TERRITORIAL CUP UP FOR GRABS IN TEMPE

Sun Devils and Wildcats will renew rivalry in the Duel in the Desert

After a snowy, 37-27 defeat at the hands of Washington State the Sun Devils will look to rebound against in-state rival Arizona in the State Farm Territorial Cup game on Saturday, November 19 at Frank Kush Field/Sun Devil Stadium. ASU enters the showdown with a 6-4 record, 4-3 in Pac-12 play. Arizona is 2-8, including a 1-7 mark in Pac-12 play. UA dropped a 48-29 decision at Colorado last week.

ON THE AIR: The IMG-Sun Devil Sports Network will carry all 12 of ASU's football games live on their 10-station radio network. Tim Healey (play-by-play) and former Sun Devil quarterback Jeff Van Raaphorst (color analyst) will call the action. The Arizona game will air on 620 AM. The game will also air on Sirius/XM radio (139/195).

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION: Arizona State's game with Arizona will be broadcast by Fox Sports Arizona. Tom Leander, Adam Archuleta and John Fina will call the action.

SUN DEVILS VS. WILDCATS: This will be the 85th Duel in the Desert, with Arizona leading the all-time series 46-37-1. Arizona State won an instant classic last season in Tucson, beating UA 30-29 in double overtime. The Wildcats won the last meeting in Tempe, beating ASU 20-17 in 2009.

COACH ERICKSON VS. ARIZONA: Dennis Erickson is 9-4 in his career against Arizona, including a 2-2 mark at Arizona State.

FINDING PAYDIRT: Junior running back Cameron Marshall added another touchdown on the ground against Washington State, giving him 25 in his career. He is one of only 11 Sun Devils all time to score at least 20 touchdowns on the ground. The 25 puts him in a tie for fifth place all-time in ASU history with Ben Malone (1971-73).

BLACK OUT: Arizona State will be hosting the second Black Out Game of the season against Arizona. The Sun Devils will don their All Black uniforms for the match-up with the Wildcats.

CAPTAINS: Omar Bolden, Garth Gerhart, Brock Osweiler, Colin Parker and T.J. Simpson have been named the captains of the 2011 Sun Devil football team.

WASHINGTON STATE RECAP: Jamal Miles returned the game's opening kickoff 95-yards for a touchdown, but ASU could not stop the Cougars aerial attack, as WSU beat the Sun Devils 37-27 on a cold, snowy night in Pullman. Brock Osweiler threw for 351 yards and Gerell Robinson had 158 yards receiving, but WSU's Connor Halliday tossed four touchdowns and threw for 494 yards to lead the Cougars to the win.

ASU vs. WASHINGTON STATE NOTES:

- Gerell Robinson turned in his fourth 100-yard receiving game of the year.
- Gerell Robinson had a career-high 158 yards receiving.
- ASU played a snow game for the first time since the 1970 Peach Bowl against North Carolina.
- Brock Osweiler threw for over 300 yards for the fifth time in his career.

STATE FARM TERRITORIAL CUP SERIES: The winner of the Arizona/Arizona State game will earn a point for its school in the State Farm Territorial Cup Series. The schools compete in 17 common varsity sports, and the school that accumulates the most points over the course of the school year will win the competition.

MARSHALL OF THE TOUCHDOWN: Cameron Marshall has set a new career high with his 14 rushing touchdowns this season. The 14 scores puts him sixth place in school history for most rushing touchdowns in a single season by a Sun Devil. The school record for rushing touchdowns in a season is 18, set by Woody Green (1972) and Terry Battle (1996). Marshall leads the Pac-12 with his 14 touchdowns on the ground and has scored more rushing touchdowns than six Pac-12 teams (WSU 13, Arizona 13, Utah 12, USC 10, Colorado 9, Oregon State 9).

MARSHALL, MARSHALL, MARSHALL: Junior running back Cameron Marshall has put together a terrific 2011 season. Marshall has run for 837 yards so far this year, eclipsing his previous career-high of 787 set in 2010. That's the most rushing yards in a season by a Sun Devil running back since Ryan Torain for 1,229 yards in 2006. Against Utah Marshall passed the 1,500-yard mark for his career and has now scored 25 career touchdowns on the ground. At UCLA, Marshall recorded his fifth career 100-yard rushing game, gaining a career-high 168-yards on 27 carries. It was his third 100-yard game of the season. He has also run for three scores in a game three times in his career, including twice this season. Marshall is also a receiving threat out of the backfield. Against UC Davis he caught four passes for a career-high 86 yards, including a 47-yard reception. On the season he has 19 catches for 162-yards.

100-YARDS ON THE GROUND: Arizona State is 4-1 when Cameron Marshall runs for at least 100-yards. He did it last year against Portland State and UCLA and this season against USC, Colorado and UCLA. ASU is now 255-53-5 all-time when it has a 100-yard rusher.

BROCK AND ROLL: Despite the loss to the Cougars, quarterback Brock Osweiler put up big numbers. The sophomore signal caller threw for 351 yards, his fifth career game with over 300 yards passing. Four of those games have come this season. Osweiler has thrown for 2,890 yards this season, second most in the Pac-12. He has also thrown 20 touchdowns.

ACADEMIC HONOR: Aaron Pflugrad was named to the Capitol One Academic All-District VIII team, making him eligible for Academic All-American honors. Pflugrad was an Honorable Mention Academic All-Pac-10 choice last season.

NOTES

MR. TOUCHDOWN: Junior wide receiver Jamal Miles has become a touchdown machine in 2011. Miles returned a kickoff for a touchdown in the season opener against UC Davis and did it again at Washington State, threw a TD pass against Missouri and has caught six touchdown passes this year. Against Oregon State, Miles added another notch to his TD belt, returning a punt 78-yards for a score. Miles is the only player in the nation to have scored a touchdown on a reception, kickoff return and punt return as well as throw a TD pass. Miles TD pass was the first of his career on his second career attempt. He also set a new career-high with his nine receptions for 55 yards and a touchdown against USC.

RUNNING FOR MILES: Jamal Miles returned his third career kickoff for a touchdown and second this season against Washington State, bringing it back 95-yards for the score. The two kickoff return touchdowns this year ties Miles with Terry Battle (1996) for most kickoff return touchdowns by a Sun Devil in a single season. The kickoff return TD against Washington State made Miles ASU's all-time leader in that category, moving him past Omar Bolden, Terry Battle and Whizzer White who all had two in their careers. It was the seventh kickoff return for touchdown the Sun Devils have had since Dennis Erickson took over as head coach in 2007, the most under one coach in school history.

MORE ON MILES: The 78-yard punt return by Jamal Miles against Oregon State was the first punt returned for a touchdown by a Sun Devil since 2005. On November 25, 2005, Terry Richardson returned an Arizona punt 71-yards for the score. It took 68 games before Miles did the same thing against the Beavers.

BALLHAWKING: After forcing only one turnover in the first two games, the Sun Devil defense has dialed up the takeaways. Over the last eight contests, Arizona State has forced 27 turnovers. ASU has intercepted 13 passes this season after totaling 10 interceptions all of last year. The Sun Devils have forced 28 total turnovers this year after forcing 17 last season. The +14 turnover ratio leads the Pac-12 and is fourth best in the nation.

BIG YEAR FOR G-ROB: Senior wide receiver Gerell Robinson is making his final season in Tempe a memorable one. Last week against Washington State, Robinson equaled his career-high with eight receptions and set a new career-high with his 158-yards. It was Robinson's fourth career 100-yard receiving game, which have all come in the last five weeks. He leads the Sun Devils with his 50 receptions for 901 yards. Both of those numbers are single season career-highs for Robinson, who made his 100th career reception in the game against the Bruins. He has gained 1,575 yards and scored 10 touchdowns in his career as a Sun Devil.

PUSH 'EM BACK: In 2010, the Sun Devil defense routinely made tackles for loss or for no gain. The defense finished 2010 with 143 plays that went for negative or no yards, totaling 307 yards lost for the offense. Against Washington State, the Sun Devil defense totaled nine plays of negative or no gain for the Cougars for 22 yards lost.

THREE AND OUT: The 2010 ASU defense was one of the top teams in the nation to force opposing offenses into three-and-out possessions. The Sun Devils averaged 4.08 three-and-outs a game, for a total of 49 in their 12 contests. That placed them in the top 20 in the nation. So far in 2011, ASU has forced opponents into 30 three-and-outs.

ERICKSON ENTERS FIFTH YEAR WITH ASU

On Dec. 11, 2006, Arizona State named Dennis Erickson its 22nd football coach. In his first season as the Sun Devils' head coach, Erickson found unprecedented success, leading ASU to a 10-3 record, a share of the Pac-10 championship and a berth in the Pacific Life Holiday Bowl. Erickson was named the 2007 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, the third time in his career he has won the award and the first to win it at three different schools.

A two-time national champion at Miami (1989 and 1991), Coach Erickson is 6th on the active career coaching list with 179. Victories over the top-ranked team (three), wins over ranked teams (29)...all notes and achievements the Sun Devils have the opportunity to grasp almost each and every season.

Coach Erickson is 179-93-1 in his 22 seasons as a collegiate head coach, is known in the Pac-12 as the architect of one of college football's biggest turnarounds when he coached at Oregon State from 1999-2002. He led the Beavers, who had not had a winning season since 1970, to a 7-5 record in his first season and then grabbed the attention of the college football world with an 11-1 mark in 2000, which was punctuated by a 41-9 defeat of No. 10 Notre Dame in the Fiesta Bowl on Jan. 1, 2001, OSU's first bowl win since the 1962 Liberty Bowl. Oregon State ended the season ranked fourth in the final AP poll and led the Pac-10 in scoring offense (32.6 points per game), scoring defense (18.5 point per game) and total defense (314.4 yards per game). Coach Erickson earned Sporting News National Coach of the Year while the Pac-10 coaches gave him conference honors. Erickson is the first person to coach three different Pac-12 schools, having also coached at Washington State.

NOEL HUDDLE OFFENSE: Offensive coordinator Noel Mazzone always says how the Sun Devils can score in a hurry, and they have not let him down this season. Arizona State's first two touchdown drives against UC Davis both took under 1:10. Last season, ASU had 11 scoring drives that took under 1:10. Against Missouri, ASU had an eight second scoring drive and in the Oregon State game the offense scored on a :44 second drive. At Utah, ASU had a 1:03 scoring drive. Against Colorado, ASU had four touchdown drives that took under two minutes, including a 35 second one and a 32 second one. Against UCLA the Sun Devils had one touchdown drive that took under two minutes. But ASU also showed they could do a long drive if necessary, turning in its two longest scoring drives of the season. The Sun Devils had a 97-yard drive and a 93-yard drive against the Bruins, both of which resulted in touchdowns. Against Washington State, ASU turned in a :59 second scoring drive.

SENIOR CLASS: The 2011 Sun Devils will feature one of the largest senior classes in the nation, as there will be 24 seniors playing in their final season. The senior class includes: Linebacker Oliver Aaron, wide receiver George Bell, offensive lineman Chris DeArmas, safety Eddie Elder, safety Clint Floyd, defensive end Jamaar Jarrett, tight end Trevor Kohl, offensive lineman Nick Emanuele, linebacker Shelly Lyons, wide receiver Angelo Magee, wide receiver Gerell Robinson, wide receiver Mike Willie, cornerback Omar Bolden, offensive lineman Garth Gerhart, snapper Cameron Kastl, offensive lineman Dan Knapp, offensive lineman Mike Marcisz, offensive lineman Trent Marsh, defensive lineman Bo Moos, linebacker Colin Parker, wide receiver Aaron Pflugrad, offensive lineman Aderious Simmons, offensive lineman Adam Tello and wide receiver T.J. Simpson.

PAC-12 PREDICTIONS: Arizona State has been picked to finish second in the Pac-12 South in the annual media poll. Oregon has been picked to win the Pac-12 North. The winners of the two divisions will face each other in the first ever Pac-12 Championship Game on December 2.

BROCK'S TALLER THAN YOU: Quarterback Brock Osweiler checks in at six foot eight inches tall, making him the tallest quarterback in the FBS. Osweiler is one of nine QBs 6-6 or taller in the nation.

SELECT COMPANY: Head Coach Dennis Erickson is in select company when it comes to conference Coach of the Year awards. Coach Erickson is one of only two coaches in the nation to have six Coach of the Year trophies to his name. Erickson won Pac-10 Coach of the Year honors in 1988 (Washington State), 2000 (Oregon State) and 2007 (Arizona State) and Big East Coach of the Year honors in 1991, 1992 and 1994 (all with Miami). The only other coach with six Coach of the Year awards is South Carolina's Steve Spurrier.

TRUE FRESHMEN UNDER ERICKSON: Since Dennis Erickson took over in 2007, 27 true freshmen have played for the Sun Devils. This season, three (Mike Bercovici, Ezekiel Bishop, Rashad Wadood) have played. Last year only three played after eight saw the field in 2009. ASU saw a school record 10 play during the 2008 season. Five schools in the Pac-12 this

Archuleta played at ASU from 1996 to 2000 before going on to an eight-year NFL career. Smith donned the Maroon and Gold from 1996 to 1999 before playing 10 seasons in the NFL and winning two Super Bowl rings with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

UNI-WATCH: Arizona State wore their traditional uniform combo for the season opener against UC Davis (gold helmet, maroon jersey, gold pants). They wore all black against Missouri and all white for the first road game at Illinois. Against USC they wore all maroon and against Oregon State they wore white helmets, maroon jerseys and white pants. At Utah and at Washington State they wore gold helmets, white jerseys and gold pants. Against Oregon the Sun Devils wore maroon helmets, white jerseys and maroon pants. For the Homecoming game against Colorado ASU wore black helmets, black jerseys and gold pants. At UCLA, ASU wore black helmets, white jerseys and black pants.
