allowing just 1.64 hits per nine innings on the year.
- His 15 strikeouts are fifth in the Pac-12 and a 12.3 K/9 average.
- At West Virginia last year, the 17th Round pick of the Dodgers struck out 52 in 37.1 innings pitched, including a 10-strikeout effort against Coastal Carolina.
- Tuolloch had a solid outing in Cape Cod this past summer where he was 10th among all players with at least five starts with a 4.03 ERA, finishing third in the league with 43 strikeouts over 31.0 innings.

GAME NOTES

Big Sean

- Sean McLain became a staple in the Sun Devil infield and batting order last season en route to being named a freshman All-American, Pac-12 All-Conference selection and ABCA All-West Region pick. McLain enters the season as the No. 33 overall collegiate prospect in the 2022 class, according to Baseball America.
- Through the first seven games, McLain has a team-best three doubles and is post a solid .455 OBP despite batting just .280 thanks to his five walks and team-best three hit-by-pitches.
- McLain recorded a 23-game hitting streak last season tied for the thirdlongest at ASU since 1998 with Andre Ethier's 2003 23-game hitting streak
- McLain was a Collegiate Baseball News freshman All-American, an ABCA All-West Region first team selection at second base and an honorable All-Pac-12
- He was second on the team with a .322 average on the year, just outside ASU's all-time freshman top-10 in the category
- McLain led the team in multi-hit games last year with 23. His 10 multi-RBI games were second on the team
- McLain had 17 doubles in the regular season, good for sixth in the Pac-12 and finished with 18 on the year - tied for third in ASU freshman history
- He led the team with 24 hits with two outs on 66 chances (.364)
- McLain stranded just 22 runners on the base path this year, lowest among the team day-to-day starters by a significant amount
- McLain successfully advanced runners 50.5 percent of the time (54-of-107 chances) - second on the year
- He had eight errors on 270 chances on the year, though one of those errors came while playing in the outfield. Those 270 chances were second among Pac-12 second-basemen - despite missing several games
- He turned 48 double plays on the season, two more than any other player in the league even including those with runs to the College World Series and 13 more than any other second baseman

- Joe Lampe figures to be one of the spark plug for the Sun Devils both in the field and he did plenty to show that off on Opening Weekend, going yard twice - including an impressive solo shot to dead center as part of his career highs in a 7-6 extra inning loss to Dixie State. His second homer was a two-run rope in the rubber match that that tied the game at 8-8 in the sixth en route to a 17-8
- Lampe is batting .355 early on with a team-best eight runs scored, two homers and two doubles. His 11 hits also pace the team.
- Lampe was one of three Sun Devils selected to the Pac-12 All-Defensive Team after not posting an error in center field in conference games all year. He finished the season with just one error and a .993 fielding percentage
- Also named a ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove Finalist as an outfielder
- In the opener against USC, Lampe recorded nine putouts the most by an ASU center fielder since at least 1998. Hunter Bishop had eight in 2019 and no other player had more than seven
- Lampe did a solid job turning the order around in the nine-hole with a .383 OBP compared to a .294 average
- Lampe successfully advanced runners 53 times on 102 chances (.520) the highest percentage in the team
- He was absurd at productive outs, recording 23 runners advanced with an out this year - five more than any other player on the roster
- He was ASU's best player with a runner on third and less than two outs with 13 RBI - tops on the team - and a .684 average on 19 chances

We Want EZ

- Ethan Long is tabbed as the No. 37 overall collegiate prospect in the 2022 MLB Draft class by Baseball America.
- The big bat hasn't quite been there through four games, but Long already as two sacrifice flies this season and a .345 OBP despite just a .190 average through seven games, with no less than three line drive balls hit against BYU that unfortunately went right to defenders or fell victim to diving catches.
- Long became the 129th Sun Devil to be named an All-American last seson, becoming a consensus selection after being named to teams by Collegiate Baseball News, NCBWA, and Baseball America
- Also earned two freshman All-America nods (CBN/NCBWA) and was a First Team All-Pac-12 pick as well as an ACBA All-West Region second team selec-

- tion and Pac-12 All-Conference first team pick
- Long Finished the 2021 regular season 22nd nationally and second in the Pac-12 with 16 home runs while finishing 13th nationally and leading the league with a .725 slugging percentage on .340 hitting. He was sixth in the league
- His .340 average remained the same through the postseason, giving him the ninth-highest freshman average in Sun Devil history
- Finished with a team-best 54 RBI, tied with Barry Bonds for fourth in ASU freshman history while his 16 homers on the year surpassed Bonds for second in ASU freshman history behind only Spencer Torkelson (25) and good for Top-Five in the league
- These numbers are made all the more incredible knowing that after the Washington series concluded on April 11, he had just one home run and 12 RBIs on the year after entering the season as the team's closer and posting four saves and no earned runs in the opening weeks of action before going down with a minor injury that kept him off the bump
- Led the team with 21 two-out RBI and bat .400 on the year (20-of-40) with runners in scoring position
- Long was responsible for the go-ahead RBI in seven Sun Devil victories this season - three coming against ranked opponents (#16 Oregon, #18 Stanford and #23 Oregon State) and four coming by way of the long ball. He has two go-ahead home runs in the ninth inning of games this year
- Behind Long's bat, ASU won five straight weekend series in the last half of the year. He began getting hot with his go-ahead two-RBI eighth inning double off potential Stanford All-American closer Zach Grech on April 16. In the 19-game stretch that started that night and lasted until his hitless weekend against USC in the penultimate series, Long bat .444 with 40 RBI, 15 home runs, eight doubles, a 1.181 slugging percentage, a .500 OBP and an absurd 1.681 OPS. Of his 32 hits in that span, 23 were for extra bases.
- Long was the only player in the Pac-12 to earn multiple Pac-12 Player of the Week nods this season, let alone three. He was the first Pac-12 player to win the honor three times in a season since Hunter Bishop in 2019. Andrew Vaughn of Cal was the last non-Sun Devil to accomplish the feat thrice in one season in 2018 when he was eventually named the Pac-12 Player of the Year.

Nate the Great

- Nate Baez earned All-Pac-12 Honorable Mention accolades as a catcher, despite only playing behind the dish for only the last month and a half of the
- Baez has shown plenty of poise as the the team's Opening Day starter behind the dish, recording three assists, throwing out two runners and playing errorless ball with just one passed ball this season.
- At the plate, Baez had the game-sealing grand slam in the rubber match against Dixie State and is batting .364 through the early going of the season - second on the team wand leading the squad with six RBIs.
- Baez bat a team-best .362 over the final 14 games of the 2021 season with team highs in homers (8) and RBI (20) in that stretch while slugging a gaudy .915. All eight of his home runs came in those 14 games
- Finished the year with a .276 average with 26 starts and 41 games played
- All these numbers are notable as he didn't become a fixture in the starting lineup until the Cal series as he has fully taken on his role as the team's backstop, showing off his utility after coming to ASU as an infielder and spending much of his early career there prior to this current stretch.

Closing Time

- It's still early, but the Sun Devils already look to have a potent 1-2 punch in the back end of the pen in redshirt juniors Will Levine and Chase Webster.
- Webster has yet to allow an earned run in his two appearances this year with a save while Levine has a 1.93 ERA and a save as well.
- Levine earned a win and a save in the Opening Weekend series win over Dixie State and recorded 4.0 innings pitched with just one run allowed, three strikeouts and no walks.
- It was his effort in the rubber match that stemmed the tide of DSU's momentum as the Trailblazers had taken a three-run advantage in the fifth inning before Levine entered and stymied the offense, throwing 2.1 innings of scoreless relief to set up ASU's come from behind victory.
- Webster took a couple batters to get his feet under him in his debut on Saturday as the first three batters he faced of the season resulted in a sungle,

- an error on himself and a walk. Despite a bases-loaded jam with no outs, Webster allowed just one unearned run as he retired the next three batters.
- Webster built upon the second half of his debut when he took the mound Tuesday against Nevada where he flashed some electric stuff, touching 96 on the radar gun as he went 3.0 innings to earn the save in the 3-1 game, allowing just one hit with no runs and striking out four.
- The Sun Devils also have the talents of Christian Bodlovich to help serve up the back end of the pen. Bodlovich has inherited 27 runners in his career at ASU, with only five scoring (18.5), including an 0-for-5 count this season.

Playing the Field

- The Sun Devils feature a moderately new look infield this year with only Sean McLain starting the season at the position he started last year - second base.
 Hunter Haas made the shift from third to shortstop to start the year while ASU has "new" faces on the corner infield positions with Ethan Long and Conor Davis.
- Despite this, the Sun Devils are fielding .985 to start the year with just four total errors - and only two of those coming from non-pitchers.
- That .985 percentage is currently 24th among all Division I programs while ASU
 has turned seven double plays on the year a tally good for 20th in Division I.
- ASU has had one or fewer errors in six of seven games this year.
- Last season, the Sun Devils were likely one of the few teams in the country that did not returning a single position player to their 2020 positions in 2021. ASU's only veteran starter was Drew Swift who shifted over to shortstop this season after spending the majority of his career at second base.. All other positions on the diamond were replaced by newcomers.
- Despite that, ASU had one or fewer errors in 40 games last year during the regular season, going 29-11 in those.
- In 2021, ASU fielded at a very respectable .976 fielding percentage in the regular season - good for 47th nationally
- ASU was first in the nation with 60 double plays turned last season, which is
 especially impressive since the team had just six in the first 14 games of the
 season.
- Sean McLain (48), Drew Swift (32) and Hunteer Haas (12) all led their respective
 positions in the Pac-12 in double plays turned in the regular season. McLain and
 Swift were first and third in the league in the category, regardless of position
 incredibly notable as first basemen tend to lead the way in the area.

Boom Goes the Dynamite

- ASU hit two grand slams (Will Rogers and Nate Baez) in consecutive innings (6th and 7th) in its 17-8 series clinching win against Dixie State on opening weekend. That was notable as prior to that, the Sun Devils had recorded just one single grand slam at Phoenix Municipal Stadium since moving there in 2015.
- It was the first time ASU had two grand slams in a single game since 2003 when
 the Sun Devils did so against San Diego State on Jan. 26 (also in consecutive
 innings in the 3rd and 4th). ASU is one of just three teams with two grand slams
 in a single game this season.
- ASU had just two grand slams total as a team between 2015-2021.
- It was the first time ASU had two grand slams in a season, period, since having two in 2014.
- Should ASU hit another grand slam this year, it would mark the first time since 2009 it has had three in one season and would tie the most since ASU had 4 in 2004.
- Despite a quiet weekend against BYU, ASU remains in the Top-40 in doubles this season and third in the Pac-12 with 17 and is still third in the league with seven homers.

The Good News...And the Bad News...

- For the most part, the BYU finale aside, ASU has gotten exceptional efforts from
 its starting pitching with the starters combining for a 2.79 ERA in the six games
 outside the anamalous BYU game. Even with the last BYU game included, ASU
 still has a sub-four ERA (3.90) amongst its seven starts this year.
- In fact against outside of the final BYU tilt ASU has been a REALLY good team
 on the mound in the first seven innings of games this year combining for a 3.21
 ERA in those first six games. Unfortunately, ASU also had three losses in those
 six games with the deciding run in all three coming in the ninth inning or later.
- ASU pitches have faced no shortage of traffic on the basepath this year with there being 18 bases-loaded opportunities for opponenents thus far. But the Sun Devils have allowed just four hits in that scenario, holding the opponents to a .222 clip in the process.
- The Sun Devil bullpen has inherited 36 runners this season, allowing just 11

- to score (30.1 percent) again a mark skewed by the final BYU contest as the numbers stood at 29 and 6 (20.7) prior to it.
- The vast majority of damage done to the Devils this year has come prior to the pitchers getting two outs as the staff is limiting opponents to just 15-of-72 hitting (.208) once it gets the second out of any inning.
- Offensively, ASU is also reaching base at a fairly solid .379 clip on the year (and over .100 points higher than its team .269 batting average) and the team has been especially good at get 41 percent of its leadoff opportunities on base.
- That being said, ASU is batting just .248 as a team with runners on the base path and just .234 (18-of-77) with runners in scoring position this year while advancing runners less than 50 percent of the time.
- ASU did have the two grand slams in one game against Dixie State unfortunately those represent ASU's only two hits with the bases loaded this
 season, going 2-for-9 as a whole (.222) and 0-for-7 in all other games but that
 one.
- The Devils have stranded 59 base runners this year (8.4 per game).

Big Willie Style

- One of the best players in the program's record books will start a new era of Sun Devil Baseball as Willie Bloomquist looks forward to his first season at the helm of the Devile
- A 14-year Major League Baseball veteran and with over 20 years of experience in professional baseball, Bloomquist returns to the Sun Devils as one of the most accomplished alumni in program history and has remained deeply entrenched in all levels of baseball.
- Bloomquist spent five years as a Special Assistant to Arizona Diamondbacks President & CEO Derrick Hall after joining the front office in May 2016. In this role, Bloomquist assisted Hall and other departments throughout the baseball and business side of the organization, including working on-field with players at all levels of the organization, attending community events, meeting with corporate partners, interacting with season ticket holders and visiting D-backs Minor League affiliates.
- The Port Orchard, Wash., native joined USA Baseball's Board of Directors in 2016, a post he has retained since then. Bloomquist is a two-time alum of Team USA, having played for the Collegiate National Team in World Baseball Classic.
- Bloomquist became the first Arizona State Sun Devil to play for the Diamondbacks and spent three seasons with the franchise from 2011-13, serving a key role on the 2011 National League West Championship team. In 225 games for the D-backs, he hit .289 with 36 doubles, 8 triples, 4 homers, 63 RBI, 43 walks and 27 stolen bases. In the 2011 NL Division Series vs. Brewers, he hit .318 (7-for-22) with an RBI and three stolen bases in five games. In 2012, he set career highs with a .302 average and 21 doubles.
- During his 14-year Major League career, which included time with the Mariners (2002-08, '14-15), Royals (2009-10) and Reds (2010), Bloomquist hit .269 with 778 hits, 110 doubles, 23 triples, 18 home runs, 225 RBI and 133 stolen bases in 1,055 career games. He compiled a .977 fielding percentage playing outfield (339 games), shortstop (305 games), third base (142), second base (141) and first base (47). Of the 111 Sun Devils to play in MLB, only seven earned more service time than Bloomquist.
- Bloomquist played three seasons at ASU (1997-99) and earned 1999 Pac-10 Player of the Year honors as a junior. In 1998, he tied a College World Series single-game record with 5 hits in a game while leading a team that competed for the National Championship. Bloomquist was an All-American in both the 1998 and 1999 campaigns. He finished his college career with a .394 average before being drafted by the Mariners in the third round of the 1999 draft.
- To this day, Bloomquist still holds the fourth-highest career batting average in school history (.394) while he remains fifth in ASU history in runs (216), fourth in triples (22) and fourth in stolen bases (72) and was named to the All-Packard Team in 2014.
